#### CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

##### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “REPCO BATHURST 1000” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 24 of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at the Mount Panorama Circuit, Bathurst, New South Wales on 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

##### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 34
- 1.5.4 **Stewards Office:** Located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Tower 3.

## CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

### 2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2023 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 All entries (including Wildcard Entries) additional Drivers are required to be nominated using the additional Driver Nomination form, which was submitted prior to the 2023 Penrite Oil Sandown 500 Event.
- 2.1.2.1 All additional Drivers (including Wildcard Entries) must be nominated in the portal as part of the Event/ Car registration process.
- 2.1.3 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

- 2.1.4 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2023 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event Program.
- 2.1.5 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

## **CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS**

### **3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK**

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 Team Transporters are permitted to enter the VCS paddock at **0830hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **1000hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time. Offending Cars will be reported to the Stewards.

### **3.2 MOTORHOME APPLICATION & APPROVAL**

- 3.2.1 At this Event and upon written application to Motorsport Operations using the form attached with the Supplementary Regulations – Motorhomes **strictly for the use of Supercars Team Personnel only (No Sponsors or Activations)** will be permitted to be parked in the Supercars paddock but must not exceed 26m in length and must fit on the right-hand side of the Teams transporter. Motorhomes that are found to be sub-let to any other person other than Supercars Team Personnel will be removed from the paddock.
- 3.2.1.1 Motorhome applications close at **1700hrs** on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2023.
- 3.2.2 Approved Team motorhomes arriving prior to **1430hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023 will not be allocated a holding area within the Event precinct. If you are requiring a place to park, the rear of the main general admission carpark will be the least congested location.
- 3.2.2.1 On Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023 once all VCS Transporters have returned and are re-parked following the Transporter parade, Teams motorhome's will be permitted to enter and park in their allocated position in the VCS Paddock.
- 3.2.3 All motorhomes are required to be parked in position in the VCS paddock no later than **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
- 3.2.3.1 Once the motorhome is parked in position in the VCS Paddock, it cannot be moved from its allocated position until two (2) hours following race 24 on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
- 3.2.4 **MOTORHOME ACCESS:** via Mountain Straight Gate (gate 2). This gate is only accessible when there are no motoracing activities taking place on the racing circuit.
- 3.2.5 All visitors to the motorhome must have approved accreditation on person from Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October to access the VCS paddock.
- 3.2.6 All Motorhomes must abide by **Supplementary Regulation 4.7**.

### 3.3 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.3.1 Series hard-card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.3.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.3.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each VCS Car will receive four (4) Priority Parking passes to park in the Priority Car Park located directly in front of the general admission Main Gate (as per 2022). Then walk over the pedestrian bridge into the VCS Paddock. Please follow the directions of the Traffic Controllers to be parked.
- 3.3.2.1 All car park passes must be displayed from **0930hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 for the duration of the Event. **No Car Pass No Access.**
- 3.3.3 **Team Caterer Transit Pass:** Each Group will receive one (1) Supercars Paddock Transit Pass (to be used outside of Event Operating hours only) for the sole purpose of delivering Team catering supplies to the Team garage.
- 3.3.3.1 Access is via the Mountain Straight gate (Gate 2). Cars parked inside the Circuit during Event Operating hours will be reported to the Stewards.
- 3.3.4 Additional car parking is available in the general admission car park at the Main Gate.
- 3.3.5 **Grid Walk Pass collection:** To be collected from the Accreditation Centre.
- 3.3.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to be parked in the VCS Paddock at any time (with exception to Supplementary Regulation 3.3.3). Offending Cars will be reported to the Stewards.

### 3.4 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.4.1 The Accreditation Centre is in **Building Block D, NSW TAFE Bathurst Campus**, accessible off Panorama Avenue. Follow directional signage. The internal Campus roadway is one-way.
- 3.4.2 The Accreditation Centre opening hours are as follows **(AEDT):**

- 3.4.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collection by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticketek Box Office located at the **Main Gate** (in an envelope with the collector's name). The Box Office will be open approx. 30min ahead of gates opening on Thursday – Sunday.

### 3.5 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.5.1 Teams are only permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023 between **1200hrs** and **1700hrs (AEDT)**.

### 3.6 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.6.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

### 3.7 DRIVER BATHS

3.7.1 Teams are to empty Driver baths at the front of Team transporters in accordance with Supplementary Regulation 4.7. No water or bath fluids are permitted to flow towards garages or into another Teams pack up areas.

### 3.8 GOLF BUGGIES

3.8.1 For this Event, one (1) road registered golf buggy per Team is permitted.

3.8.2 At this Event, Teams must report to the Motorsport Operations Transporter and obtain a Buggy Transit pass from the Supercars Paddock Manager. Any buggy to be found within the venue without a transit pass will be removed.

### 3.9 GARAGE KEYS

3.9.1 At this Event, Teams must sign-out garage keys from the Event Management Office, located at Level 1, Tower 1.

3.9.1.1 Teams are responsible for signing-back-in garage keys on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> October. If the Event Management Office is closed, a paddock security guard will take possession of the key/s and return to the venue. Unreturned keys will attract an invoice from Bathurst Regional Council.

## CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

### 4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

## **4.6 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

- 4.6.1 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation;
- 4.6.2 Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.
- 4.6.3 Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- 4.6.4 Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

## **4.7 WASTE PRODUCTS**

- 4.7.1 All personnel must be made aware of the fact the NO waste of any nature may be tipped into the storm water drains located with the support compound.
- 4.7.2 All storm water drains lead directly to the Macquarie River and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will be monitoring the situation in the lead up and throughout the Event.
- 4.7.3 This ban includes the washing of any wheel rims within the vicinity of storm water drains.
- 4.7.4 Competitors are advised that the EPA is taking an extremely proactive approach to this matter and Teams are put on notice that any infringement of this directive will result in action being taken by either the Promoter or the EPA or both. The EPA has the ability to prosecute offenders with heavy penalties.
- 4.7.5 The Promoter has provided an area for disposal of waste oil and/or fluid products that are located near the Circuit fuel bund. This is not for the disposal of used Car parts (i.e. oil filters etc.)

## CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

### 5.1 FORMAT OF VCS EVENTS

- 5.1.1 At this Event, the CPS minimum requirements will be specified in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*.

### 5.2 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

- 5.2.1 The Event Operating hours (**AEDT**), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

5.2.1.5	Sunday 8 <sup>th</sup> October 2023	0615 – end of VCS race 24

\* Note: Garage doors are required to be open for the Volunteer Party in Pitlane.

- 5.2.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.2.1**.

### 5.3 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

- 5.3.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Bathurst: <http://www.bom.gov.au/places/nsw/bathurst/>

### 5.4 BRIEFINGS

- 5.4.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023 in the large Grey Shed, immediately to the rear of Gate 2.
- 5.4.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1815hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023 in the large Grey Shed, immediately to the rear of Gate 2.

### 5.5 PRACTICE

- 5.5.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1, 3, 4 and 6.
- 5.5.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2 and 5.
- 5.5.3 The Stewards may, in their absolute discretion, order that a Driver who has not completed a suitable number of laps in practice 1, 3, 4 or 6 combined, be required to drive the Car in another Session or Sessions. This decision of the Stewards is not susceptible to appeal.
- 5.5.4 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during practice 3 and 6.
- 5.5.4.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
- 5.5.4.2 During practice 3 and 6, Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay.
- 5.5.4.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
- 5.5.4.4 At the conclusion of the practice Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to park in their pit bay.

### 5.6 WARM-UP

- 5.6.1 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during the warm-up Session on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
- 5.6.1.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
- 5.6.1.2 Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay;
- 5.6.1.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
- 5.6.1.4 At the conclusion of the warm-up Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to park in their pit bay.
- 5.6.1.5 Refuelling Towers are permitted to remain setup and in position for race 24.
- 5.6.2 The warm-up Session is time certain.

## 5.7 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.7.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.1**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.7.1.1 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the right-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.6m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
  - 5.7.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 1.75m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.
- 5.7.2 For the purpose of a visual guide to the Driver during ‘double-stacking’ and to ensure the Fastlane is kept clear for transiting Cars, an additional line of race tape must be affixed along the length of the Pit Bay.
- 5.7.2.1 The outside edge of the race tape marking the “double stack” line is required to be 1.5m from the outside edge of the race tape marking the Pit Bay.

## 5.8 PIT STOPS DRIVER CHANGE

- 5.8.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.

## 5.9 FRONT BRAKE ROTOR RESTRICTIONS

- 5.9.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D20.1.1** and **D20.1.2.2**:  
D20.1.1 Outside Team Testing activities, the Table in **Rule D20.1.2.2** outlines the per Car allocation of front brake rotors and brake pad sets during the 2023 Championship Season Events.  
D20.1.2.2

- 5.9.2 At this Event, the front brake rotor restrictions will be as per **Rule D20.1.2.2**:
- 5.9.2.1 For the Bathurst 1000 Event and subject to **Rule D20.1.2.1**, each Car will be allocated a maximum of three (3) rotors and four (4) pad sets, a maximum of two (2) rotors and three (3) pad sets are permitted to be new.

## 5.10 PERSONNEL

- 5.10.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.2**:  
D11.2.2 ~~For each 500/600 refuelling Event and Endurance Event, At this Event, each Car may be attended by a maximum of nine (9) people (the “Designated Pit Crew”) as follows, who are permitted across the Prescribed Line when carrying out any Pit Stop in any race:~~
- D11.2.2.1 One (1) Car Controller
  - D11.2.2.2 One (1) Air Jack Operator
  - D11.2.2.3 One (1) Refueler/Vent Attendant
  - D11.2.2.4 One (1) Fire Attendant
  - D11.2.2.5 Five (5) Other Team members
- 5.10.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.9**:  
D11.2.9 ~~Four (4)~~ Five (5) Other Team Persons  
D11.2.9.1 Will be responsible for the service of the Car under the direction of the Car Controller.



## 5.11 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

5.11.1 For this Event, note the amendments to the following Rules: **D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2, D8.3.2.1, D8.3.3 and D8.3.3.1:**

D8.3.1 ~~Thirty~~ Forty Minutes:

D8.3.1.1 When ~~30~~ 40 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.2 ~~Twenty-Five~~ Thirty-Five Minutes:

D8.3.2.1 When ~~25~~ 35 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.3 ~~Fifteen~~ Twenty-Five minutes:

D8.3.3.1 When ~~15~~ 25 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

## 5.12 PIT STOPS

5.12.1 For race **24** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.12.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events.**

a) In addition to the above CPS requirements, a compulsory front brake pad change (1 set) is required between, commencing lap 55 and ending lap 120.

5.12.1.2 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

## 5.13 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – EXTRA FORMATION LAP

5.13.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.6.1.9.**

## 5.14 SC DEPLOYMENT DURING A RACE

5.14.1 At this Event, refer to **Appendix 1.** which details **Rule D10.2 SC Deployment During a Race** in its entirety with the amendments to this Rule marked up.

## 5.15 SUSPENDING A RACE – RED FLAG

5.15.1 For this Event, in the instance of a suspended race due to red flag, the following will occur:

5.15.1.1 Cars one (1) or more laps behind the leader will be recorded in accordance with **Rule D9.1.3.4.**

5.15.1.2 Should however, the SC be already deployed, Cars one (1) or more laps behind the leader will be recorded in accordance with **Rule D10.2.2.6** and the race restarted in accordance with **Rule D10.2.9.**

## 5.16 CARS TO CARRY VIDEO RECORDERS

5.16.1 Further to **Rule D21.3.12:**

5.16.1.1 Each Team is required to ensure the SD card or USB device fitted to their Car is of sufficient capacity to record the entire race (128Gb or larger capacity).

5.16.1.2 SD cards (or USB device) must be cleared and reformatted prior to the 30-minute signal for race 24 on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023, however, must not be cleared prior to 30 minutes after the completion of Sunday's warm up, without the prior written permission of the HOM.

5.16.1.3 The Judiciary Camera system must use the Scene provided by Supercars at the Event.

5.16.1.4 The Car Number constant and the GPS time offset must be set correctly.

## 5.17 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.17.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.  
 5.17.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

## 5.18 DESIGN AND SIGNAGE

- 5.18.1 At this Event, note the following new **Rule E1.9.7:**

E1.9.7 In Car Driver & Car ID:

- E1.9.7.1 Each Car must have their Competition number and the Primary Driver's surname always affixed to the dash, legible and visible by the in-Car camera.

6.1.1.2 All additional Drivers (including Wildcard additional Drivers) that have not competed in a race of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2, in the Supercars Scales Garage.
