SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SUPERCARS

CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “FORMULA 1® AUSTRALIAN GRAND PRIX” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Albert Park Grand Prix Circuit, Melbourne, Victoria on 5th – 10th April 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars –32
1.5.4 **Notice Board:** National Admin Office.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 TEAM COMMUNICATION WITH OFFICIALS

- 2.1.1 At this Event, Team personnel are not permitted to conduct business outside their garage. For avoidance of doubt, unless specifically given instruction to do so; Team personnel will not be permitted access (including but not limited to) the Supercars Operations Truck, the Stewards Office, the DSA Office, RD Office, DRD Office, Race Control and Event Operations Office.

2.2 ENTRIES

- 2.2.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
2.2.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 6th April 2022.
2.2.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
2.2.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1600hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 6th April 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 CONDITIONS OF THE EVENT (FORMULA 1 PRECEDENCE)

- 3.1.1 The VCS is part of the Event hosting a round of the FIA Formula 1® World Championship 2022. Formula 1® activities will have priority over Supercars for the whole of the Event.
- 3.1.2 The Promoter reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event or any part of it in accordance with NCR 11. In the case of abandonment or cancellation of the whole of the Event, entry fees will not be refunded by the Promoter.
- 3.1.3 The Organiser and Promoter will use reasonable endeavours to ensure that the Event is conducted as planned, however, the schedule of the Event may be varied at the Organiser's or the Promoter's absolute discretion.
- 3.1.4 Any variations that may occur to the Event schedule will be notified to Supercars as soon as practicable. Such variations will be considered final and will not be subject to protest.
- 3.1.5 Any Competitor, Driver or Team member who is not in the correct place at the required time may miss their participation in the Event.
- 3.1.6 Fines of no less than \$10,000 may be imposed on any Team or Driver which actively disrupts Formula 1 activities.

3.2 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.2.1 Each Team Transporter will require an accreditation Bump-in pass to access the Circuit and VCS Paddock. The Supercars Paddock Manager will be in contact with Truck Drivers directly.
- 3.2.2 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.2.3 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.2.4 Transporters must not enter the Supercars Paddock prior to **0830hrs (AEST)** on Tuesday 5th April 2022 and all movements must be with the prior approval of the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.2.5 All Team transporters must be parked up in their allocated position by **1030hrs (AEST)** on Tuesday 5th April 2022 in order for pro-floor to be installed adjacent to Transporters.
 - 3.2.5.1 Teams will be permitted to unload transporters from **0830hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 6th April 2022.
- 3.2.6 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.2.7 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.

3.3 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.3.1 Series hard- card accreditation is **NOT** recognised at this Event.
 - 3.3.1.1 Promoter issued Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Thursday 7th April 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
 - 3.3.1.2 All accreditation and tickets will be scanned upon entry to the Event.
- 3.3.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** The Promoter will issue Teams the following car park passes for the Event.
 - 3.3.2.1 2 Car Teams – 3 x internal car park and 6 x external car park.
 - 3.3.2.2 1 Car Teams – 2 x internal car park and 3 x external car park.

- 3.3.2.3 Cars with internal car park passes must be parked in the 'M' Motorsport Car Park, located in the outfield at Turn 14, Driver's left. The cars with external car park passes must be parked in the Competitors Car Park, located adjacent to Lakeside Driver near Gate 10.

3.4 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.4.1 The AGPC Accreditation Centre is located at **Junction Oval**, accessible via the Cricket Victoria entry gate, off Lakeside Drive. The entrance to the office is to the left of the Cricket Victoria reception counter.
- 3.4.2 The Accreditation Centre will be open at the following times **(AEST)**:

3.5 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.5.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 6th April only between **1515hrs and 1700hrs (AEST)**.
- 3.5.2 All Team personnel participating in the Race Track walk must not use a vehicle of any kind including scooters and buggies.

3.6 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

- 3.6.1 Promoter issued Accreditation as per Supplementary Regulation 3.3.1.1 will permit access to the Circuit and VCS Paddock through **Gate 10** from **0730hrs daily (AEST)**:
- 3.6.2 Team personnel and/or guests in possession of Promoter issued General Admission (paper) tickets will not be permitted access to the venue until gates open to the public.

3.7 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.7.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.8 STORAGE

- 3.8.1 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock.

3.9 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.9.1 All Golf Buggies must be road registered and are strictly by application to AGPC. Teams should contact Kelsie Owen, Accreditation and Customer Coordinator to apply for a golf buggy pass including tunnel access. Applications are due no later than 28 March 2022 – Jodi Prigg jodie.prigg@grandprix.com.au.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the Victorian State Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified ~~in the Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements. This person should be nominated on the Notification of Performance Personnel Form (**Rule D24**).

4.2 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.2.1 The Medical Centre is located on the road behind the VCS paddock and will be operational during the following times (AEST):
- 4.2.2 Operating Hours will be *updated in Further Supplementary Regulations*.

4.3 PIT GARAGE STRUCTURE

- 4.3.1 Teams are not permitted to modify the bracing (if applicable) at the rear of the Pit Garage structure in anyway as it weakens the structure.
- 4.3.2 Teams are only permitted to use the 4 x 10amp power connections provided. Any connections to other sources will be cut off.

4.8 CARE FOR PARKLANDS

- 4.8.1 Competitors are advised that the area used for the Event comprises public parkland for the remainder of the year and all Competitors, support personnel and any associated personnel shall comply with the Parks Victoria Site Induction Handbook which has been drawn up for the use of this area.
- 4.8.2 A current copy of the Parks Victoria Site Induction Handbook is attached to these regulations.
- 4.8.3 Teams are advised that the main points from the Site Induction Handbook include:

- 4.8.3.1 No trees may be pruned or damaged by users of the area - accidental damage must be reported to the National Race Paddock Manager as soon as possible.
- 4.8.3.2 The ground surface and grassed areas must not be damaged by users of the area - again, any damage must be reported to the National Race Paddock Manager.
- 4.8.3.3 No open fires may be lit at Albert Park.
- 4.8.3.4 All rubbish and refuse (including fuels and oils) shall be placed in suitable containers, or removed from Albert Park.
- 4.8.3.5 Any Team identified as dropping oil, fuels, or other contaminants on the ground or into the drainage system will be held responsible for any costs associated with decontamination of the area affected.
- 4.8.3.6 No rubbish or refuse shall be disposed of in such a manner as to allow it to end up in the drainage system or the lake.
- 4.8.3.7 All materials and equipment shall be stored so as to prevent damage to the site and minimise hazards to persons, materials, and equipment.
- 4.8.3.8 All users must comply with water restrictions in force in Melbourne if applicable. Statutory fines may apply if these are not followed.

4.9 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- 4.9.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 4.9.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.1.1 The Event operating hours (**AEST**), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.1.2**.

5.1.3 During all Formula 1® on track sessions, the front doors of each garage must be closed until the last Formula 1 car has received the chequered flag.

5.1.4 Team garages are required to be open with unbranded tensa barriers in position for the following Pit Lane walk sessions (**AEST**):

Friday 8 th April 2022
10:15 – 11:00
Saturday 9 th April 2022
11:15 – 12:00
17:20 – 18:00
Sunday 10 th April 2022

5.1.5 Pit Stop Practice is only permitted in accordance with the sessions highlighted in **Chapter 8 – Event Schedule**. Unbranded Tensa barriers to be in position as a crowd barrier.

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Melbourne:

5.3 BRIEFINGS

5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor’s Authorised Representatives & Drivers Briefing** will be held at **1730hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 6th April 2022 in the Supercars Trackside Lounge, located above the Supercars Pit Garages.

5.4 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

5.4.1 Teams undertaking (invitational) Event rides are permitted to use an additional four (4) Hard Control Tyres during the Event ride session only.

5.4.1.1 These tyres must be marked by Dunlop prior to the Event ride session.

5.4.1.2 These tyres are in addition to the Event tyre allocation.

5.5 PADDOCK SIGNAGE

5.5.1 The Promoter has granted permission for Teams to display flags on transporters, however, the Promoter may, at its discretion, request their removal at any time during the Event.

5.5.2 Teams are not permitted to display their own café style tensa barriers behind their garages. The AGPC will provide generic barriers for Teams to use.

5.6 PIT LANE EQUIPMENT – SIGNAGE

- 5.6.1 All Teams must either have removed or covered up all Pit Lane equipment signage at all times during the Event.
- 5.6.1.1 Teams will be permitted boom signage as follows:
- 5.6.1.2 A height of 300mm (H) maximum;
- 5.6.1.3 Only black or white is permitted as the background colour;
- 5.6.2 Only the car number is permitted to be displayed, in a colour of the Teams choice.

5.7 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION

- 5.7.1 At this Event, Teams must use Soft (S) tyres only during all qualifying Sessions.
- 5.7.2 At this Event, both dry tyre compounds (S) and (H) must be used in race 6, 7, 8 & 9.
- 5.7.2.1 At this Event, Teams must use at least four (4) Soft Tyres and at least four (4) Hard Tyres during each race
- 5.7.2.2 **Rule D17.1.10** applies.
- 5.7.3 At this Event, the following new **Rule D17.7.11** will apply:
- D17.7.11 No later than thirty minutes (30) minutes prior to the 15-minute signal for race 6, 7, 8 & 9, Teams must nominate via email (motorsportoperations@supercars.com) the tyre compound they will commence that race with.
- D17.7.11.1 At the 15-minute signal for race 6, 7, 8 & 9, the tyre compound as nominated in **Rule D17.7.11** must be fitted to the Car and remain on the Car until the CPS window opens.
- D17.7.11.2 In the situation of **Rule D17.5.2** being declared for a race, **Supplementary Regulation 5.7.1** and **Rule D17.1.11.1** will not apply to that race.
- D17.7.11.3 A Teams' non-compliance with Rule D17.7.11 will be referred to the Stewards.

5.8 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.8.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.8.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.0m from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.8.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.9 PRACTICE

- 5.9.1 At this Event, all practice Sessions will be time certain.

5.10 GENERAL PRESCRIPTIONS – QUALIFYING

- 5.10.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D6.1.11.1**:
- D6.1.11.1 At this Event only, Teams are not permitted to refuel their Cars between qualifying race 6 and qualifying race 7 nor between qualifying race 8 and qualifying race 9.

5.11 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

5.11.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D6.1.3.2 a)** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D6.1.3.2 a) Each qualifying session will be time certain, except in extreme circumstances as determined by the Stewards, in which case the session may be extended.

5.12 START PROCEDURE

5.12.1 The Start Procedure will be in accordance with **Rule D8.4** Specific Prescriptions – 15 minute Start Procedure.

5.13 PIT STOPS

5.13.1 For races **6, 7, 8** and **9** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.13.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events.**

5.13.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 2 on the Race Track.

5.13.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.13.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

5.13.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 2 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 2, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.14 PIT CREW ACCESS ON GRID

5.14.1 Tyre equipment will be permitted in the Formula One Pit Lane, as advised over RMC.

5.14.2 During the Start Procedure, each Team will be permitted a maximum two (2) Team personnel for each Car.

5.15 SIGNALLING WALL

5.15.1 There is no provision for a signalling wall in the Supercars Pit lane, if Teams need to use a signalling wall during a Session they are permitted to do so from the Formula 1 Pit Lane signalling wall.

5.16 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

5.16.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.

5.16.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.17 IN-CAR CAMERA

5.17.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2.**

5.17.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.

5.18 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS DRIVER'S CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

5.18.1 At this Event only, note the following amendment to **Rule D14.2.1.1:**

D14.2.1.1 At this Event, additional Championship points specified as ~~5%~~ five (5) points, will be awarded to the Driver who achieves the fastest lap in each race.

a) Only Drivers who finish in the top fifteen (15) in any race will be eligible for "fastest lap" points in that race.

CHAPTER 7 -MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.
- 7.1.1.1 Activities are to be conducted in accordance with Team WHS COVID-19 management procedures and the Promoter's COVID-19 management procedures.

7.2 GRID WALKS

- 7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks are **not** permitted.

7.3 ACCESS TO CORPORATE FACILITIES

- 7.3.1 Drivers and Team PR personnel that need to access the corporate facilities at this Event are to request the visitor access pass each suite has in their possession.

7.4 PROMOTIONAL STAFF

- 7.4.1 Promotional staff are not permitted within Albert Park (being the declared area and designated access areas as defined under the Australian Grands Prix Act 1994 (Vic)) by or on behalf of any of the Teams or their commercial partners at any time during the period of the Event without the prior written agreement of the Promoter.

7.5 MERCHANDISING

- 7.5.1 No goods or merchandise of any kind may be brought, sold, advertised, displayed, distributed or promoted within Albert Park (being the declared area and designated access areas as defined under the Australian Grands Prix Act 1994 (Vic)) by or on behalf of any of the Teams at any time during the period of the Event without the prior written agreement of the Promoter.
