CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “PENRITE OIL SANDOWN SUPERSPRINT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 24, 25 and 26 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Sandown International Motor Raceway, Sandown, Victoria on 18th – 21st August 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

- 1.5.1 **Track Length:** 3.1 kilometres
- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Anti- Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 36
- 1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located outside the office of the Secretary of the Event on the ground floor of the Race Control Building, in the middle of Pit Lane.
- 1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located in a demountable building behind Race Control.
- 1.5.6 **DRD Office:** Located in a demountable building behind Race Control.
- 1.5.7 **Control Line:** Located at the Finish Line and across Pit Exit.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 All additional Drivers are required to be nominated using the additional Driver nomination form no later than Wednesday 10th August 2022.
- 2.1.2.1 All additional Drivers along with the Primary Driver are required to be entered into the portal in the Event/ Car registration section.
 - 2.1.2.2 All additional Drivers are required to upload their insurance, ASN Licence and Car Club to their portal profile no later than Wednesday 10th August 2022.
- 2.1.3 Administration checking will commence at **1200hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 18th August 2022.
- 2.1.4 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.

- 2.1.5 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 18th August 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 All Team Transporters are required to be split and ready to enter the Supercars paddock on Thursday 18th August 2022 at **0800hrs (AEST)**.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **0900hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 18th August 2022 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.
- 3.1.7 Teams are to supply their own padlocks for garages.

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.2.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 19th August 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car entry will be allocated four (4) VIP car parking passes to park in the VIP / Teams car park. All other Team vehicles will be permitted to park in the general car park. All Team car parking is only accessible via Racecourse Drive.
- 3.2.3 **Grid Walk Pass collection** – To be collected from the Accreditation Centre.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at **Gate 2** on Racecourse Drive.
- 3.3.2 The Accreditation Centre will be open as per below **(AEST)**:

- 3.3.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collection by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticketek Box Office located at **Gate 2** (in an envelope with the collector's name). The Box Office will be open approx. 30min ahead of gates opening on Saturday – Sunday.

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 18th August 2022 between **1400hrs** and **1600hrs (AEST)**.

3.5 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.5.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.6.1 For this Event, one (1) road registered golf buggy per Team is permitted.
- 3.6.2 Teams are only permitted to use **Gate 5E** at the rear of the paddock (vehicle gate located near Fuel Bund). If Teams are found to be using any gate other than **Gate 5E**, Sandown Motorsport Park will suspend the use of the buggy for the remainder of the Event.

3.7 ACCESS TO AND USE OF THE PROPERTY

- 3.7.1 Children in any restricted areas including the paddock must be under the direct supervision of an adult. The Promoter reserves the right to have any offenders removed.
- 3.7.2 Under no circumstances are stakes to be driven into the bitumen surface.

3.8 SANDOWN RACEWAY VENUE REGULATIONS

- 3.8.1 Attached is a copy of the Sandown Raceway Venue Regulations. These Regulations must be adhered to, except where in conflict with the Supercars Operations Manual, Supplementary Regulations, Further Supplementary Regulations, Bulletins or any instructions from Supercars for this Event.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the Victorian State Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified ~~in the Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements.

4.7 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- 4.7.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

- 4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

- 5.1.1 The Event operating hours (**AEST**), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.3 BRIEFINGS

- 5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 18th August 2022 in the Vintage Room, located on the 1st floor of the northern end of the grandstand. Entry is via the green walkway at the rear.
- 5.3.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **0830hrs (AEST)** on Saturday 20th August 2022 in the Vintage Room, located on the 1st floor of the northern end of the grandstand. Entry is via the green walkway at the rear.

5.4 SHADE STRUCTURES

- 5.4.1 Teams are permitted one (1) only 6m by 3m shade structure per Car on the apron at the rear of the Pit Garages. All other shade structures are to be placed next to their transporter.
- 5.4.1.1 All temporary shade structures must be installed no later than **1300hrs (AEST)**, Thursday 18th August for certification by the City of Dandenong.
- 5.4.2 Teams are required to conform with the requirements for Temporary Structures Weighting Requirements, this will be sent to Teams under separate cover.

5.5 PIT STRAIGHT SIGNALLING AREA

- 5.5.1 A restricted area has been established along the signalling wall area due to a lack of Debris Fencing on the signalling guard rail. Please refer to the attached diagram.
- 5.5.2 Should a Team have a Car/pit radio failure, the Team must seek the prior approval of the HoM for a maximum of two (2) Team members to access the area for signalling only. Please refer to the attached diagram.
- 5.5.3 Teams will be permitted to stand along the signalling guard rail in the restricted area at the end of the race in accordance with **Rule D11.5.1**.

5.6 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.6.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.6.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.4m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.6.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.7 PIT STOPS

- 5.7.1 For races **24, 25** and **26** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
- 5.7.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
- 5.7.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
- 5.7.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
- 5.7.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.7.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION, USAGE, ORDER AND PAYMENT

- 5.8.1 At this Event, note the following amendments to **Table D17.7 (as circulated in the Variation to the Rules 20th July)**:

- 5.8.2 At this Event, two (2) sets of pre-marked Control Tyres are to be used during the additional Driver Session.

5.9 FRONT BRAKE ROTOR RESTRICTIONS

- 5.9.1 One (1) pre-used front brake rotor and pad set is permitted to be used during Event Rides and the additional Driver Session.

5.10 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.10.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
- 5.10.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.11 IN-CAR CAMERA

5.11.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.

5.11.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.
