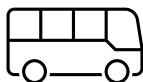

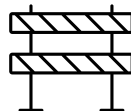

### WORKS ON ROADS

#### GC500 Race Circuit

From **5:00am Monday 20 October** all roads within the GC500 circuit will convert to one-way (anti-clockwise). Traffic control will direct all vehicles in this single direction - no exceptions.

**Friday 24 to Sunday 26 October** the roads within the major event area will be closed for the GC500 event period.

#### Gold Coast Highway

##### **Monday 20 October to Tuesday 28 October**

Gold Coast Highway will be adjusted as follows;

- One lane northbound traffic
- One lane southbound traffic
- One emergency lane (From Wednesday 23rd)

#### The Esplanade

##### **Monday 20 October to Monday 27 October**

Traffic north of Staghorn Avenue will be one-way northbound to enable construction activities.

#### Surfers Paradise

##### **Tuesday 21 October to Monday 27 October**

Traffic diversions will be in place at Budds Beach, Palm Ave, Pine Ave, Norfolk Ave, and Britt Ave.

#### Ocean Ave

##### **Wednesday 22 October to Sunday 26 October**

Partial lane closure in effect.

### COMMUNITY UPDATE – Continued Event Build Works

Public access to the Major Event Area will be closed from 24 – 26 October to facilitate the delivery of the Supercars Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500 .

Access outside of event days;

#### Works in Macintosh Island & Helen Park

From Monday 15 September to Friday 8 November 2025, pedestrian access from Admiralty Drive into Macintosh Island Park will be restricted. During this period, access will be available via the northern and southern underpasses at Paradise Waters.

Pedestrian access will be maintained with appropriate diversions in place to ensure safety and continued access to the light rail station. The playground and public amenities within Macintosh Island Park will remain open.

#### Works in Narrowneck Park & the Oceanway Footpath

Construction of grandstand and corporate viewing structures will continue along the Oceanway footpath. Pedestrians will be diverted to the western path along Main Beach Parade for the duration of these works.

#### Works on The Esplanade

Installation of temporary fencing, portable buildings and marquees will continue along The Esplanade.

#### Seaway Car Park

Additional parking bays will be utilised for construction activities and event-based operations.

#### Cypress Avenue Carpark

The entirety of Cypress Avenue Carpark will be occupied for event based operations from Friday 17 October to Tuesday 28 October.

#### Traffic Management

Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of all road users, pedestrians, cyclists and workers. Beach access in the area will remain open throughout the works.
