Onboarding

Welcome

We welcome you as a new partner school to deliver Connect 'n' Grow[®] health programs. We are excited to have you onboard. Below you will find information on assisting you with the onboarding process and what to expect and timeframes. Third Party Agreement

The Third-Party Agreement is registered with ASQA and DESBT and a fully signed copy provided for your records.

School Teacher Upskilling

Teachers who will be delivering our Program are required to provide their TAE, The Assessor Skill Set or VET delivered to School Students Teacher Enhancement Skill Set, First Aid and CPR, teacher registration and CV. Teachers are upskilled with our qualifications via a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) process, this is called the Teacher Accelerated Program (TAP).

School Teacher Working Under Supervision

Teachers who are actively working towards their TAE can work under Supervision with a Connect 'n' Grow[®] Expert Health Trainer to train and assess our Qualifications.

School Teacher Professional Development Days

Connect 'n' Grow[®] hold professional development day throughout Queensland in Week 7 of Term 1 and Week 9 or Term 4. This provides Teachers with Industry and VET Currency.

School Subject Selection Material

Only approved subject selection material may be used, which includes a Parent Letter providing information to students and parent/guardian on completing our Programs.

Trainer Resources

Teachers will receive access to the Trainers Portal on Canvas to a number of resources which will assist them in planning to deliver our Program.

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Student Enrolment

Student enrolment links are sent out mid-term 4 to the school Trainer and Program Manager for the following year cohort of students to start enrolling into the program. A number of checks are completed, and students then obtain access to the induction at the start of the new school year. If students do not enrol until the school year has commenced, a delay in accessing the induction can happen.

LLN

Students are required to complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test as part of completing the induction which is paper based. Teachers can download this from the Trainers Portal prior to commencing.

Student Access to Units of Competency (UOC)

Students receive access to the UOC after completing the induction and LLN, and when confirmation of student enrolment and VETiS is received by from the Program Manager, which is completed via email. Teachers can still teach using the resources in the Trainers Portal whilst they are waiting for student access.

Expert Health Trainer (EHT)

An EHT is allocated to your school to mark self-paced units, final checks on units of competency and deliver the incursions.
