# **CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS**

#### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "BEAUREPAIRES SYDNEY SUPERNIGHT" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise of race 1 and 2 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Sydney Motorsport Park, Eastern Creek. New South Wales on 3 – 6<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

#### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

#### **CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION**

#### **TEAM COMMUNICATION WITH OFFICIALS** 2.1

2.1.1 At this Event, Team personnel are not permitted to conduct business outside their garage. For avoidance of doubt, unless specifically given instruction to do so: Team personnel will not be permitted access (including but not limited to) the Supercars Operations Truck, the Stewards Office, the DSA Office, RD Office, DRD Office, Race Control and Event Operations Office.

#### 2.2 **ENTRIES**

- 2.2.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.2.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022.
- 2.2.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.2.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than 1700hrs (AEDT) on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.







## **CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS**

#### 3.1 VCS GARAGES AND VISION REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1.1 At this Event update **Rule E2.1.2 Garages** with the following new Rule:
  - <u>E2.1.2.4</u> <u>Promotional walling is restricted to both sides of the Teams garage (no rear walling or storage rooms are permitted).</u>
- 3.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E2.1.4.4 Shade Structures**:
  - <u>E2.1.4.4</u> Unless otherwise advised in Supplementary Regulations, shade structures and equipment of any sort will not be permitted to be situated at the rear of the Pit Garage and cannot be located any closer to the Rear of the Pit Garage than the rear edge of the Team's transporter.

# 3.2 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.2.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.2.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.2.3 All B-double transporters must be split outside the Circuit complex and be brought into the paddock as single trailers.
- 3.2.4 At the direction of the Paddock Manager, Transporters are permitted to enter the paddock at **0800hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022.
- 3.2.5 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at the discretion of the Paddock Manager on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022.
- 3.2.6 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock.
- 3.2.7 **NO** vehicles are permitted to be parked in the VCS Paddock from **0700hrs (AEDT)** Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022.

#### 3.3 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PITS AND PADDOCK

- 3.3.1 The following additional Rule applies to **Rule E3.3.1**:
- E3.3.1 A Speed limit of 10 km/h applies to all vehicle movements in the Paddock.
  - E3.3.1.1 From the commencement of transporter park up as detailed in Supplementary Regulation 3.2, vehicle/ buggy access is strictly prohibited in the area between a Transporter tailgate and the rear of the garages.

#### 3.4 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.4.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
  - 3.4.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
  - 3.4.1.2 All accreditation and tickets will be scanned upon entry to the Event, and individuals must scan the Service NSW Check-in QR code upon entry.
- 3.4.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car will receive three (3) VIP Car Park passes to park on the Figure 8. Additional accredited parking is via Gate AA but is subject to capacity.
  - 3.4.2.1 All car park passes must be displayed from **0700hrs** on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 for the duration of the Event. No Car Pass No Entry.
  - 3.4.2.2 VCS Team catering supplies should be delivered into the VCS paddock outside Event operating hours.
- 3.4.3 Pit Walk Pass collection Passes must be collected at the Accreditation Centre each morning of the pit walk. (They are not to be collected at the Supercars Ops Truck).







#### 3.5 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.5.1 The Accreditation Centre is located between Gate AA and Gate A off Ferrers Road.
- 3.5.2 The operating hours will be confirmed in Further Supplementary Regulations.

#### 3.6 RACE TRACK WALK

3.6.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March between **1400hrs** and **1630hrs (AEDT)**.

## 3.7 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.7.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **two (2) hours** after the completion of race 2 on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2022 (AEDT).
- 3.7.2 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

#### 3.8 GOLF BUGGIES

3.8.1 One (1) road registered golf buggy per Team is permitted.







# **CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

## 4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with New South Wales Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
  - E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified in the Event Supplementary Regulations by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements. This person should be nominated on the Notification of Performance Personnel Form (**Rule D24**).

#### 4.2 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.2.1 The Medical Centre is located between the Figure 8 and the Supercars paddock.
- 4.2.2 Operating Hours will be updated in Further Supplementary Regulations.

- 4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at <a href="https://www.motorsport.org.au">www.motorsport.org.au</a>.

#### 5.2 CONTROL TYRES – GENERAL PRESCRIPTIONS

5.2.1 For this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D17.1.17**:

<u>D17.1.17</u> The minimum permitted pressure of a Control Tyre when fitted to a Car is <del>17psi</del> 19psi which must be achieved at any time that the Car is on the Circuit during any Session.

#### 5.3 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION

5.3.1 At this Event, replace Event 1 Sydney Motorsport Park detailed in **Table D17.7** with the following:

- 5.3.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D17.1.19**:
  - <u>D17.1.19</u> Teams are only permitted to have three (3) four (4) sets of Control Tyres mounted in their possession from the commencement of the final race of the Event, save for an Endurance Event.
- 5.3.3 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D17.7.9**:
  - <u>D17.7.9</u> At the conclusion of practice and prior to the first qualifying Session of the Event, Teams must return the "Pre-Marked" Control Tyres in addition to two sets of Soft (S) Event Marked Control Tyres to Dunlop.
- 5.3.4 Both dry tyre compounds (S) and (SS) must be used in race 1 and race 2.
  - 5.3.4.1 Only One (1) set of super-soft (SS) tyres are permitted to be used in race 1 and one (1) set of super-soft (SS) tyres in race 2.
  - 5.3.4.2 SS Control Tyres cannot be used in any other Session other than race 1 and race 2.
  - 5.3.4.3 **Rule D17.1.10** applies.







- 5.3.5 At this Event, the following new **Rule D17.7.11** will apply:
  - <u>D17.7.11</u> No later than thirty minutes (30) minutes prior to the 40 minute signal for race 1 and no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the 30 minute signal for Race 2, Teams must nominate via email (<u>motorsportoperations@supercars.com</u>) the tyre compound they will commence that race with.
    - D17.7.11.1 At the 40-minute signal for race 1 and at the 30-minute signal for race 2, the tyre compound as nominated in Rule D17.7.11 must be fitted to the Car and remain on the Car until the CPS window opens.
    - <u>D17.7.11.2</u> In the situation of **Rule D17.5.2** being declared for a race, **Supplementary Regulation 5.3.4** and **Rule D17.1.11.1** will not apply to that race.
      - a) Only one (1) set of Super-soft (SS) tyres are permitted to be used in race 1 and one (1) set of super-soft (SS) tyres in race 2.
    - <u>D17.7.11.3</u> A Teams' non-compliance with **Rule D17.7.11** will be referred to the Stewards.

# 5.6 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.6.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
  - 5.6.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.4m from the edge of the pit building upright.
- 5.6.2 outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building upright.

#### 5.7 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

- 5.7.1 For race 1 at this Event, not the following amendments to **Rule D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2**, **D8.3.3 and D8.3.3.1**:
  - <u>D8.3.1</u> <u>Thirty Forty Minutes:</u>
    - D8.3.1.1 When 30 40 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.
  - <u>D8.3.2</u> <u>Twenty-five Thirty-five</u> minutes
    - D8.3.2.1 When 25 35 minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.
- 5.7.2 <u>D8.3.3</u> <u>Fifteen Thirty</u> minutes
  - D8.3.3.1 When <u>45 30</u> minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.







## 5.8 BRIEFINGS

- 5.8.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs** (**AEDT**) on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located at the Pit Entry end of the Pit Building.
- 5.8.2 A **Refuelling Safety Briefing** will be held at **1100hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located at the Pit Entry end of the Pit Building.
  - 5.8.2.1 Attendance for the following Team personnel is compulsory for each Car:
    - a) The refuelling hose operator;
    - b) The deadman handle operator;
    - c) The Fire Attendant; and
    - d) The Authorised Representative (per Team).
  - 5.8.2.2 An attendance sheet must be signed by each Team member detailed in 5.8.2.1 above.
  - 5.8.2.3 Any Team member detailed in 5.8.2.1 who does not attend at the prescribed time and for the duration of the Briefing will:
    - a) Be referred to the Stewards; and
    - b) Be required to attend a briefing at a time and place advised by the Stewards.
- 5.8.3 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1115hrs (AEDT)** on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located at the Pit Entry end of the Pit Building.

#### 5.9 PIT STOPS

- 5.9.1 For races **1** and **2** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
  - 5.9.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
  - 5.9.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
  - 5.9.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
  - 5.9.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
  - 5.9.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

#### 5.10 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.10.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
  - 5.10.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

#### 5.11 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.11.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with Rule C4.1 and Rule C4.2.
  - 5.11.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.







## **CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL**

#### 6.1 MINIMUM WEIGHT

6.1.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**, all Drivers will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2 on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

# **CHAPTER 7 - MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL**

#### 7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.
  - 7.1.1.1 Activities are to be conducted in accordance with Team WHS COVID-19 management procedures and the Promoter's COVID-19 management procedures.

#### 7.2 GRID WALKS

- 7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks **will be** permitted (subject to COVID restrictions). Face masks are mandatory at all times.
  - 7.2.1.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.
  - 7.2.1.2 Social /physical distancing protocols must be observed.
