CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “WINTON SUPERSPRINT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 13, 14 and 15 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Winton Motor Raceway, Winton, Victoria on 19th – 22nd May 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

1.5.2 **Direction:** Clockwise
1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 40
1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located at the rear of the Race Control Tower.
1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located on the first floor of the Race Control Tower.
1.5.6 **DRD Office:** Located on the first floor of the Race Control Tower.
1.5.7 **Control Line:** Located at the Finish Line and across Pit Exit.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 TEAM COMMUNICATION WITH OFFICIALS

- 2.1.1 At this Event, Team personnel are not permitted to conduct business outside their garage. For avoidance of doubt, unless specifically given instruction to do so; Team personnel will not be permitted access (including but not limited to) the Supercars Operations Truck, the Stewards Office, the DSA Office, RD Office, DRD Office, Race Control and Event Operations Office.

2.2 ENTRIES

- 2.2.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
2.2.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (AEST)** on Friday 20th May 2022.
2.2.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
2.2.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1730hrs (AEST)** on Friday 20th May 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

- 2.2.5 Wildcard Drivers are required to email their licensing in accordance with **Rule A5.1** including a valid Car Club Membership to motorsportoperations@supercars.com by **1000hrs (AEST) Wednesday 18th May 2022**.

2.3 SUBJECT OF AN INVESTIGATION NOT TO LEAVE THE EVENT

- 2.3.1 At this Event, delete **Rule B2.3.1** and replace with the following:
B2.3.1 Any Driver and/or Authorised Representative of a Competitor who has received written notification from the RD or DRD that such Driver or Competitor of their Car has been involved in any Incident that is the subject of an Investigation by the RD or DRD must not leave the precincts of the Event unless that Driver and/or Authorised Representative has first obtained the permission of the Stewards.

CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 All B-double transporters must be split outside the Circuit complex and be brought into the paddock as single trailers.
- 3.1.4 Transporters are permitted to enter the Supercars paddock commencing at **1400hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 19th May 2022 and all movements must be with the prior approval of the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.5 Unless otherwise approved by the Paddock Manager or their delegate, Teams are permitted to commence unloading transporters at **0830hrs (AEST)** on Friday 20th May 2022.
- 3.1.6 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.7 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.2.1.1 Promoter issued Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 20th May 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.2.1.2 All accreditation and tickets will be scanned upon entry to the Event.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car will be allocated 4 x car passes for the Teams carpark.
- 3.2.2.1 Each VCS Team will receive one (1) Transit Pass for the purpose of delivering catering supplies to the Team garage. Deliveries are required to take place outside of Event Operating Hours. Under no circumstances are vehicles to be parked anywhere other than outside the venue once the delivery is completed.
- 3.2.3 **Pit Walk Pass collection** – *To be confirmed in Further Supplementary Regulations*

3.3 CREDENTIALS OFFICE OPENING HOURS

3.3.1 The Credentials Office is located on Huntley Street on the right-hand side when accessing the circuit (adjacent to the main gate), accessed from Glenrowan-Winton Road.

3.3.2 The Credentials Office operating hours are as follows **(AEST)**:

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Friday 20th May between **1600hrs and 1730hrs (AEST)**.

3.5 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

3.5.1 Access to the venue via Fox Street will be available all day on Thursday 19th May 2022. On all other days (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) access will only be available from **0600hrs** via the main gate on Huntley Street, which is accessed via Glenrowan - Winton Road. The two right-hand side lanes will be Competitor only lanes for express access.

3.6 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

3.6.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.7 GOLF BUGGIES

3.7.1 All Golf Buggies must be road registered.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the Victorian State Government COVID-19 Health Orders.

4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:

E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified ~~in the Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.

4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.

4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements. This person should be nominated on the Notification of Performance Personnel Form (**Rule D24**).

4.2 MEDICAL SERVICES

4.2.1 Operating Hours and location will be *updated in Further Supplementary Regulations*.

4.5 WHS AND COVID COMPLIANCE

4.6 24HR VENUE SECURITY

4.7 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

4.7.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.1.1 The Event operating hours (**AEST**), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

5.1.1.1 Saturday 30th April 2022 0630 – end of VCS R13

5.1.1.2 Sunday 1st May 2022 0700 – end of VCS R15

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.1.2**.

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Winton:

5.3 BRIEFINGS

5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers Briefing** will be held at **1730 (AEST)** on Friday 20th May 2022 in the briefing room located in the support paddock.

5.4 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.4.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.4.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.4m from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
 - 5.4.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.5 PIT STOPS

- 5.5.1 For races **13, 14 and 15** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
- 5.5.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.5.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 5.5.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.5.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 5.5.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.6 ADDITIONAL FLAG POINT

- 5.6.1 In addition to the flag signals shown at the Control Line, the following flag signals will be displayed at T9 the Black Flag and Black Flag with Orange Disc (Mechanical Black Flag).

5.7 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.7.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
- 5.7.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.8 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.8.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.
- 5.8.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.

5.9 AIR IMPACT TOOLS AND PRESSURE VESSELS

- 5.9.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.3.2 a)**:
- D11.3.2** At each Event, a Team must be equipped with a minimum of four (4) air impact tools and an air lance; of which:
- a) maximum of two (2) air impact tools may be used at SuperSprint Events (save for tool failure); and
 - b) a maximum of four (4) air impact tools may be used at all other Events.

CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

6.1 MINIMUM WEIGHT

- 6.1.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**, all Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2 on Saturday 21st May 2022, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

CHAPTER 7 -MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.
- 7.1.1.1 Activities are to be conducted in accordance with Team WHS COVID-19 management procedures and the Promoter's COVID-19 management procedures.

7.2 GRID WALKS

- 7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks will be permitted (subject to COVID restrictions).
