CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "Perth SuperSprint" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event") which will also comprise races 11 & 12 of the 2018 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Barbagallo Raceway, Perth, Western Australia on 4th – 6th May 2018.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA), the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 Event Status: Restricted International.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2018 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0830hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 3rd May 2018.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2018 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** on Thursday 3rd May 2018.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1630hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 3rd May 2018 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 2.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 2.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Thursday 3rd May 2018.
- 2.2.3 Each entry will be allocated 4 passes for the Teams car park on the outside of the Circuit.
- 2.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated 1 transit car pass for the sole purpose of delivering supplies.

2.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 2.3.1 The accreditation centre is located adjacent to Gate 1, Wattle Avenue East

4.2 BRIEFINGS

- 4.2.1 A briefing for all Competitor's Authorised Representatives will be held at 1630hrs (AWST) on Thursday 3rd May 2018 in the WASCC Media Centre North located on the first floor above the race office.
- 4.2.2 A briefing for **all Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1730hrs (AWST)** on Friday 4th May 2018 in the WASCC Media Centre North located on the first floor above the race office.

4.3 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

- 4.3.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **1000hrs** on Thursday 3rd May 2018 in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.
- 4.3.2 Tyre tents must be parallel with Team transporters, with the shortest side facing the garages.

4.4 QUALIFYING

- 4.4.1 In addition to the requirements of Rule D6, qualifying for each race will be conducted in accordance with this Supplementary Regulation and as prescribed in the Event Program.
- 4.4.2 Qualifying Race 11:
 - 4.4.2.1 Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) minutes of the Session only the bottom sixteen (16) Cars in order of the final combined classification from practice 1 and 2 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q1, the slowest ten (10) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the six (6) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
 - 4.4.2.2 Qualifying Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars in order of the final combined classification from practice 1 and 2 and the top six (6) Cars from Q1 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q2, the slowest six (6) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
 - 4.4.2.3 Qualifying Part 3 (Q3): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars from Q2 will be permitted to Compete.





4.4.3 Qualifying - Race 12:

- 4.4.3.1 Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) minutes of the Session only the bottom sixteen (16) Cars in order of the final classification from practice 4 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q1, the slowest ten (10) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the six (6) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
- 4.4.3.2 Qualifying Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars in order of the final classification from practice 4 and the top six (6) Cars from Q1 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q2, the slowest six (6) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
- 4.4.3.3 Qualifying Part 3 (Q3): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars from Q2 will be permitted to Compete.

4.5 GRID DETERMINATION

- 4.5.1 Grid positions will be determined by the final classification of qualifying and as follows:
 - 4.5.1.1 The last ten (10) grid positions will be occupied by the Cars eliminated in Q1 with the fastest Car in 17th position.
 - 4.5.1.2 The next six (6) grid positions will be occupied by the Cars eliminated in Q2 with the fastest Car in 11th position.
 - 4.5.1.3 The top ten (10) grid positions will be occupied by the Cars, which Competed in Q3 with the fastest Car in 1st position.
- 4.5.2 Cars that are disqualified from the qualifying Session will start at the rear of the grid in order of the final combined classification of practice from fastest Driver to slowest Driver.

4.6 COMPULSORY PIT STOPS

- 4.6.1 For race 11 only, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 4.6.1.1 Each Car must complete one (1) CPS.
 - 4.6.1.2 A Car may only complete its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 4.6.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 4.6.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 4.6.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

4.7 PENALTIES FOR KERB INFRINGEMENTS

- 1.1.1 With respect to turn 7 only, delete Rule **B7.6.1.1** and replace with the following: **B7.6.1.1** During any practice and qualifying session:
 - a) That lap time and the subsequent lap time will be disallowed.



CHAPTER 5 - OPERATIONS



5.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 5.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars.
- 5.1.2 Transporters must not enter the paddock prior to **0830hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 3rd May 2018.
- 5.1.3 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **1000hrs (AWST)** unless otherwise approved by the Paddock Manager.
- 5.1.4 Transporters that arrive before the time detailed in 5.1.2 will be permitted to park on the bitumen area between turns 5 and 6 on the right-hand side, off the Race Track. If the prime mover is disconnected, timber blocks must be placed under the landing legs.
- 5.1.5 Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock at any time during the Event.
- 5.1.6 Team caterers vehicles who have the required car pass are permitted to enter the Supercars paddock during transporter park up and unload on Thursday 3rd May 2018 (0830hrs to 1200hrs).

5.2 RACE TRACK WALK

5.2.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 3rd May 2018 between **1200** and **1400** hours.

5.3 TRANSPORTER DEPARTURE AFTER THE EVENT

5.3.1 Unless otherwise advised by Supercars, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **1800hrs** on Sunday 6th May 2018.

7.5 PADDOCK

- 7.5.1 Neither fuel or tyres are permitted to be carried across the pedestrian bridge.
- 7.5.2 The disposal of fuel drums and Tyres is the responsibility of the competitor. These items are not to be put in the bins at the Raceway and must be disposed of by the competitor outside the venue in a thoughtful manner and at the competitor's cost.
- 7.5.3 Only oil can be placed in the waste oil drums at the Raceway. Oil filters, coolant, brake and power steering fluids must be disposed of at the competitor's cost at a government approved collection centre. For further information see www.oilrecycling.gov.au.

7.6 HEALTH AND SAFETY

7.6.1 In line with the West Australian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

7.7 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 7.7.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 7.7.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 7.7.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 7.7.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in the exclusion from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn. The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.
