CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "BETEASY DARWIN TRIPLE CROWN" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise races 15 and 16 of the 2019 International Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Hidden Valley Raceway, Darwin, Northern Territory on 14th – 16th June 2019.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0830hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 13th June 2019.
 - 2.1.2.1 Wildcard Drivers are required to present their licensing in accordance with Rule A5.1 including a valid Car Club Membership to the Supercars Operations Truck by 1700hrs (ACST) on Thursday 13th June 2019.
 - 2.1.2.2 Wildcard Drivers are required to sign the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form by **1700hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 13th June 2019.







- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 13th June 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

2.2.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

A4.3.3.1 I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.

Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:

- to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;
- in the opinion of the Sporting & Technical Director Head of Motorsport, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.

2.3 HEARINGS

2.3.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>B3.11.1</u> After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule <u>B8.2 B7.2</u> impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 There will be no parking available inside the Hidden Valley Motorsport Complex for Transporters arriving early.
- 3.1.3 At the direction of the Paddock Manager, Transporters are permitted to enter the paddock and park up 90 degrees to the garages between **1600hrs** and **1800hrs** (**ACST**) on Tuesday 11th June 2019 and from **0800hrs** (**ACST**) on Wednesday 12th June 2019.
- 3.1.4 Catering equipment only is permitted to be unloaded at **0800hrs (ACST)** on Wednesday 12th June 2019.







- 3.1.5 Remainder of Transporter unload is not permitted until **0830hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 13th June 2019 unless otherwise approved by the Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.6 With exception to Team caterers who are permitted to deliver supplies, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs (ACST)** on Wednesday 12th June 2019.

3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Thursday 14th June 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated four (4) car passes for CP5 (Teams Car Park) located behind the support paddock garages. Only Event issued car passes will be accepted.
- 3.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated one (1) CP5 car pass and will be permitted to enter the paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies. These cars must not park in the paddock, but in CP5 (Teams Car Park).

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 Accreditation Centres are located at Gate 4 and Entrance B.
- 3.3.2 The accreditation centre will be open at the following times (ACST):

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 13th June 2019 between **1200hrs** and **1700hrs (ACST)**.
- 3.4.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

3.5 TEAM ACCESS TO CIRCUIT DURING EVENT

3.5.1 All Series Accreditation, including all Promoter issued accreditation and car passes (CP2, CP3, CP5, CP6, CP7), must use Entrance B (via Marlow Road) to access the Event during the following hours (ACST):

3.5.1.1	Friday 14 th June	0600 - 1800
3.5.1.2	Saturday 15 th June	0600 - 2100
3.5.1.3	Sunday 16 th June	0600 - 2100

3.5.1.4 Outside of these hours access is via the Security Checkpoint at Entrance A.

3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.6.1 All golf buggies must be road registered and meet roadworthy requirements.
- 3.6.2 Any vehicles/golf buggies/quad bikes not registered will need to apply for temporary registration (fees apply) issued through Northern Territory's Department of Transport's Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR).
- 3.6.3 No buggy movements are permitted at any time between the rear of transporters and Team Garages.







DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT 3.7

- 3.7.1 Unless otherwise advised by Supercars, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to 1800hrs (ACST) on Sunday 16th June 2019.
- 3.7.2 Transporters are only permitted to depart the Hidden Valley Motorsport Complex via Entrance B, Marlow Road between 1800hrs and 2100hrs (ACST) on Sunday 16th June 2019.
- All remaining transporters will be permitted to depart Hidden Valley Motorsport Complex 3.7.3 after 2100hrs (ACST) using Entrance A, via the internal road of the complex.

3.8 **DRIVER'S BATH WATER**

3.8.1 Teams are not permitted to drain Driver's bath water at any time into the Paddock. All baths are required to be drained using the promoter organised water truck. This truck is scheduled to commence draining at 1700hrs (ACST) on Sunday 16th June 2019.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

MEDICAL SERVICES 4.1

4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located on the far side of the marshalling area near the TV compound and will be operational during the following times: (ACST):

4.6 DELIVERIES AND ACCESS BY NON-ENDORSED EVENT SUPPLIERS

4.6.1 It is the Team's responsibility to ensure any service providers/contractors they engage who are not an endorsed supplier, have the correct accreditation to access the venue and any applicable site safety induction is completed.

4.7 TRUCK WASHING

- 4.7.1 Truck wash downs are not permitted in the Supercars paddock or at the Circuit.
- 4.7.2 There is a truck washing facility at the Territory Transit Bus Depot, Corner Armidale and Illiffe Streets, Stuart Park 0820.
 - 4.7.2.1 The facility will be available on Tuesday 11th and Wednesday 12th June from **0930 1430 (ACST)**. Teams are asked to make a \$20 donation for the use of the facility, which will be donated to a charity nominated by the bus drivers. Please note that a brief induction will need to be undertaken and high-vis to be worn.

4.8 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.8.1 In line with the Northern Territory Health and Safety Act, there are two (2) Designated Smoking Areas allocated within the Paddock. Smoking is only permitted in these areas and will be sign posted.

4.9 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.9.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.9.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 4.9.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 4.9.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 4.9.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 PITS AND PADDOCK

- 5.1.1 For this Event, delete **Rule E3.2.4.1** and replace with the following:
 - E3.2.4.1 If positioned above the ground, they must be placed at a minimum height to the maximum height of the transporter of 6 meters above the ground.

5.2 MARKINGS ON CARS

5.2.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:

E1.6.2.3 The surnames of each Driver must be

5.3 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

5.3.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **0900hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 13th June 2019 in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.

5.4 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.4.1 The Event operating hours (ACST) for the purpose of Rule E2 are as follows:

5.4.1.1 Friday 14th June 0815 – 1600

5.4.1.2 Saturday 15th June 0810 – after VCS Race 15 5.4.1.3 Sunday 16th June 0800 – after VCS Race 16

5.5 BRIEFINGS

- 5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs** (ACST) on Thursday 13th June 2019 in the Media Briefing Area located adjacent to the Paddock Offices.
- 5.5.2 A briefing for all **Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1615hrs (ACST)** on Friday 14th June 2019 in the in the Media Briefing Area located adjacent to the Paddock Offices.

5.6 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.6.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Berrimah: http://www.bom.gov.au./places/nt/berrimah/

5.7 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

5.7.1 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of the Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 15 will be determined by the final classification of practice 2.







- 5.7.2 Delete Rule **D6.2.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) minutes of the Session only the bottom fourteen (14) fifteen (15) Cars in order of the final classification from the practice Session designated in the Supplementary Regulations will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q1, the slowest ten (10) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the four (4) five (5) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
- 5.7.3 Delete Rule **D6.2.2.2** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - Qualifying Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars in order of the final classification from the practice Session designated in the Supplementary Regulations and the top four (4) five (5) Cars from Q1 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q2, the slowest four (4) five (5) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) remaining Cars will then be deleted.

5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – 30 MINUTE START PROCEDURE

- 5.8.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.3.2.4** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - **D8.3.2.4** Team members may then approach the Car.
 - **D8.3.2.4.1** Team trolleys are required to be positioned directly behind the rear of the Car and perpendicular to the track direction.

5.9 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

- 5.9.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>Prior</u> to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.
 - Should the SC be deployed eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

5.10 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS - PIT LANE

- 5.10.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>D11.5.2.1</u> Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule <u>D8.1.8</u> <u>D8.1.6</u> and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

5.11 PIT STOPS

- 5.11.1 For race 15 and race 16, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 5.11.1.1 Each Car must complete <u>the</u> one (1) CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2**. **Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.11.1.2 A Car may only complete perform <u>a</u> its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.







- 5.11.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
- 5.11.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.11.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.
- 5.11.2 For this Event, delete Rule D11.8.8 in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>D11.8.8</u> During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, <u>the brake lock mechanism must be</u> engaged so as <u>the</u> rear wheels <u>do not</u> rotate <u>without the</u> prior approval of the HoM.
 - <u>D11.8.8.1</u> Where the HoM grants such approval, the <u>rear</u> wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the <u>rear</u> wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.
 - <u>During any Pit Stop</u>, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

5.12 PARCE FERME

- 5.12.1 At this Event for practice 2 only, update Rule **D13.5.1** as follows, noting the additional subrule:
 - <u>D13.5.1</u> Unless otherwise authorised by the HoM, Teams are only permitted to undertake the following while any Car is in Parc Fermé:
 - D13.5.1.1 Check Control Tyres pressures;
 - D13.5.1.2 Loosen the wheels;
 - D13.5.1.3 Rotate the wheels;
 - D13.5.1.4 Install cool suit loop lines and remove dry ice;
 - D13.5.1.5 Position cooling fans in the radiator and/or brake duct intakes in the front bumper bar:
 - D13.5.1.6 Connect auxiliary power pack.
 - <u>D13.5.1.7</u> <u>One crew member is permitted to download dash data however</u> no deleting or uploading of files is permitted.

5.13 POINT SCORE

- 5.13.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>D14.1.5</u> Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final <u>Classification</u> of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

5.14 CONTROL TYRES

- 5.14.1 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

5.15 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

- 5.15.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.
- 5.15.2 All marked front discs count towards Rule D19.1.





5.16 FUEL RIGS

5.16.1 Fuel rigs are not permitted to be stored in pit lane.

CHAPTER 6 - TECHNICAL

6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0730hrs (ACST)** on Friday 14th June 2019.

CHAPTER 7 - MARKETING

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.2 TRANSPORTER PARADE

7.2.1 Teams with B Doubles must participate in the parade with their A and B Trailer.

7.3 GRID WALK

- 7.3.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.
- 7.3.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid sticker.
