

Supercars Paddock Conditions of Entry

These conditions apply to all persons entering the paddock section of an event (*Paddock*) conducted, promoted, or sanctioned by V8 Supercars Australia Pty Ltd and its related body corporate (*Supercars*). Any person entering the Paddock (*you*) agrees to be bound by the following conditions, which are supplementary to any conditions of entry applicable to the event.

Entry at own risk

1. You acknowledge that you are entering the Paddock at your own risk. The Paddock is a live working environment, and your entry may expose you to risks related to movement of heavy machinery and other dangerous goods, moving vehicles, use of electrical current, hazardous fluids, fire, significant noise, the release of noxious fumes and the general movement and operation of team members and race officials.

Access

- 2. You must not access the Paddock without a valid ticket, accreditation or other pass permitting you such access, or access the Paddock outside the days or times which such access is permitted.
- 3. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18 years of age, at all times.
- 4. You acknowledge that the Paddock closes 30 minutes prior to the completion of the final race held on an event day, unless closed earlier by Supercars in its absolute discretion. You must vacate the Paddock prior to closure.
- 5. Unless authorised by Supercars, you must not enter the pit, the track or any other restricted area of the Paddock.
- 6. Unless authorised by a team representative, you must not enter any restricted team area.

Conduct

- 7. You must abide by the directions of Supercars and/or event staff at all times whilst in the Paddock.
- 8. You must ensure you give right-of-way to, and do not otherwise disrupt, interrupt, interfere with or obstruct any Supercars, event staff, team member and race officials.
- 9. Within the Paddock, you must not:
 - (a) smoke or vape;
 - (b) bring in or consume alcohol; or
 - (c) touch any equipment.
