CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “VALO ADELAIDE 500” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 33 and 34 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at the Adelaide Parklands 2 Circuit, Adelaide, South Australia on 29th November – 4th December 2022.

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

- 1.5.1 **Track Length:** 3.22 kilometres
- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 32
- 1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located at the office of the Secretary of the Event.
- 1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located in the Red Zone in the Pit Paddock next to the Pit Paddock Entry.
- 1.5.6 **DRD Office:** Located in the Red Zone in the Pit Paddock next to the Pit Paddock Entry.
- 1.5.7 **Control Line:** Located at the Finish Line and across the Pit Entry.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 30th November 2022.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event Program.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1730hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 30th November 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Details of the access into the Circuit and set up of the Supercars paddock, will be as per the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 Transporters are only permitted to enter the Supercars paddock following the Transporter Parade on Tuesday 29th November 2022, this is expected to be from **1500hrs (ACDT)**. A park-up procedure will be issued as per Supplementary Regulation 3.1.2.
- 3.1.4 Transporter unload is permitted from **1000hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 30th November 2022.
- 3.1.5 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time. Offending Cars will be reported to the Stewards.
- 3.1.6 **NOTE:** The circuit will be closed to all traffic on Wednesday 30th November between **0630hrs and 1315hrs (ACDT)** due to a promotional activation on the Circuit.

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
 - 3.2.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Thursday 1st December 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each VCS Car will be allocated three (3) car passes to park in the VCS Car Park. Access to this carpark will be via Gate A off East Terrace.
 - 3.2.2.1 All car park passes must be displayed from Thursday 1st December 2022 for the duration of the Event. **No Car Pass No Access.**
- 3.2.3 VCS Team catering supplies are required to be delivered into the VCS Pit Lane outside Event operating hours.
 - 3.2.3.1 All deliveries must be completed in Pit Lane between the hours of **1900hrs – 0700hrs (ACDT)** from Thursday 1st through to Sunday 4th December 2022.
 - 3.2.3.2 Each Team will receive one (1) Supercars Paddock Transit Pass (to be used after hours only).
- 3.2.4 **Grid Walk Pass collection** – To be collected from the Motorsport Operations Transporter.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation centre is located at **Gate 1** from **Thursday 1st December 2022**.
- 3.3.2 The Accreditation Centre will open as per the below **(ACDT)**:
 - 3.3.2.1 Tuesday 29th – Wednesday 30th November[^] 0800
[^] Location is Highway 500
 - 3.3.2.2 Thursday 1st December 0600
 - 3.3.2.3 Friday 2nd December 0800
 - 3.3.2.4 Saturday 3rd December 0800
 - 3.3.2.5 Sunday 4th December 0800
- 3.3.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collection by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticketek Box Office located at Gate One (1) (in an envelope with the collector's name). The Box Office will be open approx. 30min ahead of gates opening on Thursday – Sunday.

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 30th November 2022 between **1315hrs** and **1700hrs (ACDT)**.

3.5 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.5.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.6 STORAGE

- 3.6.1 It is not permitted to store anything under the stairs that lead up to the corporate facilities above the Pit Lane.
- 3.6.2 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock area between the Transporters and the Teams garage.

3.7 DRIVER BATH WATER

- 3.7.1 Teams are not permitted to drain water from Driver baths onto the Paddock bitumen.
- 3.7.2 Teams must provide a 30m hose and drain the water from their Driver baths into the drain located at the rear of the Transporters.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the South Australian Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified in the ~~Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements.

4.8 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

4.8.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

4.8.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

4.9 CARE FOR PARKLANDS

4.9.1 Competitors must be aware that the Adelaide Parklands are a valuable asset to the host community, so all Teams are required to treat the areas available within the Parklands with respect and discretion to minimise any adverse environmental impact.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION, USAGE, ORDER AND PAYMENT

- 5.1.1 At this Event, delete rule **D17.7.9** and replace with the following:
D17.7.9 At the conclusion of practice ~~and prior to the first qualifying Session of the Event,~~ Teams must return the “Pre-Marked” Control Tyres in addition to two (2) sets of Event Marked Control Tyres to Dunlop. These four (4) sets of tyres will be marked separately by Dunlop before the commencement of Practice 1 as PRAC and are not permitted to be used in Qualifying or Race Sessions, the remaining six (6) sets of Event Marked tyres will be marked RACE for use in all Sessions.

5.4 BRIEFINGS

- 5.4.1 A briefing for all **Competitor’s Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1630hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 30th November 2022 in the Conference Room located on level 2, northern end of the Pit Garage Complex. Access to the Conference room is via the Media Centre.
- 5.4.2 A briefing for all **Competitor’s Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **0830hrs (ACDT)** on Saturday 3rd December 2022 in the Conference Room located on level 2, northern end of the Pit Garage Complex. Access to the Conference room is via the Media Centre.

5.5 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.5.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.5.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.4m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.5.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.6 TOP TEN SHOOTOUT

- 5.6.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D6.3.7.3** and replace with the following:
D6.3.7.3 Unless directed otherwise by the Race Director over RMC, the Competitor of each further Car competing in the Session is to ensure their Car is at the Pit Exit prior to the preceding Car receiving the green flag to commence its timed lap.

- a) If the Race Director gives a contrary direction, it is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure their Car is at the Pit Exit by the nominated time to commence its timed lap.

5.7 PIT STOPS

- 5.7.1 For races **33** and **34** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
- 5.7.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events.**
 - 5.7.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 5.7.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.7.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 5.7.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.8 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.8.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
- 5.8.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.9 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.9.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2.**
- 5.9.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.
