CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "BUNNINGS TRADE PERTH SUPERNIGHT" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise of race 10, 11 and 12 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Wanneroo Raceway, Wanneroo, Perth on 28th April to 1st May 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 TEAM COMMUNICATION WITH OFFICIALS

2.1.1 At this Event, Team personnel are not permitted to conduct business outside their garage. For avoidance of doubt, unless specifically given instruction to do so; Team personnel will not be permitted access (including but not limited to) the Supercars Operations Truck, the Stewards Office, the DSA Office, RD Office, DRD Office, Race Control and Event Operations Office.

2.2 ENTRIES

- 2.2.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.2.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (AWST)** on Friday 29th April 2022.
- 2.2.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers Briefing as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.2.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1600hrs (AWST)** on Friday 29th April 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.







2.3 SUBJECT OF AN INVESTIGATION NOT TO LEAVE THE EVENT

2.3.1 At this Event, delete **Rule B2.3.1** and replace with the following:

<u>B2.3.1</u> Any Driver and/or Authorised Representative of a Competitor who has received written notification from the RD or DRD that such Driver or Competitor of their Car has been involved in any Incident that is the subject of an Investigation by the RD or DRD must not leave the precincts of the Event unless that Driver and/or Authorised Representative has first obtained the permission of the Stewards.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 Transporters must enter the Supercars Paddock between **1400hrs and 1600hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 28th April 2022 and all movements must be with the prior approval of the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.4 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.5 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
 - 3.2.1.1 Promoter issued Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 29th April 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
 - 3.2.1.2 All accreditation and tickets will be scanned upon entry to the Event.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car will be allocated 3 x car passes for Car Park B on the outside of the Circuit.
 - 3.2.2.1 Each VCS Team will receive one (1) Transit Pass for the purpose of delivering catering supplies to the Team garage. Deliveries are required to take place outside of Event Operating Hours. Under no circumstances are vehicles to be parked anywhere other than outside the venue once the delivery is completed.
- 3.2.3 Pit Walk Pass collection Passes must be collected at the Accreditation Centre each morning of the pit walk. (They are not to be collected at the Supercars Ops Truck).

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at **Gate 3** via Wattle Avenue East.
- 3.3.2 The Accreditation Centre operating hours will be updated in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*.

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Friday 29th April between **1615hrs and 1745hrs (AWST).**







3.5 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

- 3.5.1 Bump in (Thursday) Circuit access will be via **Gate 1** (Wattle Ave East).
- 3.5.2 Event Days (Friday Sunday) Supercars Series Accreditation will permit Team access to the Circuit and VCS Paddock through **Gate 9** (via Mather Drive) from **0730hrs (AWST)**. Access prior to **0730hrs** is via **Gate 1**.

3.6 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

3.6.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.7 GOLF BUGGIES

3.7.1 All Golf Buggies must be road registered.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the West Australian State Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
 - E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified in the Event Supplementary Regulations by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements. This person should be nominated on the Notification of Performance Personnel Form (**Rule D24**).

4.2 MEDICAL SERVICES

4.2.1 Operating Hours and location will be updated in Further Supplementary Regulations.

4.3 PADDOCK WHS

- 4.3.1 Neither fuel or tyres are permitted to be carried across the pedestrian bridge.
- 4.3.2 The pedestrian bridge will be closed for all race starts and for the race 12 chequered flag.
- 4.3.3 Only oil can be placed in the waste oil drums at the Raceway. Oil filters, coolant, brake and power steering fluids must be disposed of at the competitor's cost at a government approved collection centre. For further information see www.oilrecycling.gov.au.

4.8 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- 4.8.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 4.8.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

- 5.1.1 The Event operating hours **(AWST)**, for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:
 - 5.1.1.1 Saturday 30th April 2022

0730 - end of VCS R10

5.1.1.2 Sunday 1st May 2022

0700 - end of VCS R12

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.1.2**.

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.3 BRIEFINGS

5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers Briefing** will be held at **0900 (AWST)** on Saturday 30th April 2022 in the WASCC Media Centre – North, located on the first floor above the race office.

5.4 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.4.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
 - 5.4.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.0m from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
 - 5.4.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.







5.5 SPECIFIC PRESCRITIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

- 5.5.1 At this Event, note the following amendments to **Rule D6.2.3.1 a):**
 - <u>D6.2.3.1</u> This Session will commence as per the following:
 - <u>a)</u> Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) twelve (12) minutes of the Session all Cars take part. At the end of Q1, the twenty (20) fastest Cars in order will be permitted to continue to Q2. The remaining Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times of the twenty (20) fastest Cars will then be deleted.

5.6 PIT STOPS

- 5.6.1 For races **10**, **11** and **12** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 5.6.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.6.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 5.6.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.6.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 5.6.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.7 PENALTIES FOR KERB INFRINGEMENTS

- 5.7.1 At this Event, in respect to turn 7 only, delete **Rule B7.6.1.1** and replace with the following: B7.6.1.1 During any practice and qualifying session:
 - <u>a)</u> That lap time <u>and the subsequent lap time</u> will be disallowed.

5.8 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.8.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System <u>will</u> be operational.
 - 5.8.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.9 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.9.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with Rule C4.1 and Rule C4.2.
 - 5.9.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.
