CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “REPCO BATHURST 1000” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 30 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Mount Panorama Circuit, Bathurst, New South Wales on 4th – 9th October 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Anti- Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 34
- 1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located on the ground floor of Tower 3, facing the Supercars Paddock.
- 1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located on the 2nd floor of Tower 3.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 All additional Drivers (including additional Drivers of Wildcard entries) are required to be nominated using the additional Driver nomination form no later than Wednesday 14th September 2022.
- 2.1.2.1 All additional Drivers along with the Primary Driver are required to be entered into the portal in the Event/ Car registration section.
 - 2.1.2.2 All additional Drivers are required to upload their insurance, ASN Licence and Car Club to their portal profile no later than Wednesday 14th September 2022.
- 2.1.3 Administration checking will commence at **1200hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 5th October 2022.

- 2.1.4 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.5 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 5th October 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 Team Transporters are permitted to enter the VCS paddock at **0830hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 4th October.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **1000hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 4th October 2022 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time. Offending Cars will be reported to the Stewards.

3.2 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PITS AND PADDOCK

- 3.2.1 Transporter tailgates / tail lifts are not permitted to be in operation from 60 minutes prior to the first on-track activity and until conclusion of the final Session each day as per the Event Program. **Rule E2.6.1.5** applies.

3.3 MOTORHOME ACCREDITATION & ACCESS

- 3.3.1 At this Event and upon written application to Motorsport Operations – Motorhomes **strictly for the use of Supercars Team Personnel only (No Sponsors or Activations)** will be permitted to be parked in the Supercars paddock but must not exceed 26m in length and must fit on the right-hand side of the Teams transporter. Motorhomes that are found to be sub-let to any other person other than a Supercars Driver will be removed from the paddock.
- 3.3.1.1 Applications close at **1700hrs** Thursday 29th September.
- 3.3.1.2 Each approved motorhome will be provided an accreditation sticker that must be affixed to the front windscreen prior to parking up.
- 3.3.2 Approved and accredited Team motorhomes arriving prior to **1430hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 5th October 2022 will not be allocated a holding area within the Event precinct. If you are requiring a place to park, the rear of the main general admission carpark will be the least congested location.
- 3.3.2.1 On Wednesday 5th October 2022 once all VCS Transporters have returned and are re-parked following the Transporter parade, Teams motorhome's will be permitted to enter and park in their allocated position in the VCS Paddock.
- 3.3.3 All motorhomes are required to be parked in position in the VCS paddock no later than **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 5th October 2022.
- 3.3.3.1 Once the motorhome is parked in position in the VCS Paddock, it cannot be moved from its allocated position until two (2) hours following race 30 on Sunday 9th October 2022.

- 3.3.4 **MOTORHOME ACCESS:** via Mountain Straight Gate (gate 2). This gate is only accessible when there are no motoracing activities taking place on the racing circuit.
- 3.3.5 All visitors to the motorhome must have approved accreditation on person from Thursday 6th October to access the VCS paddock.
- 3.3.6 All Motorhomes must abide by **Supplementary Regulation 4.8.**

3.4 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.4.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.4.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Thursday 6th October 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.4.2 Four (4) tickets will be allocated to each additional Driver, these will be automatically included in your accreditation FOC allocation.
- 3.4.3 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each VCS Car will receive four (4) Priority Parking passes to park in the Priority Car Park located directly in front of the general admission Main Gate (as per 2019). Then walk over the pedestrian bridge into the VCS Paddock. Please follow the directions of the Traffic Controllers to be parked.
- 3.4.3.1 All car park passes must be displayed from **0500hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 6th October 2022 for the duration of the Event. **No Car Pass No Access.**
- 3.4.4 Additional car parking is available in the general admission car park at the Main Gate.
- 3.4.5 VCS Team catering supplies are required to be delivered into the VCS paddock outside Event operating hours.
- 3.4.5.1 Each Team will receive one (1) Supercars Paddock Transit Pass (to be used after hours only). Access is via the Mountain Straight gate (Gate 2). Cars parked inside the Circuit during Event hours will be reported to the Stewards.
- 3.4.6 **Grid Walk Pass collection** – To be collected from the Accreditation Centre.
- 3.4.7 **NO** vehicles are permitted in the VCS Paddock from **0800hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 4th October. Offending Cars will be reported to the Stewards.

3.5 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.5.1 The Accreditation Centre location will be confirmed in *Further Supplementary Regulations.*
- 3.5.2 The Accreditation Centre will be open as per below **(AEDT):**

- 3.5.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collection by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticketek Box Office located at the **Main Gate** (in an envelope with the collector's name). The Box Office will be open approx. 30min ahead of gates opening on Thursday – Sunday.

3.6 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.6.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 5th October 2022 between **1200hrs** and **1700hrs (AEDT)**. Teams are reminded that the race track is a public road during this period and to keep to the side of the road at all times.

3.7 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.7.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.7.2 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to two (2) hours after the completion of **race 30** on Sunday 9th October 2022.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the New South Wales Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified in the ~~Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements.

4.7 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- 4.7.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

4.8 WASTE PRODUCTS

- 4.8.1 All personnel must be made aware of the fact the NO waste of any nature may be tipped into the storm water drains located with the support compound.
- 4.8.2 All storm water drains lead directly to the Macquarie River and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will be monitoring the situation in the lead up and throughout the Event.
- 4.8.3 This ban includes the washing of any wheel rims within the vicinity of storm water drains.
- 4.8.4 Competitors are advised that the EPA is taking an extremely proactive approach to this matter and Teams are put on notice that any infringement of this directive will result in action being taken by either the Promoter or the EPA or both. The EPA has the ability to prosecute offenders with heavy penalties.
- 4.8.5 The Promoter has provided an area for disposal of waste oil and/or fluid products that are located near the Circuit fuel bund. This is not for the disposal of used Car parts (i.e. oil filters etc.)

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.1.1 The Event operating hours (**AEDT**), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

- 5.1.1.1 Wednesday 5th October 2022 * 1500 – 1700 (volunteer party)
- 5.1.1.2 Thursday 6th October 2022 0700 – 1700
- 5.1.1.3 Friday 7th October 2022 0700 – 1700
- 5.1.1.4 Saturday 8th October 2022 0700 – 1800
- 5.1.1.5 Sunday 9th October 2022 0630 – end of R30

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.1.2**.

* **Note** – Garage doors are required to be open for the Volunteer Party in Pitlane.

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.2.1 In accordance with **Rule D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Bathurst: <http://www.bom.gov.au/places/nsw/bathurst/>

5.3 BRIEFINGS

5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 5th October 2022 in the large Grey Shed, immediately to the rear of Gate 2.

5.3.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1815hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 6th October 2022 in the large Grey Shed, immediately to the rear of Gate 2.

5.4 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION, USAGE, ORDER AND PAYMENT

5.4.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D17.7.8**.

5.4.2 At this Event, delete **Rule D17.7.9**.

5.5 PIT BAY MARKINGS

5.5.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:

- 5.5.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the right-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.6m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.5.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.6 FRONT BRAKE ROTOR RESTRICTIONS

5.6.1 At this Event, the front brake rotor restrictions will be as per **Rule D20.1.1.3**:

- 5.6.1.1 For the Bathurst 1000 Event and subject to **Rule D20.1.1.1**, each Car will be allocated a maximum of five (5) sets of front brake rotors, a maximum of three (3) sets permitted to be new.
- 5.6.1.2 During practice Sessions 1 – 6, Teams will be permitted to use up to two (2) sets of pre marked CP6281 or CP8184 front brake rotors.
- 5.6.1.3 During all Sessions, Teams will be permitted to use up to three (3) sets of new CP6281 front brake rotors and pads.
- 5.6.1.4 For qualifying, warm-up and race 30, only the three (3) sets of new CP6281 front brake rotors and pads are permitted to be used.

5.7 PRACTICE

- 5.7.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1, 3, 4 and 6.
- 5.7.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2 and 5.
- 5.7.3 The Stewards may, in their absolute discretion, order that a Driver who has not completed a suitable number of laps in practice 1, 3, 4 or 6 combined, be required to drive the Car in another Session or Sessions. This decision of the Stewards is not susceptible to appeal.
- 5.7.4 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during practice 4 and 6.
 - 5.7.4.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
 - 5.7.4.2 During practice 4 and 6, Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay.
 - 5.7.4.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
 - 5.7.4.4 At the conclusion of the practice Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to parallel park in their pit bay.

5.8 WARM-UP

- 5.8.1 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during the warm-up Session on Sunday 9th October 2022.
 - 5.8.1.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
 - 5.8.1.2 Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay;
 - 5.8.1.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
 - 5.8.1.4 At the conclusion of the warm-up Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to parallel park in their pit bay.
 - 5.8.1.5 Refuelling Towers are permitted to remain setup and in position for race 31 following warm up.

5.9 TOP TEN SHOOTOUT

- 5.9.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D6.3.7.3** and replace with the following:
 - D6.3.7.3 Unless directed otherwise by the Race Director over RMC, the Competitor of each further Car competing in the Session is to ensure their Car is at the Pit Exit prior to the preceding Car receiving the green flag to commence its timed lap.
 - a) If the Race Director gives a contrary direction, it is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure their Car is at the Pit Exit by the nominated time to commence its timed lap.

5.10 PERSONNEL

- 5.10.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.2**:
 - D11.2.2 For each ~~500/600 refuelling Event~~ and Endurance Event, each Car may be attended by a maximum of nine (9) people (the "Designated Pit Crew") as follows, who are permitted across the Prescribed Line when carrying out any Pit Stop in any race:
 - 11.2.2.1 One (1) Car Controller
 - 11.2.2.2 One (1) Air Jack Operator
 - 11.2.2.3 One (1) Refueler/Vent Attendant
 - 11.2.2.4 One (1) Fire Attendant
 - 11.2.2.5 Five (5) Other Team members
- 5.10.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.9**:
 - D11.2.9 ~~Four (4)~~ Five (5) Other Team Persons
 - D11.2.9.1 Will be responsible for the service of the Car under the direction of the Car Controller.

5.10.3 At this Event, delete **Rule D11.2.11.1** and replace with the following:

D11.2.11.1 A Driver nominated with the Car may assist the exiting Driver to leave the Car and the incoming Driver to enter and be properly seated in the Car.

5.11 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

5.11.1 For this Event, note the amendments to the following Rules: **D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2, D8.3.2.1, D8.3.3 and D8.3.3.1:**

D8.3.1 ~~Thirty~~ Forty Minutes:

D8.3.1.1 When ~~30~~ 40 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.2 ~~Twenty-Five~~ Thirty-Five Minutes:

D8.3.2.1 When ~~25~~ 35 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.3 ~~Fifteen~~ Twenty-Five minutes:

D8.3.3.1 When ~~45~~ 25 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

5.12 PIT STOPS

5.12.1 For race **30** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.12.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events.**

a) In addition to above CPS requirements, a compulsory front brake rotor change is required between, commencing lap 55 and ending lap 120.

5.12.1.2 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.12.1.3 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

5.13 PIT STOPS – DRIVER CHANGE

5.13.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.

5.14 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – EXTRA FORMATION LAP

5.14.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.6.1.9.**

5.15 SC DEPLOYMENT DURING A RACE

5.15.1 At this Event, refer to **Appendix 1.** which details **Rule D10.2 SC Deployment During a Race** in its entirety with the amendments to this Rule marked up.

5.16 SUSPENDING A RACE – RED FLAG

5.16.1 For this Event, in the instance of a suspended race due to red flag, the following will occur:

5.16.1.1 Cars one (1) or more laps behind the leader will be recorded in accordance with **Rule D9.1.3.4.**

5.16.1.2 Should however, the SC be already deployed, Cars one (1) or more laps behind the leader will be recorded in accordance with **Rule D10.2.2.6** and the race restarted in accordance with **Rule D10.2.9.**

5.17 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.17.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
5.17.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.18 CARS TO CARRY VIDEO RECORDERS

- 5.18.1 Further to **Rule D21.3.14**, SD cards must be cleared and reformatted prior to the 40-minute signal for race 30 on Sunday 9th October 2022, however, must not be cleared prior to 30 minutes after the completion of Sunday's warm up, without the prior written permission of the HOM.
5.18.1.1 Each Team is required to ensure the SD card fitted to their Car is of sufficient size to record the entire race. It is suggested the camera settings should be set to record at a screen resolution of 720 and a frame rate of 60 FPS.

5.19 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.19.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.
5.19.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.

CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

6.1 MINIMUM WEIGHT

- 6.1.1 At this Event, note the following amendments to **Rule C4.1**:
- C4.1.1 The minimum weight of a Car is 1400 kg and will include the weight of the Driver wearing their complete Driver's apparel as detailed in **Rule D23.3**, as recorded by the HoM, or with the Driver on board.
C4.1.1.1 The HoM reserves the right to reweigh the Driver at any point during the Season.
- C.4.1.2 At each Endurance Event the following will apply:
- C.4.1.2.1 The minimum weight of 1400kg applies to any Driver who takes part in any Qualifying session.
- C.4.1.2.2 For all other Sessions the minimum weight applies only to the Primary Driver.
- C4.1.3 The minimum front axle weight of a Car is 755 kg, and will be measured as follows:
C4.1.3.1 at the front axle centreline; and
C4.1.3.2 with the Driver wearing their complete Driver's apparel on board; or
C4.1.3.3 with weights placed in the seat to replicate the Driver's recorded weight.
- C4.1.4 The minimum weights stated in **Rules C4.1.1, C4.1.2, C4.1.3** and **C4.1.4** must be achieved both during and immediately after any Competition at an Event, with the exception that during any Competition in which refuelling is permitted, the minimum weights must be achieved without fuel.
- C4.1.5 Supercars reserves the right at all times to amend the weights of Cars in the interests of equitable Competition.

6.2 MINIMUM WEIGHT

6.2.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1:**

6.2.1.1 All Wildcard Primary Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 1 on Thursday 6th October 2022, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

6.2.1.2 All additional Drivers (including Wildcard additional Drivers) that have not competed in a race of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2 on Thursday 6th October 2022, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

CHAPTER 7 -MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.1.1.1 Activities are to be conducted in accordance with Team WHS COVID-19 management procedures and the Promoter's COVID-19 management procedures.

7.2 GRID WALKS

7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks will be permitted (subject to COVID restrictions).
