POWERED SITES

Powered sites are only available in The Orchard and Motorhome Park campgrounds. If you have a powered site you will have access to either 10 amps or 15 amps. You must bring your own 25 metre lead. We cannot guarantee connection to the campground distribution board with extension cords that are shorter than 25 metres in length. All extension cords must be tested and tagged as per Electrical Testing Standards.

TICKETS AND VEHICLE PASSES

All vehicles must display the valid campsite access pass to access the campgrounds. Both motorbikes and cars require a vehicle pass. (Motorbikes can exchange their adhesive vehicle pass for a wristband at the check in points).

Vehicle passes will be distributed in August 2025 to the mailing address on your profile.

The number of vehicles is limited per site to manage space and to ensure everyone's enjoyment. Vehicles not parked within campsite lines will be towed at the owner's expense.

Q. Does my campsite ticket get me access into the Repco Bathurst 1000?

A. No. You must purchase an admission ticket to the Repco Bathurst 1000 in addition to your campsite ticket. General Admission Tickets are available via Ticketek.

Your admission ticket must be valid for the duration of your stay. To be clear, if you intend to check in in any campground at any time before 6pm Thursday 9 October, you must have a 4-day General Admission Ticket.

Corporate tickets are available via <u>our website</u>. Our Corporate Team will be able to provide options for corporate guests who are camping (noting that if you only purchase weekend corporate passes, you will need to purchase access tickets via the Team to enable camping access prior to Saturday 11 October).

CHECKING IN AND DURATION OF STAY

Q. How long do I have my campsite for?

A. You have access to your campsite for the duration of the Booking Period specified in the table below. Campers must vacate their campsite by closing time.

Once your campground opens, check-in is available between 7am – 10pm **daily** during the Booking Period, refer to the table in the following question.

<u>No check-in</u> is permitted into the campgrounds outside of these hours. Detailed instructions on how to enter all campgrounds will be provided closer to the Repco Bathurst 1000.

CAMPSITE CAPACITY AND DIMENSIONS

A maximum of eight (8) people are allowed to camp on a campsite. A valid access camping wristband is required to enter the campgrounds. The wristbands are supplied once your <u>valid</u> entry ticket is scanned. Note, if camping in the Paddock Campground, you DO NOT need to purchase a Paddock Upgrade ticket to simply camp there. <u>Please note</u>: campsites are marked out by line markers each year and subject to minor changes in size and shape. Supercars make no guarantee that the perimeters of your campsite will be straight or uniform in nature.

Q. Can I use materials to cordon off my campsite?

A. Yes, provided such materials do not exceed 1.2m high and remain within the perimeter of your campsite.

Q. Can I bring a motorhome or caravan onto my site?

A. Yes, provided it fits within the perimeters of your campsite. Please note, not all sites are flat.

Q. Is there overflow parking for additional vehicles?

A. Overflow parking is located at the main public car parking area off Panorama Ave. Parking cannot be reserved and is on a first-come-first-served basis.

AMENITIES & WASTE POINTS

Accessible amenities are located in the permanent amenity blocks in the following campgrounds:

- Reid & Sulman Campground
- McPhillamy Park Campground
- Paddock Campground
- Max Cameron Campground (temporary accessible shower and bathroom)

The event precinct has on-site dump points at the following locations:

- Paddock Campground (near Officials portable amenities block)
- Motorhome Park Campground (near main amenities block)
- The Chase Campground (main amenities block on 18th Avenue)
- The Orchard Campground (at main amenities block under gum tree)
- Reid & Sulman Campground (near entry to McPhillamy Park)
- Max Cameron Campground (main amenities block)

ALCOHOL

Each person (aged 18 years and above) can bring, and have in their possession, a maximum of ONE (1) type of the following alcohols on the campgrounds **per day** (*Maximum Quantities*):

- a) one (1) x carton (30 x 375ml cans) of full-strength beer (5% alcohol or less); or
- b) one (1) x carton (30 x 375ml cans) of light / mid strength beer (3.5% alcohol or less); or
- c) one (1) x carton (24 x 375ml cans) of pre-mixed spirits (6% alcohol or less); or
- d) one (1) x carton (24 x 375ml cans) cider (5% alcohol or less); or
- e) one (1) x sealed 4 litre cask of wine (14.5% alcohol or less); or
- f) two (2) x 375ml unopened (manufacturer's seal unbroken) plastic bottles of spirits (38 % alcohol or less); or
- g) one (1) x 750ml bottle of spirits (plastic bottle only)

Note, most campers either decant their spirits or wine into a plastic bottle at check in OR before they leave home. Whilst we appreciate that most spirits and quality wines are not produced in glass bottles, we cannot allow any glass into the campgrounds).

A reminder – you can only bring one (1) day's alcohol in each time you go through the security checkpoints.

Supercars reserves the right to confiscate any alcohol found on the campgrounds to be more than the Maximum Quantities and will not be liable to you whatsoever for such confiscation. There is no storage or "check-in" facility for excess alcohol so please make yourself aware of these limits prior to attending the event.

GAZEBOS & GROUND MARKINGS

Gazebos and associated line markings can only be erected/marked within the Event Precinct from when camping opens from 9am on Saturday October 4. Any gazebos or markings within the Event Precinct prior to this time will be removed. Please observe the line markings noting the space left for pedestrian access in locations.

DEPARTING THE CAMPGROUNDS

All rubbish is to be placed in garbage bins and large items taken off site and disposed of. Any site which is left with rubbish and items to be removed will be (a) charged a cleaning fee and (b) possibly have their right to purchase the same site in future years revoked.

CAMPFIRES

Fires are **only** permitted in campsites if:

- a) They are contained within a metal barrel, fire drum or equivalent vessel;
- b) The fire rating for the Central Ranges is not classified as Extreme or Catastrophic (as determined by the NSW Rural Fire Service); and
- c) any firewood used does not contain nails, bolts or screws.

Our official firewood supplier for 2025 will be confirmed by JUNE 2025.

LIST OF PROHIBITED ITEMS (as per conditions of entry)

- chairs, lounges, benches or stools, other than a folding chair or folding stool (unless such items remain within your vehicle);
- clothing or signage bearing any racist language or images;
- any power tool (other than battery-powered hand drills);
- glass (other than glass jars 200ml or under in size containing food preserves or other spreads);
- gas bottles heavier than 9 kilograms (inclusive of the gas);
- fuel in excess of 20 litres;
- flares or fireworks;
- prohibited or controlled weapons or firearms;
- firewood containing any nails, bolts or screws;
- drones and other unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV);
- animals other than animals recognised as assistance animals under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (Cth) (Supercars, acting reasonably, may request evidence that an animal is an assistance animal and/or is trained to meet standards of hygiene and behaviour that are appropriate for an animal in a public place); or
- any other item which Supercars reasonably believes could negatively impact, or have the potential to negatively impact the safety, security or comfort of Supercars staff or other patrons within the Campgrounds or which are prohibited under applicable legislation.

GENERAL

Q. Can I bring glass into the campgrounds?

A. <u>NO GLASS</u> is to be brought into the campgrounds, other than glass jars 200mls or under in size containing spreads or food preserves.

Q. Can I bring an axe to chop my firewood into the campgrounds?

A. A regular size axe (not exceeding 36inches or 900mm) can be brought into the campground

Q. Can I buy ice at the campgrounds?

Yes! The ice truck will once again be on site. Please note, the ice supplier accepts cash and card.

Q. Can I bring my own food?

A. Yes. There is also a range of food and beverage outlets throughout the event. Details to be communicated in September2025. Campers can bring their own food for personal consumption.

Q. Can I bring a generator?

A. Yes, generators are allowed within campgrounds however they must be turned off from 11pm – 7am each day out of respect for your neighbours.

To reduce the risk of wildfire;

- Never use generators during fire bans.
- Place the generator in an area clear of fuels, dry grass or other combustible material.
- Ensure extension leads do not cross access tracks and are rated for external use.
- Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for safe operation of your generator.
- Only operate generators in well-ventilated areas outside of tents and sleeping spaces.
- Never leave your generator unattended whilst in operation.

Q. How much fuel can I take in for my generator?

A. A 20L drum of fuel for your personal generator is the maximum amount permitted to enter the event precinct per day.

Q. Can I bring a BBQ to my campsite?

A. Yes, provided it remains on your campsite for the duration of your stay. Gas bottles must be no heavier than 9kg (inclusive of the weight of the gas) and must NOT be expired.

Q. Are gas cookers allowed?

A. Yes, personal gas cookers are allowed in campgrounds. Please note that;

- Gas bottles must be no heavier than 9kg (inclusive of the weight of the gas) and must NOT be expired.
- Your equipment must be in good working order.
- Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for safe operation of your gas cooker.
- Never light a gas cooker inside your tent or in any other enclosed area.

Q. Can I bring my pet to the campgrounds?

A. Only assistance animals (as defined under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* (Cth) will be permitted onto the campgrounds. No other pets are allowed on the campgrounds.

Q. Can I move my vehicle to come and go from the campgrounds and drive into town?

A. Yes, you may exit and re-enter the campgrounds as you please however please be aware that each time your reenter your vehicle will be searched by security at the entry gate and all passengers checked for valid wristbands. To reiterate, there are no new check-ins between 10pm – 7am daily.

Q. Is a shuttle bus service available?

A. There are several shuttle services available. Please refer to the "Getting There" section of the Event website www.supercars.com for details.

Q. I am planning on hiring a van and they are delivering it to the campground. How do they get access?

A. Please email the camping team from June 1, 2025 and advise your campground and campsite number. We will issue you with a letter to send to the van owner which will allow them access. Note, they can only deliver during check in hours and all vans / motorhomes must have left the campgrounds by 12 midday Monday October 13, 2025.

Q. I have purchased a campsite but can no longer attend this year – can I on sell it?

A. It is expected that if you have a site purchased in your name that you will be attending the event, on the site and available to assist the Bathurst Camping team should we have any queries. If you are unable to attend due to unforeseen circumstances, we will be implementing a register to detail your (a) non-attendance at the site or (b) the details of who will be on your site this year.

Q. I wish to transfer the renewal rights into a friend's name – can this be done?

A. Yes – a change of name transfer form is available on our website under IMPORTANT LINKS. Please note, all transfers for this year must be completed prior to June 10, 2025. The transfer window will reopen on November 15, 2025 however a \$50 administration fee will be charged per site transfer. *Note, consideration will be given to change of site details due to extenuating circumstances.*

BOOKING CAMPSITES

Q. I wish to attend for the first time – what are my options?

A. Please review our Public Sale tips document on our website

It can be overwhelming trying to decide what your best options are. We suggest answering a few questions first:

- What set up are you intending to bring? (tent / caravan / motorhome)?
- How big is your set up (including vehicle/s which must be parked within your site)? see campsite size chart
- Do I require power? only some sites within the Orchard campground and Motorhome Park have access
 to powered sites. Due to the cost involved with bringing in temporary power, these are the most expensive
 sites

Once you have answered these and reviewed this document to ascertain what is most suitable, please review the Campground Maps within the important links section of the <u>website</u> to understand the various sections within each campground (i.e. Chase A, Chase B etc). This will assist in allowing you to go straight to this section to check what sites are available when we go on sale.

Q. Which campsites are suitable for caravans / motorhomes?

A. All campgrounds are suitable for caravans however each campground has sites which vary in size and not all are flat! Please review the approximate campsite size details chart. We have also included some commentary on van

suitability in each campground profile. Suffice to say, sites in the Orchard, Enduro, the Chase, Max Cameron and Motorhome Park are predominantly flat with only a small percentage unsuitable for caravans.

Details on dump points and power offering is available in each campground profile.

Q. Which campgrounds are more suitable for families?

A. Families are welcome in all campgrounds and there is a nice mix of families, large groups and independent travellers. Due to limited demand, the focus will always be on getting a site that suits your needs from a space and power perspective.

Q. Which campgrounds have accessible amenities?

A. McPhillamy Park, Reid & Sulman, the Paddock all have permanent accessible toilet and showers available. Supercars are adding in portable accessible amenities Max Cameron campground. Please contact the camping team via camping@supercars.com if you require a campsite in close proximity to accessible amenities.
