## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SUPERCARS

### CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

#### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “WATPAC TOWNSVILLE 400” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise races 17 and 18 of the 2019 International Virgin Australia Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at the Reid Park Circuit, Townsville, Queensland on 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

#### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

## 1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

- 1.5.1 **Track Length:** 2.86 kilometres
- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 32
- 1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located outside the Secretary of the Event's office, adjacent to the race control complex.
- 1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located adjacent to the race control complex.
- 1.5.6 **DRD Office:** Located adjacent to the race control complex.
- 1.5.7 **Control Line:** Located at the Finish Line and across Pit Exit.

## CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

### 2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0830hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1730hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

### 2.2 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

- 2.2.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:  
A4.3.3.1 *I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on*

*this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.*

*Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:*

- to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;*
- in the opinion of the ~~Sporting & Technical Director~~ Head of Motorsport, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.*

## 2.3 HEARINGS

- 2.3.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:  
B3.11.1 After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule ~~B8.2~~ B7.2 impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

## CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

### 3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 At the direction of the Paddock Manager, Transporters are permitted to enter the paddock at **1230hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **1430hrs (AEST)** or once all Supercars transporters are in their park up position after the transporter parade.
- 3.1.5 With exception to Team caterers who are permitted to deliver supplies, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019.

### 3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated one (1) VIP car pass and three (3) Team Car Passes to park in the Townsville High School Car Park, access via First Street. The VIP pass will permit parking at the front of the car park.
- 3.2.4 Each **Team caterer** will be allocated one (1) transit car pass and will be permitted to enter the paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies.

- 3.2.4.1 All deliveries must be completed between the hours of **1900hrs – 0630hrs (AEST)**.
- 3.2.4.2 Once deliveries are completed, cars must not park in the paddock, but in Townsville High School car park using the allocated Team Car Pass.

### **3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS**

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located on First Street at Townsville State High School (Stanton Lodge).
- 3.3.2 The accreditation centre will be open at the following times **(AEST)**:
  - 3.3.2.1 Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 1200 – 1700
  - 3.3.2.2 Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July 0900 – 1700
  - 3.3.2.3 Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 0630 – 1530
  - 3.3.2.4 Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> July 0600 – 1900
  - 3.3.2.5 Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July 0600 – 1430

### **3.4 RACE TRACK WALK**

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2019 between **1300hrs** and **1500hrs (AEST)**.
- 3.4.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

### **3.5 TEAM ACCESS TO CIRCUIT DURING EVENT**

- 3.5.1 All Series Accreditation must use the VIP Gate located inside the Townsville High School car park to access the Event, this gate will be open from **0630hrs (AEST)** each day of the Event.

### **3.6 GOLF BUGGIES**

- 3.6.1 No golf buggies are permitted in the paddock. All buggies must park on the outside of paddock Gate 2, which is the gate at the rear of the paddock, unless otherwise approved by the Motorsport Operations Manager.
- 3.6.2 Any person that is planning on using a golf buggy in the venue will need to complete the Site Vehicle Requirements Form and return it to the Accreditation Centre to register their buggy. If approved, a sticker will be allocated for the buggy, which must be displayed at all times across the Event.

### **3.7 STORAGE**

- 3.7.1 Fuel drums are not permitted to be stored directly next to each other.
- 3.7.2 It is not permitted to store anything under the stairs that lead up to the corporate facilities above the Pit Lane.

### **3.8 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT**

- 3.8.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **0730hrs (AEST)** on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

### 3.9 DRIVER'S BATH WATER

- 3.9.1 Teams are not permitted to drain Driver's bath water at any time into the Paddock. Coates Hire will be draining Driver's bath water from **1715hrs (AEST)** on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July at no charge to Teams. Teams that require this service must email Motorsport Operations by 28 June 2019. Baths should be setup towards the prime mover end.

## CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

### 4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located at pit entry and will be operational during the following times: **(AEST)**:

### 4.6 DELIVERIES AND ACCESS BY NON-ENDORSED EVENT SUPPLIERS

- 4.6.1 It is the Team's responsibility to ensure any service providers/contractors they engage who are not an endorsed supplier, have the correct accreditation to access the venue and any applicable site safety induction is completed.

### 4.7 TRUCK WASHING

- 4.7.1 Teams are not permitted to wash their transporters at the Circuit.  
4.7.2 Truck washing facilities are available at Big Boys, Webb Drive, The Bohle (07) 4774 6634.

## 4.8 HEALTH AND SAFETY

- 4.8.1 In line with the Queensland Health and Safety Act, the Supercars paddock will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

## 4.9 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.9.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.9.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 4.9.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 4.9.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 4.9.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

### 5.1 MARKINGS ON CARS

- 5.1.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:  
**E1.6.2.3** The surnames of each Driver must be
- a) Height: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: ~~400~~ 80mm  
Endurance Events: ~~50~~ 35mm
  - b) Font: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: Helvetica Bold  
Condensed Endurance Events: Helvetica Bold  
Condensed
  - c) Position: Lower edge of each rear door window.
- 5.1.2 Delete **reference 2, 4 and 8.** in **Schedule E1 Markings on Cars** in its entirety and replace with the below:

## 5.6 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

- 5.6.1 For race 17 and race 18, replace **Rule D8.3, D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2, D8.3.2.1, D8.3.3 and D8.3.3.1** only, noting the updates double-underlined:

### D8.3                      **Specific Prescriptions – 30 35 minute Start Procedure**

D8.3.1    Thirty -Five minutes

D8.3.1.1                                      When 30 35 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.2    ~~Twenty-Five~~ Thirty minutes

D8.3.2.1                                      When 25 30 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.3    ~~Fifteen~~ Twenty minutes

D8.3.3.1                                      When 15 20 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

- 5.6.2 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.3.2.4** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D8.3.2.4                      Team members may then approach the Car.

D8.3.2.4.1                      Team trolleys are required to be positioned directly behind the rear of the Car and perpendicular to the track direction.

## 5.7 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

- 5.7.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D10.2.13                      Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.

**D10.2.13.1** Should a SC deployment end eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

## 5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE

5.8.1 Delete Rule **D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D11.5.2.1** Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule ~~D8.1.8~~ D8.1.6 and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

## 5.9 PIT STOPS

5.9.1 For race 17 and race 18, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.9.1.1 Each Car must complete the one (1) CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.

5.9.1.2 A Car may only ~~complete~~ perform a its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.

5.9.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.9.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

5.9.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.9.2 For this Event, delete Rule **D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D11.8.8** During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, the brake lock mechanism must be engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.

**D11.8.8.1** Where the HoM grants such approval, the rear wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the rear wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.

**D11.8.8.2** During any Pit Stop, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

## 5.10 POINT SCORE

5.10.1 Delete Rule **D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D14.1.5** Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final Classification of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

## 5.11 CONTROL TYRES

5.11.1 Delete Rule **D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D17.1.15** It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.



## 5.12 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

- 5.12.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.
- 5.12.2 All marked front discs count towards **Rule D19.1**.

## 5.13 FUEL RIGS

- 5.13.1 Fuel rigs are not permitted to be stored in pit lane.

## CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

### 6.1 SCRUTINEERING

- 6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0830hrs (AEST)** on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

## CHAPTER 7 -MARKETING

### 7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

### 7.2 GRID WALK

- 7.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.
- 7.2.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid sticker.
