### STEWARDS SUMMARY OF JUDICIAL OUTCOMES, Update #2 (Final): Saturday, 6<sup>th</sup> October 2018 at 2200hrs.

#### Matters from the Race:

##### Deputy Race Director Incident Determinations

The RD conducted a post-Race investigation into an incident involving Car #88 Paul Dumbrell and Car #23 Dean Fiore on the exit of Turn 2 on Lap 4. Following a review of Television Broadcast Footage and Judicial Camera Footage from Car #23 and #62, neither Driver was wholly or predominately to blame for the incident.

The RD conducted a post-Race investigation into an incident involving Car #8 Zane Goddard and Car #67 Shae Davies on the exit of Turn 2 on Lap 4. Following a review of Television Broadcast Footage and Judicial Camera Footage from Car #62, neither Driver was wholly or predominately to blame for the incident.

##### Stewards' Decisions – Penalties imposed

The Stewards imposed a Pit Lane drive through Penalty on Car #5 Thomas Randle, for a breach of Supplementary Regulation 4.7 - Pit Stop personnel infringement, not behind the Prescribed Line.

After a post-race RD investigation and an admission by Car #57 Brodie Kostecki, of a breach of Schedule B2 Article 2.1.2 (Code of Driving Conduct, Reckless Driving – contact with Car #49 Jordan Boyce, at Turn 21 on Lap 33), the Stewards imposed the penalty of the Loss of 35 Dunlop Super2 Series Points on Car #57 Brodie Kostecki.

After a post-race RD investigation and an admission by Car #56 Jake Kostecki, of a breach of Schedule B2 Article 2.1.2 (Code of Driving Conduct, Reckless Driving – contact with Car #55 Kurt Kostecki, at Turn 1 on Lap 8), the Stewards imposed the penalty of the Loss of 35 Dunlop Super2 Series Points on Car #56 Jake Kostecki.

After a post-race RD investigation and an admission by the Competitor, Eggleston Motorsport Australia Car #38 and Car #63, to a breach of the Supplementary Regulation 4.12 - The use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted during the Session, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$1,000.

## STEWARDS SUMMARY OF JUDICIAL OUTCOMES

For causing the Red Flag to be displayed during a qualifying session, Car #56 Jake KostECKI, had his fastest lap in the session deleted and was not permitted to take any further part in the session.

The fastest time for Car #8 Zane Goddard in the Session was deleted by the Stewards for a breach of the Red Flag procedures, in that Car was observed transiting the Pit Lane prior to signal given to open the Pit Exit.

After a post-race RD investigation and an admission by Car #62, Alex Rullo, to a breach of Rule D11.5.10.3, in that Car #62 entered the Pit Lane after the Chequered Flag was displayed, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$500.

### **Matters from Briefing:**

After a Stewards Hearing and an admission by Dunlop Super2 Competitor for a breach of the Event's Supplementary Regulation 4.2.3 Supercars Refuelling Briefing, in that the DS2 Team's Authorised Representative did not attend the briefing, the Stewards imposed a Fine of \$500 on each of the following Competitors;

- KostECKI Brothers Racing
