BOOKING CAMPSITES

Q. When do campsites go on sale?

A. Tuesday May 7 - 11am (AEST) via our website

Q. I wish to attend for the first time – what are my options?

A. Please review our Public Sale tips document on our website.

It can be overwhelming trying to decide what your best options are. We suggest answering a few questions first:-

- What set up are you intending to bring? (tent / caravan / motorhome)
- How big is your set up (including vehicle/s which must be parked within your site)? see campsite size chart
- Do I require power? only some sites within the Orchard campground and Motorhome Park have access to powered sites. Due to the cost involved with bringing in temporary power, these are the most expensive sites

Once you have answered these and reviewed this document to ascertain what is most suitable, please review the Campground Maps within the important links section of the <u>website</u> to understand the various sections within each campground (i.e. Chase A, Chase B etc). This will assist in allowing you to go straight to this section to check what sites are available when we go on sale.

Q. Which campsites are suitable for caravans / motorhomes?

A. All campgrounds are suitable for caravans however each campground has sites which vary in size and not all are flat! Please review the approximate campsite size details chart. We have also included some commentary on van suitability in each campground profile. Suffice to say, sites in the Orchard, Enduro, the Chase, Max Cameron and Motorhome Park are predominantly flat with only a small percentage unsuitable for caravans.

Details on dump points and power offering is available in each campground profile.

Q. Which campgrounds are more suitable for families?

A. Families are welcome in all campgrounds and there is a nice mix of families, large groups and independent travellers. Due to limited demand, the focus will always be on getting a site that suits your needs from a space and power perspective.

Q. Which campgrounds have accessible amenities?

A. McPhillamy Park, Reid & Sulman, the Paddock all have permanent accessible toilet and showers available. Supercars are adding in portable accessible amenities to a campground down the bottom of the mountain in 2024. Please contact the camping team via <u>camping@supercars.com</u> if you require a campsite in close proximity to accessible amenities

CAMPGROUNDS

Q. What campgrounds are available in 2024?

A. There are eight (8) campgrounds at the Repco Bathurst 1000; Details of the different campgrounds and the amenities provided in each are outlined below;

MaDhillowy Dark Compareural		
	McPhillamy Park Campground	
There is no better way to head to the Repco Bathurst 1000 than travelling up the mountain and setting up camp at the McPhillamy Park Campground. This is where the legends of Bathurst live. Campers come here year after year to show the true spirit of the Repco Bathurst 1000!In 2024, we are excited to release a new section – McPhillamy Park C. We have been able to secure an additional 70 sites. All sites are 8m x 8m. The new sites are mainly on grass/dirt and relatively flat. They are located behind the water towers in a previously fenced off area.LOCATIONTop of the Mountain, near Skyline and the "Esses".

Most sites in McPhillamy B are flat however some are prone to flooding if there is a rain event. The sites to the LEFT of 3^{RD} Street ($12^{th} - 23^{rd}$ AVE) do start to go downhill the further you go from the main street and therefore not suitable for caravans.

THE ORCHARD CAMPGROUND

Located outside the circuit, this campground has both non-powered and powered sites (10amp single connection per site for standard size, 15amp for larger sites). The smaller powered sites are approximately 7.5m x 7.5m with the larger sites being approximately 15m x 6m, perfect for Motorhomes. All sites are on grass - perfect for easy camping with reasonably flat ground.

Easy walking distance to the Support Category Paddock and Supercars Paddock *(to which a Paddock Pass is required to access)*, this campground provides some great behind the scenes action. Note – there will be no Paddock sites available in the public sale.

Q. Is there power in the campgrounds?

A. Powered sites are available in The Orchard, Chase and Motorhome Park campgrounds. If you have a powered site you will have access to either 10 amps or 15 amps. You must bring your own 25 metre extension cord. We cannot guarantee connection to the campground distribution board with extension cords that are shorter than 25 metres in length. All extension cords must be tested and tagged as per Electrical Testing Standards.

Q. How much do campsites cost?

TICKETS AND VEHICLE PASSES

Q. How many vehicle passes do I get per campsite?

A. You will receive one (1) x vehicle pass per campsite in the **Paddock** campground, and two (2) x vehicle passes per campsite in **all other campgrounds**. All vehicles must display a valid access pass to access the campgrounds. Both motorbikes and cars require a vehicle pass.

Vehicle passes will be distributed in August 2024 to the mailing address on your profile with regular updates sent.

The number of vehicles are limited per site to manage space and to ensure everyone's enjoyment. Vehicles not parked within campsite lines will be towed at the owner's expense.

Q. Does my campsite ticket get me access into the Repco Bathurst 1000?

A. No. You must purchase an admission ticket to the Repco Bathurst 1000 **in addition** to your campsite ticket. General Admission Tickets are available <u>via Ticketek</u> from April 4, 2004.

Your admission ticket must be valid for the duration of your stay. To be clear, if you intend to check in in any campground at any time before 6pm Thursday 10 October, you must have a 4 day General Admission Ticket.

Corporate tickets are available via <u>our website</u>. Our Corporate Team will be able to provide options for corporate guests who are camping *(noting that if you only purchase weekend corporate passes, you will need to purchase access tickets via the Team to enable camping access prior to Saturday 12 October)*

CHECKING IN AND DURATION OF STAY

Q. What day will the campgrounds open?

A. Reid & Sulman and McPhillamy Park campgrounds will open from 9:00am, Saturday, 5 October 2024.

The Paddock campground will open from 9:00am, Sunday, 6 October 2024.

The Chase, Orchard, Enduro and Max Cameron campgrounds will open from 9:00am, Tuesday, 8 October 2024 and the Motorhome Park campground will open from 12 midday, Tuesday, 8 October 2024.

All dates and times are subject to change.

Further communication will be sent detailing check in procedures in September.

Q. When can I check-in to my campsite?

A. Once your campground opens, check-in is available between 7am – 10pm **daily** during the Booking Period, refer to the table in the following question.

No **check in** is permitted into the campgrounds outside of these hours. Detailed instructions on how to enter all campgrounds will be provided closer to the Repco Bathurst 1000.

Q. How long do I have my campsite for?

A. You have access to your campsite for duration of the Booking Period specified in the table below. Campers must vacate their campsite by closing time.

CAMPSITE CAPACITY AND DIMENSIONS

Q. How many people can camp on my campsite?

A. A maximum of eight (8) people are allowed to camp on a campsite. A valid access camping wristband is required to enter the campgrounds. The wristbands are supplied once your valid entry ticket is scanned.

Q. How big is my campsite?

A. The minimum approximate size of each campsite is listed below;

<u>Please note</u>: campsites are marked out by line markers each year and subject to minor changes in size and shape. Supercars makes no guarantee that the perimeters of your campsite will be straight or uniform in nature.

Q. Can I use materials to cordon off my campsite?

A. Yes, provided such materials do not exceed 1.2m high and remain within the perimeter of your campsite.

Q. Can I bring a motorhome or caravan onto my site?

A. Yes, provided it fits within the perimeters of your campsite. Please note, not all sites are flat.

Q. Is there overflow parking for additional vehicles?

A. Overflow parking is located at the main public car parking area off Panorama Ave. Parking cannot be reserved and is on a first-come-first-served basis.

ACCESSING THE PADDOCK CAMPGROUND

Q. What is the size of the access tunnel to the Paddock campground?

A. The access tunnel is 3.5 metres wide and 3.1 metres tall.

Q. My vehicle won't fit in the tunnel. How can I access the Paddock campground?

A. You will need to access the campground via the racetrack *outside of racing times*. Racing times will be communicated closer to the start of the Event.

AMENITIES AND FACILITIES

Q. Are there accessible amenities in campgrounds?

A. Accessible amenities are located in the permanent amenity blocks in the following campgrounds:

Reid & Sulman Campground

McPhillamy Park Campground

Paddock Campground

Q. Are waste facilities provided for caravans / motorhomes?

A. Yes, there are sewage dump tanks available for patrons to use in five (5) of the campgrounds. Patrons need to carry their own blackwater / greywater to these tanks.

Q. Where are the waste dump points?

A. The event precinct has on-site dump points at the following locations:

Paddock Campground Motorhome Park Campground The Chase Campground Reid & Sulman Campground (near entry to McPhillamy Park) Max Cameron Campground

A new free dump point in Bathurst is also now available adjacent to the Waste Water Treatment Works, off the corner of Morrisset and Commonwealth Streets (205 Morrisset Street) which is open 24/7.

The Bathurst dump point has water available for washing and is illuminated for night-time use. There are CCTV cameras monitoring for any misuse or abuse.

The previous dump point is no longer available to the public.

Q. Is water available in the campgrounds?

A. Drinking water is available at various locations in all campgrounds. However, there is no capacity to supply water via tap or hose to any individual camp sites.

ALCOHOL

Q. How much alcohol can I bring onto the campground?

A. Each person can bring, and have in their possession, a maximum of ONE (1) type of the following alcohols on the campgrounds **per day** (*Maximum Quantities*):

- a) one (1) x carton (30 x 375ml cans) of full-strength beer (5% alcohol or less); or
- b) one (1) x carton (30 x 375ml cans) of light / mid strength beer (3.5% alcohol or less); or
- c) one (1) x carton (24 x 375ml cans) of pre-mixed spirits (6% alcohol or less); or
- d) one (1) x carton (24 x 375ml cans) cider (5% alcohol or less); or
- e) one (1) x sealed 4 litre cask of wine (14.5% alcohol or less); or
- f) two (2) x 375ml unopened (manufacturer's seal unbroken) plastic bottles of spirits (38 % alcohol or less); or
- g) one (1) x 750ml bottle of spirits (plastic bottle only)

Supercars reserves the right to confiscate any alcohol found on the campgrounds to be in excess of the Maximum Quantities and will not be liable to you whatsoever for such confiscation. There is no storage or "check-in" facility for excess alcohol so please make yourself aware of these limits prior to attending the event.

CAMPFIRES

Q. Can I have a fire in my campsite?

A. Fires are only permitted in campsites if:

- a) they are contained within a metal barrel, fire drum or equivalent vessel;
- b) the fire rating for the Central Ranges is not classified as Extreme or Catastrophic (as determined by the NSW Rural Fire Service); and
- c) any firewood used does not contain nails, bolts or screws.

Q. Is firewood available to buy at the campgrounds?

Details of our official firewood supplier will be confirmed in May, 2024.

WEATHER

Q. Can I get a refund for bad weather?

A. Supercars will only offer you a refund for bad weather if Supercars cancels or reschedules the Repco Bathurst 1000 as a result of such weather. Campers are advised to prepare for the likelihood of rain whilst staying within any campground on Mount Panorama, as it is likely to rain at some stage during their stay.

GENERAL

Q. Can I book multiple campsites?

A. Yes – multiple sites can be booked – refer to "How to book a campsite" document on our website.

Q. Can my mates and I book campsites next to each other?

A. Yes - you will need to review what is available for sale and choose from the maps provided.

Q. Can I bring glass into the campgrounds?

A. <u>NO GLASS</u> is to be brought into the campgrounds, other than glass jars 200mls or under in size containing spreads or food preserves.

Q. Can I buy ice at the campgrounds?

Supercars will communicate the official ice supplier in May, 2024

Q. Can I bring my own food?

A. Yes. There is also a range of food and beverage outlets throughout the event. Details to be communicated in September. 2024

Q. Can I bring a generator?

A. Yes, generators are allowed within campgrounds however they must be turned off from midnight – 7am each day out of respect for your neighbours.

To reduce the risk of wildfire;

- Never use generators during fire bans.
- Place the generator in an area clear of fuels, dry grass or other combustible material.
- Ensure extension leads do not cross access tracks and are rated for external use.
- Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for safe operation of your generator.
- Only operate generators in well ventilated areas outside of tents and sleeping spaces.
- Never leave your generator unattended whilst in operation.

Q. How much fuel can I take in for my generator?

A. A 20L drum of fuel for your personal generator is the maximum amount permitted to enter the event precinct per day.

Q. Can I bring a BBQ to my campsite?

A. Yes, provided it remains on your campsite for the duration of your stay. Gas bottles must be no heavier than 9kg (inclusive of the weight of the gas) and must NOT be expired.

Q. Are gas cookers allowed?

A. Yes, personal gas cookers are allowed in campgrounds. Please note that;

- Gas bottles must be no heavier than 9kg (inclusive of the weight of the gas) and must NOT be expired.
- Your equipment must be in good working order.
- Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for safe operation of your gas cooker.
- Never light a gas cooker inside your tent or in any other enclosed area.

Q. Can I bring my pet to the campgrounds?

A. Only assistance animals (as defined under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* (Cth)) will be permitted onto the campgrounds. No other pets are allowed on the campgrounds.

Q. Can I bring fireworks into the event venue?

A. No fireworks or explosives of any kind may be brought into the Repco Bathurst 1000 event precinct, including the campgrounds.

Q. Can I bring my drone?

A. No. Aerial drones and unmanned aerial vehicles are not to be taken into the campgrounds.

Q. What furniture can I have on my campsite?

A. Temporary foldout chairs are permitted; however, no couches or lounge chairs are permitted into the campsite.

Q. Can I move my vehicle to come and go from the campgrounds and drive into town?

A. Yes, you may exit and re-enter the campgrounds as you please however please be aware that each time your re-enter your vehicle will be searched by security at the entry gate.

Q. Is a shuttle bus service available?

A. There are several shuttle services available. Please refer to the "Getting There" section of the Event website <u>www.supercars.com</u> for details.

Q. I am planning on hiring a van and they are delivering it to the campground. How do they get access?

A. Please email the camping team from June 1, 2024 and advise your campground and campsite number. We will you with a letter to send to the van owner which will allow them access. Note, they can only deliver during check in hours and all vans / motorhomes must have left the campgrounds by 12 midday Monday October 14, 2024.
