CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "SUPERCHEAP AUTO BATHURST 1000" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise race 25 of the 2019 International Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Mount Panorama, Bathurst, NSW on 8th October – 13th October 2019.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 Event Status: Restricted International.

- 1.5.1 Track Length: 6.213 kilometres
- 1.5.2 Direction: Anti-Clockwise
- 1.5.3 Track Density: Supercars – 34
- 1.5.4 Notice Board: Located on the ground floor of Tower 3, facing the Supercars Paddock.
- Located on the 2nd floor of Tower 3. 1.5.5 Stewards Office:

- 1.5.7 **Control Line:** Is located at the Finish Line and across the Pit Entry.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- Administration checking will commence at 0900hrs (AEDT) on Wednesday 9th October 2.1.2 2019.
 - 2.1.2.1 All Wildcard Drivers are required to present their licensing in accordance with Rule A5.1 including a valid Car Club Membership to the Supercars Operations Truck by **1400hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 9th October.
 - 2.1.2.2 All Wildcard Drivers are required to sign the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form by 1400hrs (AEDT) on Wednesday 9th October.





- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1730hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 9th October 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.
- 2.1.5 Any Competitor that has cross entered Drivers, must nominate their final Car Driver pairing prior to **1310hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 11th October 2019.

2.2 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

- 2.2.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>A4.3.3.1</u> I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.

Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:

- to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;
- in the opinion of the Sporting & Technical Director <u>Head of Motorsport</u>, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.

2.3 HEARINGS

- 2.3.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>B3.11.1</u> After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule <u>B8.2</u> <u>B7.2</u> impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Transporters (including prime movers) must only be parked in the Supercars Paddock.
- 3.1.3 Transporters must not enter the Circuit before **0830hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 8th October 2019.
- 3.1.4 Transporters must not be unloaded prior to **1000hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 8th October 2019.





- 3.1.5 Teams are not permitted to set up any equipment in their Pit Garage prior to the designated time to unload Transporters.
- 3.1.6 Save for Supplementary Regulations 3.1.8 and 3.2.4, no passenger vehicles are to enter the Supercars paddock from **0730hrs (AEDT)** on Tuesday 8th October 2019. Passenger vehicles with a transit pass will be permitted to enter the paddock to <u>unload only</u>, at all other times these vehicles will be required to park in the general admission car park.
- 3.1.7 Approved and accredited Team motorhomes are not permitted to enter the paddock until after **1400hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 9th October 2019.
 - 3.1.7.1 Motorhomes that arrive at the Circuit prior to the time listed above, will be permitted to park in the support category car park on the outside of the Circuit, access off Ray Bant Drive.
- 3.1.8 Vehicles with a transit pass can access the Supercars paddock by:
 - 3.1.8.1 **If the Circuit is open:** passing through the admission entry gates and reverse direction along Conrod Straight, then right into the paddock via the gate prior to the ARMOR ALL bridge. To avoid unnecessary delays, please use this entry where possible.
 - 3.1.8.2 **If the Circuit is closed:** along Panorama Drive towards the Circuit. Once at the Panorama Drive roundabout, turn left and enter Gate 1, which passes through the Chase tunnel and into the paddock area.

NOTE: The tunnel is 3.1 metres high by 2.7 metres wide.

3.1.9 Vehicles without a car pass will not be permitted entry.

3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Wednesday 9th October 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated four (4) VIP car parking passes to park in the Harris Park car park located in front of the general admission car park.
 - 3.2.3.1 All other Team vehicles will be permitted to park in the general admission car park.
- 3.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated one (1) transit car pass and will be permitted to enter the paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies.
 - 3.2.4.1 All deliveries must be completed between the hours of **1900hrs 0630hrs** (AEDT).
 - 3.2.4.2 Once deliveries are complete, Team Caterers with a transit car pass must park in the general admission car park. Vehicles located in the paddock outside the restricted delivery hours detailed in 3.2.4.1 will be towed.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation centre is located in the main Car Park to the right, off Panorama Ave.
- 3.3.2 The accreditation centre will be open at the following times (AEDT):
 - 3.3.2.1 Monday 7th Wednesday 9th October 0900 1600
 - 3.3.2.2 Thursday 10th Saturday 12th October 0630 1700
 - 3.3.2.3 Sunday 13th October 0630 1400

3.4 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

- 3.4.1 The following gate access times are permitted during the Event **(AEDT)**
 - 3.4.1.1Thursday 10th October0600hrs3.4.1.2Friday 11th October0600hrs
 - 3.4.1.3 Saturday 12th October 0600hrs
 - 3.4.1.4 Sunday 13th October 0530hrs





3.5 RACE TRACK WALK

- Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 9th October 2019 3.5.1 between 1200hrs and 1700hrs (AEDT).
- The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track 3.5.2 Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.
- Golf Buggies are permitted to be used in accordance with Supplementary Regulation 4.7. 3.5.3

3.6 TRANSPORTER DEPARTURE AFTER THE EVENT

3.6.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to two (2) hours after the completion of Race 25 on Sunday 13th October 2019 (AEDT).

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located at Pit Entry and will be operational during the following times: (AEDT):
 - 4.1.1.1 Wednesday 9th October
 - 4.1.1.2 Thursday 10th October
 - Friday 11th October 4.1.1.3
 - Saturday 12th October 4.1.1.4
 - 4.1.1.5 Sunday 13th October
- Any medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours outlined in 4.1.1, 4.1.2 please contact 000. The address to give to Emergency Services is: "Your Specific Location" E.g.: Garage 1, Pit Complex, Pit Straight, Mount Panorama, Bathurst NSW.

4.2 WATER RESTRICTIONS

4.2.1 The township of Bathurst, NSW including Mount Panorama Circuit is on level 3 water restrictions. Teams are required to adhere to all water conservation strategies in place at the Event.

4.6 24HR VENUE SECURITY

4.6.1 The 24-hour security phone number is 0498 252 121.

4.7 GOLF BUGGIES

- 4.7.1 Golf buggies must be road registered and be fitted with an operational flashing amber light, whilst in use. Road rules and event speed limits must be adhered.
- 4.7.2 No buggy movements are permitted at any time between the rear of transporters and Team garages.

4.8 TRUCK WASHING

4.8.1 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock.

4.9 DELIVERIES AND ACCESS BY NON-ENDORSED EVENT SUPPLIERS

4.9.1 It is the Team's responsibility to ensure any service providers/contractors they engage who are not an endorsed supplier, have the correct accreditation to access the venue and any applicable site safety induction is completed.

4.10 WASTE PRODUCTS

- 4.10.1 All personnel must be made aware of the fact the NO waste of any nature may be tipped into the storm water drains located with the support compound.
- 4.10.2 All storm water drains lead directly to the Macquarie River and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will be monitoring the situation in the lead up and throughout the Event.
- 4.10.3 This ban includes the washing of any wheel rims within the vicinity of storm water drains.
- 4.10.4 Competitors are advised that the EPA is taking an extremely proactive approach to this matter and Teams are put on notice that any infringement of this directive will result in action being taken by either the Promoter or the EPA or both. The EPA has the ability to prosecute offenders with heavy penalties.
- 4.10.5 The Promoter has provided an area for disposal of waste oil and/or fluid products that are located near the Circuit fuel bund. This is not for the disposal of used Car parts (i.e. oil filters etc.).

4.11 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.11.1 In line with the New South Wales Health and Safety Policy, the Supercars paddock will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

4.12 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.12.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.12.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 4.12.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 4.12.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.





4.12.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

CHAPTER 5 - SPORTING

5.1 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

- 5.1.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from 0900hrs (AEDT) on Wednesday 9th October 2019 in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.

5.3 **SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PITS AND PADDOCK**

5.3.1 Update Rule E3.2.7 with the below additional Rule: All gas cylinders must be secured and have the main valve in the fully off E3.2.7.4 position during all movements at an Event.

5.5 BRIEFINGS

- 5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1730hrs** (AEDT) on Wednesday 9th October 2019 in the Briefing Room, located adjacent to the Scrutineering Bay in the Supercars Paddock area.
- 5.5.2 A briefing for all **Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1310hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 11th October 2019 in the Briefing Room, located adjacent to the Scrutineering Bay in the Supercars Paddock area.
- 5.5.3 A Refuelling Safety Briefing will be held at **1730hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 11th October 2019 in the Briefing Room, located adjacent to the Scrutineering Bay in the Supercars paddock area. Attendance for the following Team personnel is compulsory for each Car:
 - 5.5.3.1 The refuelling hose operator
 - 5.5.3.2 The fire extinguisher operator
 - 5.5.3.3 The deadman handle operator
 - 5.5.3.4 The Authorised Representative
- 5.5.4 An attendance sheet must be signed by each Team member detailed in 5.5.3 above.
- 5.5.5 Any Team member detailed in 5.5.3 who does not attend at the prescribed time and for the duration of the Briefing will:
 - 5.5.5.1 Be referred to the Stewards; and
 - 5.5.5.2 Be required to attend a briefing at a time and place advised by the Stewards.

5.6 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.6.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Bathurst: <u>http://www.bom.gov.au./places/nsw/bathurst/</u>

5.7 WARM-UP

- 5.7.1 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during the warm-up Session on Sunday 13th October 2019.
 - 5.7.1.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
 - 5.7.1.2 Cars are required to parallel park in their pit bay during refuelling;
 - 5.7.1.3 Attire in accordance with **D22.4.5** is required; and
 - 5.7.1.4 At the conclusion of the warm-up Session, Cars are required to parallel park in their pit bay.

5.8 PRACTICE

- 5.8.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1, 3, 5 and 6.
- 5.8.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2 and 4.
- 5.8.3 The Stewards may, in their absolute discretion, order that a Driver who has not completed a suitable number of laps in practice 1, 2 or 3 combined, be required to drive the Car in another Session or Sessions. This decision of the Stewards is not susceptible to appeal.
- 5.8.4 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during practice 6.
 - 5.8.4.1 During practice 6, Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay.





5.9 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

- 5.9.1 For this Event, update the following **Rules: D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2, D8.3.2.1, D8.3.2.4, D8.3.3** and **D8.3.3.1**:
 - **<u>D8.3.1</u>** Thirty Forty Minutes:
 - **<u>D8.3.1.1</u>** When $30 \underline{40}$ minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.
 - **<u>D8.3.2</u>** Twenty-Five <u>Thirty-Five</u> Minutes:
 - **<u>D8.3.2.1</u>** When 25 <u>35</u> minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.
 - **D8.3.2.4.1** Team trolleys are required to be positioned directly behind the rear of the Car and perpendicular to the track direction.
 - D8.3.2.4.2Teams are not permitted to use a fan of any type,
with the exception of Driver cooling.
 - **D8.3.3** Fifteen <u>Twenty-Five minutes</u>:
 - **<u>D8.3.3.1</u>** When $15 \underline{25}$ minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

5.10 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

- 5.10.1 For this Event, delete Rule D10.2.13 in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - **D10.2.13** Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.
 - D10.2.13.1 Should a SC deployment end eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

5.11 AIR IMPACT TOOLS AND PRESSURE VESSELS

- 5.11.1 At this Event, delete **<u>Rule D11.3.2</u>** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - **<u>D11.3.2</u>** A Team must be equipped with a minimum of four (4) air impact tools and an air lance during any race.
 - D11.3.2.1 Pressure Sensors are not permitted to be affixed to any air line connected to an air impact tool or air lance.

5.12 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE

5.12.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D11.5.2.1</u> Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule <u>D8.1.8</u> <u>D8.1.6</u> and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

5.13 USE OF EQUIPMENT / TOOLS

5.13.1 At this Event, update **<u>Rule D11.7</u>** with the following:

D11.7.11 Teams are not permitted to use a data logger affixed on any pitlane equipment.





5.14 PIT STOPS – DRIVER CHANGE

5.14.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.

5.15 PIT STOPS

- 5.15.1 For race 25, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 5.15.1.1 Each Car must complete <u>the</u> one (1) CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2**. **Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.15.1.2 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.15.1.3 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.15.2 For this Event, delete Rule **D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - **<u>D11.8.8</u>** During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, <u>the brake lock mechanism must be</u> engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.
 - <u>D11.8.8.1</u> Where the HoM grants such approval, the <u>rear</u> wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the <u>rear</u> wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.
 - <u>D11.8.8.2</u> <u>During any Pit Stop</u>, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

5.16 PIT STOPS – PERSONNEL – FRONT BRAKE ROTOR CHANGE

- 5.16.1 Each Car may be attended by a maximum of ten (10) people (the "Designated Pit Crew") as follows, who are only permitted across the Prescribed Line when carrying out a front brake rotor change in the race:
 - D11.2.1.1 One (1) Car Controller
 - D11.2.1.2 One (1) Air Jack Operator
 - D11.2.1.3 One (1) Refueler/Vent Attendant
 - D11.2.1.4 One (1) Fire Attendant
 - D11.2.1.5 <u>Six (6)</u> Other Team members
- 5.16.2 When carrying out any other Pit Stop in the race, the requirements of **Rule D11.2.1** remain unchanged.

5.17 PARC FERME

5.17.1 At this Event, update Rule **D13.5.1** as follows:

- <u>**D13.5.1</u>** Unless otherwise authorised by the HoM, Teams are only permitted to undertake the following while any Car is in Parc Fermé:</u>
 - D13.5.1.1 Check Control Tyres pressures;
 - D13.5.1.2 Loosen the wheels;
 - D13.5.1.3 Rotate the wheels;
 - D13.5.1.4 Install cool suit loop lines and remove dry ice;
 - <u>D13.5.1.5</u> Position cooling fans in the radiator and/or brake duct in takes in the front bumper bar;
 - D13.5.1.6 Connect auxiliary power pack;
 - D13.5.1.7 One crew member is permitted to download the Data Logger;





<u>D13.5.1.8</u> Within 20 minutes of the Session being complete, data from the fastest lap and the last outing from the Session must be

- <u>uploaded to a network location specified by the MOM.</u> a. <u>For any VCS race, all data from the Session must be</u> <u>supplied:</u>
- b. For the final VCS race of the Event, data must be supplied to the Supercars Motorsport Department on the provided USB storage device within 20 minutes of the session being complete.

5.18 POINT SCORE

5.18.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D14.1.5</u> Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final <u>Classification</u> of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

5.19 CONTROL TYRES

5.19.1 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D17.1.15</u> It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.

5.20 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

- 5.20.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.
- 5.20.2 All marked front discs count towards **Rule D19.1**.

5.21 CARS TO CARRY VIDEO RECORDERS

- 5.21.1 Further to **Rule D20.3.13**, SD cards must be cleared and reformatted prior to the 40-minute signal for race 25 on Sunday 13th October 2019, however, must not be cleared prior to 30 minutes after the completion of Sunday's warm up, without the prior written permission of the HOM.
- 5.21.2 Each Team is required to ensure the SD card fitted to their Car is of sufficient size to record the entire race. It is suggested the camera settings should be set to record at a screen resolution of 720 and a frame rate of 60 FPS.

5.22 FUEL RIGS

5.22.1 Fuel rigs are not permitted to be stored in pit lane, spare garages or breezeways.

CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0730hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 10th October 2019.

6.2 MINIMUM WEIGHT

6.2.1 In accordance with the requirements of Rule C4.1.1, Wildcard Drivers and all additional Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 1 at 1055hrs (AEDT) on Thursday 10th October 2019, in the Supercars Scales Garage.





CHAPTER 7 -MARKETING

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.2 GRID WALK

- 7.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.
- 7.2.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid walk access wristband.
