1	Visa application form duly completed and signed			
2	Recent passport size photo (white background) taken within the last 6 months, clear facial features and eyes – not covered by hair or glasses frame			
3	Valid Passport + copy of data page – valid for at least 3 months after intended return to the home country with at least 2 blank pages, issued in the previous 10 years			
4	<p>Valid proof of legal residence in the country where the applicant is applying for the visa.</p> <p>The applicant must prove that he is legally residing in the country where he is submitting visa application.</p> <p>Non-residence applicant – residence permit + copy- valid for 3 months beyond the intended date of departure from the territory of the Member States</p>			
5	<p>Traveller profile (family ties and travel history)</p> <p>For first-time applicants or applicants who have lost their passport: The Mogamma (movement) certificate (indicating if the applicant has had previous passports and if the applicant has previously travelled to the Member States)</p> <p>Proof of the applicant's family ties and marital status in Egypt through an extract of the Kid Aely family register (for all applicants).</p>			
6	<p>Proof of social or economic ties to the country where the applicant lives.</p> <p>original bank account statements with an official bank stamp and signature and translations of the statements, showing activity over the last 6 months, or proof of other assets</p> <p>If the applicant is employed: a recent statement from the applicant's employer stating the job title, contract duration and salary and leave approval. The certificate has to be signed and stamped or a certificate of employment.</p> <p>If the applicant is self-employed: a business permit or a photocopy of their income tax return, plus bank statements from the previous 6 months</p> <p>If the applicant is a student: a document proving they are enrolled in a study programme in their country of residence. The document must state the area of study and the duration of the programme.</p> <p>A document showing that the applicant has a home or other immovable property in their country of residency</p>			

7	<p>Document proving the purpose of the stay- medical purpose Purpose of the stay: Certificate from the referring doctor in Egypt and/or a medical institution stating the kind of medical treatment or examination needed.</p> <p>Official document from the receiving medical institution confirming that it can perform the specific medical treatment and that the patient will be accepted accordingly, including an estimate of the cost of the treatment.</p> <p>Financial guarantee: Confirmation of prepayment of the medical treatment or any other proof of the financial arrangements made</p>			
8	<p>Confirmation of accommodation a) prepaid hotel reservation; b) confirmation of hotel reservation; c) confirmation of prepaid accommodation; d) confirmation of private accommodation, mentioning that the host will cover the accommodation costs; e) proof of rental or ownership of real estate in Slovakia</p>			
9	<p>If the visa application for a minor child (under 18)</p> <p>Minors (under 18 years of age) travelling alone (without parents/legal guardian):</p> <p>Birth certificate</p> <p>If minors travel without their legal guardian(s): consent of the parental authority (both parents) or legal guardian(s) must be provided either through a notarised certificate or a form signed at the consulate premises or at the external service provider.</p> <p>If minors travel with only one of their legal guardians: consent of the parental authority or legal guardian not travelling with their minor child must be provided through a notarised certificate or a form signed at the consulate premises or at the external service provider.</p> <p>If 1 of the parents or guardians has a valid Schengen visa: a colour photocopy of the biographical data page of their passport and of their valid Schengen visa.</p> <p>If 1 of the parents or guardians passed away: a photocopy of the death certificate of the deceased parent or guardian.</p> <p>If a guardian has been appointed: a photocopy of official proof of guardianship</p> <p>If there is a court order in place: a photocopy of permission from the court for the minor to travel.</p>			
10	<p>Travel medical insurance The document must state that: • The insurance provides cover in all Schengen area countries for the entire duration of the applicant's stay. • The insurance covers at least €30,000 in medical expenses. This includes the costs of a hospital stay and treatment, emergency care, prescription medication and repatriation to the applicant's country of residence (including in the event of death)</p>			
11	<p>Document indicating the date and means of transport to the Slovak Republic (air ticket reservation)</p>			

By signing this checklist, I understand that my visa may be denied and I will not receive a refund of the visa fee if I do not submit all the requested documents. All presented documents should be in English or translated to English or Slovak.

I have been informed that the Slovak Embassy should decide on my visa application within 15 days of the date of lodging. Decision making period may be extended up to a maximum of 45 calendar days.

Due to the fact that I have submitted my visa application later than 15 days before my planned trip, the decision may not be taken on time and I will bear all responsibility for any damage, including financial, which may occur in such case
