Matters from Race 2:

Race Director Incident Determinations

During the Race, the Race Director investigated the incident involving Car #5, Thomas Randle, at Turn 2 and determined the incident did not warrant referral to the Stewards as there was no breach of the rules.

After the Race, the Race Director investigated Car #33's pit stop and determined that the incident did not warrant referral to the Stewards as there was no breach of the rules.

Stewards' Decisions – Penalties imposed

Following a Stewards Hearing and finding of a breach of parc ferme rules, the Stewards disqualified Car #10, Brenton Grove, and Car #55, Kurt KostECKi, from Race 2.

Matters from Race 1:

Race Director Incident Determinations

The Incident involving Car #38, Will Brown, and Car #57, Brodie Kostecki, was reviewed and it was determined the matter did not warrant referral to the Stewards.

Stewards' Decisions – Penalties imposed

Following a post-race investigation and an admission of Reckless Driving by Kurt Kostecki (incident involving Car #5, Thomas Randle) the Stewards imposed the penalty of the loss of 35 Championship Points on Kurt Kostecki.
