CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN [NAME OF CONSIGNOR] AND [NAME OF CONSIGNMENT STORE]

Description of Goods

1. The consignor agrees to provide the following items for sale through the consignment store: [DESCRIPTION OF GOODS, INCLUDING QUANTITY, BRAND, AND CONDITION].

Liability and Insurance

7. The consignor is responsible for insuring the goods against loss or damage during shipping. The consignment store is not responsible for any loss or damage to the goods that occurs during shipping or while they are in the possession of the consignor. The consignment store is responsible for insuring the goods while they are in its possession.

Termination and Withdrawal

8. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by giving written notice to the other party. The consignor may withdraw any unsold items at any time during the consignment period by providing written notice to the consignment store. The consignor must pay any outstanding fees or charges before withdrawing any items.

Dispute Resolution

9. Any disputes that arise under this agreement shall be resolved by binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association. Each party shall bear its own costs of arbitration.

Governing Law

10. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of [STATE], without regard to its conflict of law provisions.
