SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SUPERCARS

CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "Superloop Adelaide 500" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event") which will also comprise races 1 and 2 of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at the Adelaide Parklands Circuit, Adelaide, South Australia on 28th February – 3rd March 2019.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the International Sporting Code including Appendices of the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA), the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 27th February 2019.





- 2.1.2.1 All Driver's are required to present their licensing in accordance with **Rule A5.1** including a valid Car Club Membership to the Supercars Operations Truck during the following times: **1300hrs** to **1700hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 27th February 2019 and from **0830hrs** to **1400hrs** on Thursday 28th February 2019.
- 2.1.2.2 All Competitors must present their CAMS International Competitor licence to the Supercars Operations Truck, during the hours as detailed in 2.1.2.1.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** on Wednesday 27th February 2019.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1730hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 27th February 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Details of Transporter access into the Circuit and set up of the Supercars paddock, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.3 Transporters are permitted to enter the Supercars paddock commencing at **0800hrs** (ACDT) on Wednesday 27th February 2019.
- 3.1.4 Transporters may arrive at the Circuit from **1300hrs (ACDT)** Tuesday 26th February 2019. Transporters are only permitted to park on the Pit straight, however they must not park on any grid markings.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock.
- 3.1.6 Other than Team caterers who have the required Transit Car Pass, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs (ACDT)** on Wednesday 27th February 2019.

3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Wednesday 27th February 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated 3 x passes for Car Park 1, access to which is via Gate 1A at the corner of Gillies Street and East Terrace.
 - 3.2.3.1 Additional car parking at Gate 1A on the corner of East Terrace is available for \$80 for a 4-day pass. These passes must be pre-ordered from the Promoter at: <u>https://superloopadl500.com.au/hospitality/parking</u>
- 3.2.4 Team invited guests must be in possession of a paddock pass to gain access into the paddock. No pass no entry.
- 3.2.5 Each Team caterer will be allocated 1 x transit pass and will be required to exit the paddock prior to **0800hrs (ACDT)** each morning.





3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at Gate 1.
- 3.3.2 The Accreditation centre will be open at the following times (ACDT):
 - 3.3.2.1 Tuesday 26th February
 - 3.3.2.2 Wednesday 27th February
 - 3.3.2.3 Thursday 28th February
 - 3.3.2.4 Friday 1st March
 - 3.3.2.5 Saturday 2nd March
 - 3.3.2.6 Sunday 3rd March

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk at any time on Wednesday 27th February 2019.
- 3.4.2 The Race Track will still be a public road at this time, so please keep to one side where possible.

3.5 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

3.5.1 The following gate access times **(ACDT)** are permitted during the Event, Teams must access the Circuit through Gate 1A:

3.5.1.1	Thursday 28 th February	0730 hrs
3.5.1.2	Friday 1 st March	0730 hrs
3.5.1.3	Saturday 2 nd March	0730 hrs
3.5.1.4	Sunday 3 rd March	0730 hrs

3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.6.1 All golf buggies must be road registered.
- 3.6.2 The 'Vehicle Identification Application' must be completed and returned to the Promoter for approval. This form will be circulated with the Further Regulations.
- 3.6.3 No buggy movements are permitted at any time between the rear of transporters and Team Garages.

3.7 STORAGE

- 3.7.1 Fuel drums are not permitted to be stored directly next to each other.
- 3.7.2 It is not permitted to store anything under the stairs that lead up to the corporate facilities above the Pit Lane.
- 3.7.3 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock.

3.8 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.8.1 Unless otherwise advised by Supercars, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **1900hrs (ACDT)** on Sunday 3rd March 2019.
- 3.8.2 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

4.6 CARE FOR PARKLANDS

4.6.1 Competitors must be aware that the Adelaide Parklands are a valuable asset to the host community, so all Teams are required to treat the areas available within the Parklands with respect and discretion to minimise any adverse environmental impact.

4.7 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.7.1 In line with the South Australian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

4.8 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.8.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.8.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.





- 4.8.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- A breach of this prohibition will result in the exclusion from the Event for any offending 4.8.4 Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any 4.8.5 Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

- 5.3.1 A briefing for all Competitor's Authorised Representatives will be held at 1730hrs (ACDT) on Wednesday 27th February 2019 in the Conference Room located on level 2, northern end of the Pit Garage Complex.
- A Refuelling Safety briefing will be held immediately following the Competitor's 5.3.2 Authorised Representatives briefing in the Conference Room located on level 2, northern end of the Pit Garage Complex. Attendance of the following Team members from each Car is compulsory:
 - 5.3.2.1 The refuelling hose operator
 - The fire extinguisher operator 5.3.2.2
 - The deadman handle operator 5.3.2.3
 - 5.3.2.4 The Authorised Representative
- An attendance sheet must be signed by each Team member detailed in 4.3.2 above. 5.3.3
- Any Team member detailed in 4.3.2 who does not attend at the prescribed time and for the 5.3.4 duration of the Briefing will:
 - 5.3.4.1 Be referred to the Stewards: and
 - Be required to attend a Briefing at a time and place advised by the Stewards. 5.3.4.2

6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0730hrs (ACDT)** on Thursday 28th February 2019.

6.2 MINIMUM WEIGHT

- 6.2.1 In accordance with the requirements of Rule C4.1.1, all Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials at 1610hrs (ACDT) on Thursday 28th February 2019, in the Supercars Scales Garage.
 - 6.2.1.1 Full Driver apparel is required, including all underwear, gloves, HANS, boots, race suit and helmet.

CHAPTER 7 -MARKETING

7.1 **PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE**

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.2 GRID WALK

- 7.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team personnel on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing Instructions.
- 7.2.2 Team guests for the grid walk are not permitted on the grid until all Cars are in their grid positions post the reconnaissance lap, or unless advised otherwise by Supercars staff. Team personnel will still be able to access the grid when advised over RMC.
- 7.2.3 Promotional staff, Drivers and crew (up to 8 people per Car) are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid sticker.
