The Crocker's award-winning mobile education center invites an entire school to explore and celebrate our nation's rich and diverse cultural landscape with *American Narratives*, an interactive exhibition that explores the power of storytelling and allows students to study the lives and art of North American artists, many from the Sacramento region. Students engage in hands-on art activities as they build visual literacy skills and discover how art can tell stories.

- Up to 175 students per day.
- Pricing starts at \$4,100 per five-day installation. Extended visits are available.
- Six-week advance registration required. Spots fill quickly!

Let the Museum come to you! Crocker docents engage students grades 3 – 6 with a one-hour, interactive multimedia presentation of works from the Museum's collection in your classroom. Students learn strategies for looking, reading, and thinking critically about a work of art. These visits are also a great way to introduce your class to the Museum before an in-person visit.

Guided Museum Tour

Journey into art on view with a 50-minute guided tour led by one of the Museum's docents. Guided school group tours are interactive experiences aligned with State standards and designed to expose your students to the Museum's collection and special exhibitions. A docent will work with you to customize the tour to the needs of your class.

- The museum can accommodate up to 120 students per hour. Students will be divided into smaller sub-groups of no more than 15 per group.
- One adult chaperone is required per sub-group of students. Adult-to-student ratios will be provided at time of booking, based on group size.
- Cost is \$5 per student, \$3 per student of Title 1 schools.
- Free for required chaperones, \$10 per additional adult.
- Six-week advance registration required.
- Tours book quickly. The earlier you make your reservation, the better!



Guided Museum Tour + Workshop

Enhance your guided tour with a paired artmaking workshop. During this two-hour experience, students explore artworks in the galleries with a docent, then join Museum educators in the studio to create their own work of art.

- Mixed media or sketching workshops offered.
- The Museum can accommodate up to 35 students for each Tour + Workshop. Students will be divided into smaller sub-groups of no more than 15 per group for the tour.
- One adult chaperone is required per sub-group of students. Adult-to-student ratios will be provided at time of booking, based on group size.
- Pricing starts at \$350 per workshop. Costs vary based on subject and number of students.
- Six-week advance registration required.
- Tour + Workshop dates fill quickly! Book well in advance for best availability.



Homeschool Day

Explore the Crocker with a Museum experience designed specifically for homeschool students and parents. This drop-in program allows groups to structure their own experience—at their own pace, in the order they choose—while in community with other homeschoolers.

Follow a customized map that highlights gallery and studio spaces where docents, educators, and teaching artists are ready with a discussion or activity centered around that day's theme. Stay after the program to explore more of the Museum.
