#### CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

##### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “REPCO BATHURST 1000” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 31 of the 2021 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Mount Panorama, Bathurst, New South Wales on 28<sup>th</sup> November – 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

##### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted National.

## CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

### 2.1 TEAM COMMUNICATION WITH OFFICIALS

- 2.1.1 For this Event, Team personnel are not permitted to conduct business outside their garage. For avoidance of doubt, unless specifically given instruction to do so; Team personnel will not be permitted access (including but not limited to) the Supercars Operations Truck, the Stewards Office, the DSA Office, RD Office, DRD Office, Race Control and Event Operations Office.

### 2.2 ENTRIES

- 2.2.1 Competitors must have completed the 2021 Supercars Entry Registration Form.  
2.2.1.1 All additional Drivers are required to sign the 2021 Supercars Entry Registration Form by **1000hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021.  
2.2.2 All additional Drivers are required to be nominated using the additional Driver nomination form no later than Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2021.  
2.2.2.1 All additional Drivers and Wildcard Drivers are required to email their licensing in accordance with **Rule A5.1** including a valid Car Club Membership to [motorsportoperations@supercars.com](mailto:motorsportoperations@supercars.com) by **1000hrs (AEDT)** Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021.

- 2.2.3 Administration checking will commence at **1300hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021.
- 2.2.4 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2021 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.2.5 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

## CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

### **3.1 VCS GARAGES AND VISION REQUIREMENTS**

- 3.1.1 For this Event update **Rule E2.1.2 Garages** with the following new Rule:  
E2.1.2.4 Promotional walling is restricted to both sides of the Teams garage (no rear walling or storage rooms are permitted).
- 3.1.2 For this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E2.1.4.4 Shade Structures:**  
E2.1.4.4 Unless otherwise advised in Supplementary Regulations, shade structures and equipment of any sort will not be permitted to be situated at the rear of the Pit Garage and cannot be located any closer to the Rear of the Pit Garage than the rear edge of the Team's transporter.

### **3.2 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK**

- 3.2.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.2.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.2.3 **NO** vehicles are permitted to be parked in the VCS Paddock from **0700hrs (AEDT)** Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November.
  - 3.2.3.1 All Team deliveries should be directed to pit lane for unload to Supercar garage/s.

### **3.3 PARKING ONSITE – 23<sup>RD</sup> -26<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER**

- 3.3.1 For Team Personnel onsite from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> November, parking is restricted to the Paddock A campground, accessible via Mountain Straight gate.
  - 3.3.1.1 As per Supplementary Regulation 3.2.3 – Parking is **NOT** permitted under any circumstances in the VCS paddock. The VCS Paddock is a construction area.

### **3.4 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PITS AND PADDOCK**

- 3.4.1 Transporter tailgates / tail lifts are **not** permitted to be in operation from 60 minutes prior to the first on-track activity and until conclusion of the final Session each day as per the Event Program. **Rule D2.6.1.5** applies.
- 3.4.2 The following additional Rule applies to **Rule E3.3.1:**
  - E3.3.1 A Speed limit of 10 km/h applies to all vehicle movements in the Paddock.
    - E3.3.1.1 From the commencement of transporter park up as detailed in Supplementary Regulation 3.2, vehicle/ buggy access is strictly prohibited in the area between a Transporter tailgate and the rear of the garages.

### 3.5 MOTORHOME ACCREDITATION

- 3.5.1 At this Event and upon written application to Motorsport Operations - Motorhomes will be permitted to be parked in the Supercars paddock but must not exceed 26m in length and must fit on the right-hand side of the Teams transporter.
- 3.5.1.1 Each approved motorhome will be provided an accreditation sticker that must be affixed to the front windscreen prior to parking up.
- 3.5.2 Approved and accredited Team motorhomes arriving prior to 1600hrs on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> November must be parked in the Paddock A campground.
- 3.5.2.1 On Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> November at 1600hrs you will be required to relocate your motorhome and park in position in the VCS Paddock.
- 3.5.3 All motorhomes are required to be parked in position in the VCS paddock no later than 1800hrs on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November.
- 3.5.3.1 Motorhomes that are not parked up in the VCS paddock by the above day and time, will be required to be parked up at the conclusion of on-track activities on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November. (No parking of motorhomes is permitted during general public access to the VCS paddock).
- 3.5.3.2 Once the motorhome is parked in position in the VCS Paddock, it cannot be moved from its allocated position until two (2) hours following race 31 on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021.
- 3.5.4 **MOTORHOME ACCESS:** via Mountain Straight Gate (gate 2). This gate is only accessible when there are no track activities taking place on the racing circuit.
- 3.5.5 All passengers and/or visitors of the motorhome must have approved accreditation on person from Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

### 3.6 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.6.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.6.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.6.1.2 All accreditation and tickets will be scanned upon entry to the Event, and individuals must scan the Service NSW Check-in QR code for COVID tracing purposes each day.
- 3.6.1.3 Four (4) tickets will be allocated to each additional Driver, these will be automatically included in your accreditation FOC allocation.
- 3.6.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each VCS Car will receive four (4) Priority Parking passes to park in the Priority Car Park located directly in front of the general admission Main Gate (as per 2019). Then walk over the pedestrian bridge into the VCS Paddock. Please follow the directions of the Traffic Controllers to be parked.
- 3.6.2.1 All car park passes must be displayed from **0600hrs** on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 for the duration of the Event. No Car Pass No Entry.
- 3.6.2.2 Additional car parking is available in the general admission car park at the Main Gate.
- 3.6.2.3 VCS Team catering supplies should be delivered into the VCS paddock outside Event operating hours.
- 3.6.3 **Pit Walk Pass collection – Passes must be collected at the Accreditation Centre each morning of the pit walk. (They are not to be collected at the Supercars Ops Truck).**

### 3.7 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.7.1 The Accreditation Centre is located in the main Car Park to the right, off Panorama Ave.
- 3.7.2 The operating hours will be *confirmed in Further Supplementary Regulations*.

### 3.8 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.8.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2021 between **1200hrs** and **1700hrs (AEDT)**.

### 3.9 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.9.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **two (2) hours** after the completion of race 31 on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021 **(AEDT)**.
- 3.9.2 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

### 3.10 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.10.1 One (1) road registered golf buggy per Team is permitted.

## CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

### 4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 For this Event update **Rule E3.2.1** with the following:  
E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified ~~in the Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.
- 4.1.2 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.3 In accordance with **Rule E3.1.2**, Teams are required to update their Workplace Health and Safety Policy and Procedures Manual with specific inclusion of COVID-19 management procedures and a response plan outlining how the Team will respond to a Team member developing symptoms of COVID-19 at both their Team workshop and at the Event. All updates to Team WHS Manual including COVID-19 Response Plan throughout the course of the 2021 Season must be submitted to Motorsport Operations.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements. This person should be nominated on the Notification of Performance Personnel Form (**Rule D24**).
- 4.1.5 The following occupant density limits apply at this Event in accordance with the NSW Government Safe checklist for Impacted areas (below is subject to change):
  - 4.1.5.1 **Indoor areas** - 1 person per 4 square metres, personnel must wear a face mask.
  - 4.1.5.2 **Outdoor areas** – 1 person per 2 square metres, personnel are encouraged to wear a mask if social distancing is not possible.
- 4.1.6 Race Fuel will be delivered directly to the Teams' garages.
- 4.1.7 Entry into the Dunlop tyre garage is not permitted.

### 4.2 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.2.1 The Medical Centre is located at Pit Entry.
- 4.2.2 Operating Hours will be *updated in Further Supplementary Regulations*.

### 4.5 WHS AND COVID COMPLIANCE

### 4.7 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

4.7.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

### 4.8 WASTE PRODUCTS

4.8.1 All personnel must be made aware of the fact the NO waste of any nature may be tipped into the storm water drains located with the support compound.

4.8.2 All storm water drains lead directly to the Macquarie River and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will be monitoring the situation in the lead up and throughout the Event.

4.8.3 This ban includes the washing of any wheel rims within the vicinity of storm water drains.

4.8.4 Competitors are advised that the EPA is taking an extremely proactive approach to this matter and Teams are put on notice that any infringement of this directive will result in action being taken by either the Promoter or the EPA or both. The EPA has the ability to prosecute offenders with heavy penalties.

4.8.5 The Promoter has provided an area for disposal of waste oil and/or fluid products that are located near the Circuit fuel bund. This is not for the disposal of used Car parts (i.e. oil filters etc.).

- 5.6.1.1 Only one (1) Authorised Representative per Team is permitted to attend.
- 5.6.1.2 Social /physical distancing protocols must be observed. Refer 4.1.5.
- 5.6.2 A **Refuelling Safety Briefing** will be held following the Competitors Authorised Representatives Briefing on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November in the large Grey Shed, immediately to the rear of Gate 2.
- 5.6.2.1 Attendance for the following Team personnel is compulsory for each Car:
- The refuelling hose operator;
  - The deadman handle operator;
  - The Fire Attendant; and
  - The Authorised Representative (per 2- Car Team).
- 5.6.2.2 An attendance sheet must be signed by each Team member detailed in 5.6.2.1 above.
- 5.6.2.3 Any Team member detailed in 5.6.2.1 who does not attend at the prescribed time and for the duration of the Briefing will:
- Be referred to the Stewards; and
  - Be required to attend a briefing at a time and place advised by the Stewards.
- 5.6.2.4 Social /physical distancing protocols must be observed. (A maximum of ninety (90) people are permitted inside the briefing area.)
- 5.6.3 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1800hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2021. in the large Grey Shed, immediately to the rear of Gate 2.
- 5.6.3.1 Only one (1) Authorised Representative per 2 Car Team, Primary Driver and additional Driver is permitted to attend.
- 5.6.3.2 Social /physical distancing protocols must be observed. Refer 4.1.5.



## 5.7 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

## 5.8 PRACTICE

- 5.8.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1, 4 and 6.
- 5.8.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2, 3 and 5.
- 5.8.3 The Stewards may, in their absolute discretion, order that a Driver who has not completed a suitable number of laps in practice 1, 4 or 6 combined, be required to drive the Car in another Session or Sessions. This decision of the Stewards is not susceptible to appeal.
- 5.8.4 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during practice 4 and 6.
  - 5.8.4.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
  - 5.8.4.2 During practice 4 and 6, Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay.
  - 5.8.4.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
  - 5.8.4.4 At the conclusion of the practice Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to parallel park in their pit bay.

## 5.9 WARM-UP

- 5.9.1 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during the warm-up Session on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021.
  - 5.9.1.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
  - 5.9.1.2 Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay;
  - 5.9.1.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
  - 5.9.1.4 At the conclusion of the warm-up Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to parallel park in their pit bay.
  - 5.9.1.5 Refuelling Towers are permitted to remain setup and in position for race 31 following warm up.

## 5.10 PERSONNEL

- 5.10.1 For this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.2**:
  - D11.2.2 For the Super500 refuelling and Endurance Event, each Car may be attended by a maximum of nine (9) people (the "Designated Pit Crew") as follows, who are permitted across the Prescribed Line when carrying out any Pit Stop in any race:
    - 11.2.2.1 One (1) Car Controller
    - 11.2.2.2 One (1) Air Jack Operator
    - 11.2.2.3 One (1) Refueler/Vent Attendant
    - 11.2.2.4 One (1) Fire Attendant
    - 11.2.2.5 Five (5) Other Team members
- 5.10.2 For this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.9**:
  - D11.2.8 ~~Four (4)~~ Five (5) Other Team Persons
    - D11.2.9.1 Will be responsible for the service of the Car under the direction of the Car Controller.
- 5.10.3 For this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.2.11.1**:
  - D11.2.11.1 A Driver nominated with the Car may assist the exiting Driver to leave the Car and the incoming Driver to enter and be properly seated in the Car.

## 5.11 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.11.1 For this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.11.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the right-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.6m from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.11.1.2 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the Pit Building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

## 5.12 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

- 5.12.1 For this Event, note the amendments to the following **Rules: D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2, D8.3.2.1, D8.3.3 and D8.3.3.1:**
- D8.3.1 ~~Thirty~~ Forty Minutes:
- D8.3.1.1 When ~~30~~ 40 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.
- D8.3.2 ~~Twenty-Five~~ Thirty-Five Minutes:
- D8.3.2.1 When ~~25~~ 35 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.
- D8.3.3 ~~Fifteen~~ Twenty-Five minutes:
- D8.3.3.1 When ~~45~~ 25 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

## 5.13 PIT STOPS – DRIVER CHANGE

- 5.13.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.

## 5.14 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – EXTRA FORMATION LAP

- 5.14.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.6.1.9**.

## 5.15 PIT STOPS

- 5.15.1 For race **31** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
- 5.15.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
- a) In addition to above CPS requirements, a compulsory front brake rotor change is required between, commencing lap 55 and ending lap 120.
- 5.15.1.2 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
- 5.15.1.3 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

## 5.16 FRONT BRAKE ROTOR RESTRICTIONS

- 5.16.1 For this Event, the front brake rotor restrictions will be as per **Rule D20.1.1.3 Variation to the Rules Issued 28<sup>th</sup> April 2021**. Please see below:
- D20.1.1.3 For the Bathurst 1000 Event and subject to **D20.1.1.1**, each Car will be allocated a maximum of five (5) sets of front brake rotors, a maximum of three (3) sets permitted to be new.

- D20.1.1.4 During practice Sessions 1 – 6, Teams will be permitted to use up to two (2) sets of pre marked CP6281 or CP8184 front brake rotors and pads.
- D20.1.1.2 During all Sessions, Teams will be permitted to use up to three (3) sets of new CP6281 front brake rotors and pads.
- D20.1.1.3 For qualifying, warm-up and race 31, only the three (3) sets of new CP6281 front brake rotors and pads are permitted to be used.

## 5.17 SC DEPLOYMENT DURING A RACE

- 5.17.1 For this Event, refer to **Appendix 2**, which provides **Rule D10.2 SC Deployment During a Race** in its entirety with the amendments to this Rule marked up.

## 5.18 SUSPENDING A RACE – RED FLAG

- 5.18.1 For this Event, in the instance of a suspended race due to red flag, the following will occur:
- 5.18.1.1 Cars one (1) or more laps behind the leader will be recorded in accordance with **Rule D9.1.3.4**.
- 5.18.1.2 Should however, the SC be already deployed, Cars one (1) or more laps behind the leader will be recorded in accordance with **Rule D10.2.2.6** and the race restarted in accordance with **Rule D10.2.9**.

## 5.19 END OF SESSION

- 5.19.1 For this Event, a practice start will be permitted at the end of Practice 1 (scheduled **1000 – 1100hrs AEDT**, Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2021).
- 5.19.1.1 Any Car that takes the chequered flag on the track, may then complete another lap and, instead of entering the pit lane, they can proceed to the grid, stop and then carry out a practice start.
- 5.19.1.2 For these Cars only **Rule D3.1.3**, will not apply.
- 5.19.1.3 All Drivers carrying out a practice start may only do so in the order which they arrive to the grid and by pulling as far forward on the grid as possible.
- 5.19.1.4 If necessary, each Driver must wait for another Car ahead to carry out a start before moving to a grid position further forward.
- 5.19.1.5 Under no circumstances should a Driver make a practice start if another Car is still stationary in front of them.
- 5.19.2 If any Driver appears to be disregarding any of the above, the matter will be referred to the Stewards. After completing a practice start, a Car must return to Pit Lane

## 5.20 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.20.1 For this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
- 5.20.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

## 5.21 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.21.1 For this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.
- 5.21.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.

## 5.22 CARS TO CARRY VIDEO RECORDERS

- 5.22.1 Further to **Rule D21.3.14**, SD cards must be cleared and reformatted prior to the 40-minute signal for race 31 on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021, however, must not be cleared prior to 30 minutes after the completion of Sunday's warm up, without the prior written permission of the HOM.
- 5.22.2 Each Team is required to ensure the SD card fitted to their Car is of sufficient size to record the entire race. It is suggested the camera settings should be set to record at a screen resolution of 720 and a frame rate of 60 FPS.

## 5.23 SCHEDULE D1. VCS POINT SCORE SYSTEM

- 5.23.1 For this Event, note the amendments to **Schedule D1. VCS Point Score**, for race 31 as attached in Appendix 1.

## 5.24 PERFORMANCE AND NON-PERFORMANCE PERSONNEL LIMITS

- 5.24.1 For this Event, replace **Rule D24.3.3** with the following:

D24.3.3 At each Event:

D24.3.3.1 A maximum of Four (4) non-Performance Personnel are permitted per two (2) Car Team.

- (a) If applicable, work experience personnel as outlined in **Rule D24.3.8** and **D24.3.8.1** must be included within the non-Performance Personnel allocation and listed on the **D24**. Form.

D24.3.3.2 A maximum of Three (3) non-Performance Personnel are permitted per one (1) Car Team.

- (a) If applicable, work experience personnel as outlined in **Rule D24.3.8** and **D24.3.8.1** must be included within the non-Performance Personnel allocation and listed on the **D24**. Form.

D24.3.3.3 A maximum of Six (6) non-Performance Personnel are permitted per three (3) Car Team.

- (a) If applicable, work experience personnel as outlined in **Rule D24.3.8** and **D24.3.8.1** must be included within the non-Performance Personnel allocation and listed on the **D24**. Form.

D24.3.3.4 Teams are permitted one (1) person for the purpose of providing team catering services. This person is subject to the prior approval of the HoM and is not required to be listed on the **D24**. Form.

D24.3.3.5 The non-Performance Personnel limit at each Event is subject to change by the HoM and will be updated in the Supplementary Regulations when amended.

- 5.24.2 For this Event, replace **Rule D24.3.6** with the following:

D24.3.6.1 A Team Owner deemed not to contribute to the performance of a Car, is not required to be listed on the **D24**. Form.

- 5.24.3 For this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D24.3.8**:

D24.3.8.2 During the Season, a local TAFE, School, or Registered Training Organisation may provide student/s to the Supercars Motorsport Department for the purpose of gaining work experience at a Supercars Event. In this instance, Rule D24.3.8 does not apply and this person/s is not required to be listed on the D24. Form.

## CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

### 6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **1300hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021.

### 6.2 MINIMUM WEIGHT

6.2.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**, all additional Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2021 Repco Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2 on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2021, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

## CHAPTER 7 - MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL

### 7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.1.1.1 Activities are to be conducted in accordance with Team WHS COVID-19 management procedures and the Promoter's COVID-19 management procedures.

### 7.2 GRID WALKS

7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks **will be** permitted (subject to COVID restrictions). Face masks are mandatory at all times.

7.2.1.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.

7.2.1.2 Social /physical distancing protocols must be observed.
