

ORDINANCE OF MINISTER OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS
from 23 February 2015.

Regarding the financial means required from the foreigner entering the territory of Polish Republic and documents that can confirm the possibility of obtaining such funds along with the purpose and duration of the intended stay. On the basis of art. 26 paragraph. 1 of the Act of 12 December 2013. Aliens (Dz. U. item. 1650 and 2014. Pos. 463 and 1004) is hereby ordered as follows:

§ 1. The Regulation sets out:

- 1) the amount of financial resources required from a foreigner entering the territory of the Republic of Poland intended to cover:
 - a) maintenance of the alien throughout his stay on the territory,
 - b) trip back to the country of permanent residence,
 - c) transit through territory to a third country, which grants permission to enter;
- 2) documents which may confirm the possibility of obtaining funds, referred to in point 1 in accordance with the law;
- 3) documents which may confirm the purpose and duration of the planned stay of a foreigner in case purpose or the duration of the intended stay was followed by differentiation of measures.

§ 2. 1. An alien entering the territory of the Polish Republic must have the financial resources, referred to in § 1 point 1 and, at least:

- 1) 300 PLN, if the period of intended stay does not exceed 4 days;
- 2) 75 PLN for each day of planned stay if the period of intended stay exceeds 4 days – or equivalent of this amount in the foreign currency.

2. Foreigner entering the territory of the Polish Republic, which:

- 1) participates in a tourist event, youth camp, sports competitions,
- 2) has paid the costs of staying in the Republic of Polish,
- 3) is going to a medical sanatorium,
- 4) is a participant of a program which enables to perform summer jobs on the territory of Poland, which is not the main purpose of his stay, and the program is regulated by an international agreement in which the Republic Poland is participating.
- must possess the financial resources, referred to in § 1 point 1 and, in at least 20 PLN for each day of the planned stay, but not less than 100 PLN, or its equivalent in foreign currencies.

3. An alien entering the territory of the Polish Republic in order to take up or continue studies, for participation in researches or trainings, for performing developmental work or to undertake or continue their education, must have the financial resources, referred to in § 1 point 1 and, at least 1,086 PLN for the first two months of the planned stay or its equivalent in foreign currencies.

§ 3. A foreigner must have the financial resources, referred to in § 1 point 1 b or c, in the amount equivalent to the ticket, on the basis of which arrived on Polish territory, but not less than:

- 1) 200 PLN, if he came from the neighboring country of the Polish Republic,
- 2) 500 PLN if he came from the European Union Member State other than referred to in paragraph 1,
- 3) 2500 PLN if you come from a non-member of the European Union
- Or its equivalent in foreign currencies.

§ 4. 1. The documents, which can confirm the possibility of obtaining by a foreigner funds referred to in § 1 point 1 can be:

- 1) traveler's check;
- 2) a certificate of the limit on a credit card issued by a bank or credit institution that issued the credit card;
- 3) proof of possession of money in the bank or cooperative savings or in a credit institution established in Poland or in another Member State The European Union.

2. Document that can confirm ownership by a foreigner of funds referred to in § 1 point 1 b and c, may also be a return ticket entitling to travel to that country.

3. A document that can confirm ownership by a foreigner of funds referred to in § 2. 3, may also be proof of a granted scholarship for the foreigner.

4. The certificates referred to in paragraph. 1 point 2 and 3 shall be issued not earlier than one month before crossing the border.

§ 5. Documents that can confirm the purpose and duration of the intended stay of aliens, mentioned in § 2. 2 are:

- 1) a document confirming participation in a tourist trip, a youth camp or sports events;
- 2) proof of payment of the costs of residence in the Polish Republic in terms of covering at least the costs of accommodation and meals;
- 3) referral to medical or sanatorium facilities;
- 4) visa to attend a summer work program that contains the name of the program set out in the "Remarks".

§ 6. A document that can confirm the purpose and duration of the planned stay of a foreigner referred to in § 2. 3, a certificate of enrollment or continuation of studies, participation in research, training, conducting research and development and to undertake or continue learning.

§ 7. The conversion into Polish currency held by a foreigner funds in foreign currency shall be the average exchange rate for that currency announced by the National Polish Bank on the last working day preceding the alien's entry into the Polish territory.

§ 8. The Regulation shall enter into force after 14 days from the date of publication.
