CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "NTI TOWNSVILLE 500" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise of race 19 and 20 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at the Reid Park Street Circuit, Townsville, Queensland on 6th July to 10th July 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 7th July 2022.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 7th July 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.







2.2 SUBJECT OF AN INVESTIGATION NOT TO LEAVE THE EVENT

2.2.1 At this Event, delete **Rule B2.3.1** and replace with the following:

<u>B2.3.1</u> Any Driver and/or Authorised Representative of a Competitor who has received written notification from the RD or DRD that such Driver or Competitor of their Car has been involved in any Incident that is the subject of an Investigation by the RD or DRD must not leave the precincts of the Event unless that Driver and/or Authorised Representative has first obtained the permission of the Stewards.

2.3 TIME PENALTY SERVED AT NEXT PIT STOP

- 2.3.1 At this Event, delete **Rule B7.7.1.7** and replace with the following:
 - B7.7.1.7 Time Penalty, during or after the Event. Unless otherwise directed by the Stewards, a Time Penalty imposed during a Race must be served at the Car's next Pit Stop during that Race. Any Time Penalty to be served during a Pit Stop:
 - (a) May not be served while the SC boards or Red Flag are displayed or while the Race is suspended
 - (b) Must be served after the completion of all work being performed on the Car during the Pit Stop.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 At the direction of the Paddock Manager, Transporters are permitted to enter the paddock following the transporter parade at **1300hrs (AEST)** on Wednesday 6th July 2022.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **0830hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 7th July 2022 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
 - 3.1.5.1 Truck washing facilities are available at Big Boys, Webb Drive, The Bohle (07) 4774 6634.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
 - 3.2.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 8th July 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car entry will be allocated four (4) VIP car parking passes to park in the Townsville State High School field, access via First Street.
 - 3.2.2.1 Additional car parking for accredited personnel will be available in Lou Lister Park, behind Office Works off Brodie Street. (Present your Series or Event Only Accreditation to access car park).







- 3.2.2.2 There is the option to purchase additional parking in the Townsville State High School, for further information go to https://www.ivvy.com.au/event/TZ8BLD/
- 3.2.3 Team Caterer Transit Pass Each Team will be allocated one (1) transit pass to enter the VCS paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies during the hours designated on the Site Access Map that will be circulated with the Further Supplementary Regulations.
 - 3.2.3.1 All deliveries must be completed within the Site Access Map Hours.
 - 3.2.3.2 Once the delivery of supplies is completed, the vehicle must be removed from the venue and parked in one of the designated car parks detailed in Supplementary Regulation Any Cars found to be in breach of this will be reported to the Stewards.
- 3.2.4 **Grid Walk Pass collection** To be collected from the Accreditation Centre each morning of the walk.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located inside the first classroom on your left as you drive inside the Townsville State High School driveway, accessible off First Street (same location as 2019).
- 3.3.2 The Accreditation Centre operating hours are as follows (AEST):

3.3.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collecting by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticket Box Office in a marked envelope.

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 7th July 2022 **1300hrs** and **1500hrs (AEST).**

3.5 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

3.5.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.6.1 Unless otherwise approved by the Motorsport Operations Manager, the use of Buggies is not permitted inside the VCS paddock. All buggies must park on the outside of the VCS paddock at Paddock Gate 2.
- 3.6.2 Teams are to email accreditation@supercars.com if they intend operating a buggy at the Event. An accreditation sticker will then be issued to the Team. The deadline for applications is Friday 24th June.







CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the Queensland State Government COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
 - E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified in the Event Supplementary Regulations by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements.

4.7 ALCOHOL. DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- 4.7.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

CHAPTER 5 - SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.1.1 The Event operating hours (AEST), for the purpose of Rule E2.1.1 are as follows:

5.1.1.1 Friday 8th July 2022 0730 – 1710

5.1.1.2 Saturday 9th July 2022 0700 – end of VCS R19 5.1.1.3 Sunday 10th July 2022 0730 – end of VCS R20

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.1.2**.

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.2.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Townsville: http://www.bom.gov.au/qld/forecasts/townsville.shtml

5.3 BRIEFINGS

- 5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs** (AEST) on Thursday 7th July 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located at Pit Exit.
- 5.3.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1745hrs (AEST)** on Friday 8th July 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located at Pit Exit.

5.4 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.4.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
 - 5.4.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.2m and parallel from the edge of the steel bracket on the Pit Building upright.
 - 5.4.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.5 PRACTICE AND USE OF REFUELLING TOWER

- 5.5.1 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during practice 2.
- 5.5.2 The use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session.
- 5.5.3 During practice 2, Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay.
- 5.5.4 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
- 5.5.5 At the conclusion of the practice 2, Cars in Pit Lane are permitted to parallel park in their pit bay.







5.6 PIT STOPS

- 5.6.1 For races **19 and 20** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 5.6.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.6.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 5.6.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.6.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 5.6.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.7 CONTROL TYRES – GENERAL PRESCRIPTIONS

- 5.7.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D17.1.17**:
 - <u>D17.1.17</u> The minimum permitted pressure of a Control Tyre when fitted to a Car is 17psi <u>19psi</u> which must be achieved at any time that the Car is on the Circuit during any Session.
- 5.7.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D17.1.19**:
 - <u>D17.1.19</u> Teams are only permitted to have three (3) four (4) sets of Control Tyres mounted in their possession from the commencement of the final race of the Event, save for an Endurance Event.

5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION

- 5.8.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D17.7.9**:
 - <u>D17.7.9</u> At the conclusion of practice and prior to the first qualifying Session of the Event, Teams must return the "Pre-Marked" Control Tyres in addition to two sets of Hard (H) Event Marked Control Tyres to Dunlop.
- 5.8.2 Both dry tyre compounds (H) and (SS) must be used in race 19 and race 20.
 - 5.8.2.1 Only One (1) set of super-soft (SS) tyres are permitted to be used in race 19 and one (1) set of super-soft (SS) tyres in race 20.
 - <u>5.8.2.2</u> SS Control Tyres cannot be used in any other Session other than race 19 and race 20.
 - 5.8.2.3 Rule **D17.1.10** applies.
- 5.8.3 At this Event, the following new **Rule D17.7.11** will apply:
 - <u>D17.7.11</u> No later than thirty minutes (30) minutes prior to the 30- minute signal for race 19 and race 20, Teams must nominate via email (motorsportoperations@supercars.com) the tyre compound they will commence that race with.
 - <u>D17.7.11.1</u> At the 30-minute signal for race 19 and for race 20, the tyre compound as nominated in **Rule D17.7.11** must be fitted to the Car and remain on the Car until the CPS window opens.
 - <u>D17.7.11.2</u> In the situation of **Rule D17.5.2** being declared for a race, **Supplementary Regulation 5.8.2** and **Rule D17.7.11.1** will not apply to that race.
 - <u>D17.7.11.3</u> A Teams' non-compliance with **Rule D17.7.11** will be referred to the Stewards.







5.9 DRIVER BATH WATER - DRAINAGE

5.9.1 At this Event, drainage of Driver baths is prohibited until 1 hour after the conclusion of VCS race 20. Teams are to empty Driver baths at the front of Team transporters, no water or bath fluids are permitted to flow towards garages or into another Teams pack up areas.

5.10 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

5.10.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System <u>will</u> be operational. 5.10.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.11 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.11.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.
 - 5.11.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.

5.12 AIR IMPACT TOOLS AND PRESSURE VESSELS

- 5.12.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.3.2 a):**
 - <u>D11.3.2</u> At each Event, a Team must be equipped with a minimum of four (4) air impact tools and an air lance; of which:
 - a) maximum of two (2) air impact tools may be used at SuperSprint Events (save for tool failure); and
 - b) a maximum of four (4) air impact tools may be used at all other Events.

5.13 REFUELLING EQUIPMENT

5.13.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Schedule D4. 1.4.2** and **1.5.2**:

Schedule D4. 1.4.2 Have an ID no greater than 51mm (2 inch); and Schedule D4. 1.5.2 The maximum ID of the vent hose is 51mm (2 inch); and
