1	Visa application form filled in online through the e-konsulat system and printed and signed.		
2	3.5 x 4.5 cm color biometric photograph. Required features for photography: a. The background is white, the sharpness is well adjusted and it is printed on high quality paper, b. Taken within the last 6 months, c. The face should cover 70-80% of the photograph, taken from the front, from the top of the head to the top of the shoulder, showing the eyes and face clearly. When taking photos, items that cover the head (hat) and glass-colored dark glasses should be removed.		
3	Passport that is not older than ten years, valid for at least 3 months after the expiry date of the requested visa, and has at least two blank pages for visas. If there is another valid passport in possession, it must be attached to the visa application.		
4	Passport Protocol.		
5	A photocopy of the passport page with the personal data and the photo, as well as copies of visas from Poland or other Schengen countries issued within the last 3 years.		
6	Health insurance valid on the territory of the Republic of Poland with a coverage of at least 30,000 euros, covering each day within the planned stay. An informative text on insurances that meet the requirements of the Foreigners Act of 12 December 2013 is available on the website of the Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs https:// www.gov.pl/web/turkiye/ulusal-vize-d-tipi-vize-basvurusunda-bulunmak-istiyoruz		
7	Proof of Residence and Other Address. For foreign nationals who do not have Turkish citizenship, a Residence and Other Address Document showing that the region where your residence is located is under the jurisdiction of the consulate where the visa application is made, as well as a work/residence permit card valid at least until the start date of the planned trip.		
8	If the Applicant is a Student; Copy of student ID card / Student Certificate.		
9	Criminal Record		
10	Complete extract of the civil registry		
11	Military Status Certificate (Over the age of 35 or present a current student certificate proving student status in Turkey except for those who do).		
12	Invitation letter from a university, language school or institution in Poland (original and photocopy)		
13	Diploma of the last graduated school.		
14	Proof of accommodation (confirmation from the inviting company, hotel reservation or rental contract)		
15	If he/she has been abroad for a preparatory or language course before, proof of completion of school		
16	Confirmation of the payment made to the educational institution for the education to be received. (must be offered if the training is paid)		
17	A. A current account statement with wet signature and stamp obtained from the bank of the person and for the last three months, sufficient to cover the costs of stay in Poland; OR B. In the event that the costs are borne by the family or the sponsor. Notarized Letter of Undertaking prepared in the name of the person covering the expenses and a current account statement with wet signature and stamp from the bank for the last three months, sufficient to cover the costs of staying in Poland; C. Grant letter.		
18	Visa application fee (non-refundable in case of rejection of the visa application).		

ATTENTION

- The required documents must be up-to-date (less than 3 months old), the original documents and a photocopy must be submitted.
- I am aware that if I do not submit one or more of the above-mentioned documents, my visa request may be rejected.
- In addition to the above-mentioned documents, the Consul may request the submission of other documents and may call the applicant for an interview.

8	Proof of Residence and Other Address. 9	Proof of sufficient financial resources or proof of regular income - Account statement for the last 3 months, - Credit card statements, or - A letter stating the position and salary information of the employee for the last 3 months taken from the workplace, - Document showing that a pension has been received, if any ,			
10	Flight reservation or other document proving the planned means of transportation or travel document that proves the itinerary.			
11	Proof of accommodation (e.g. original and photocopy of official invitation or hotel reservation).			
12	Document confirming the purpose and conditions of the planned stay in the territory of the Republic of Poland.			
13	For minors travelling alone: a notarized statement from the parents - a letter of consent or, in the case of only one of the parents: written permission from the other parent/guardian (original and photocopy) is required. *In cases where it is not possible to obtain such consent - documents explaining the reason for such a deficiency (statement or other documents confirming the special situation of the single parent). Birth certificate (original and photocopy). Copies of the passports and valid visas of the parents or guardians in case of traveling together. In addition, the following documents must be attached to the Schengen visa application, regardless of the purpose of travel.
