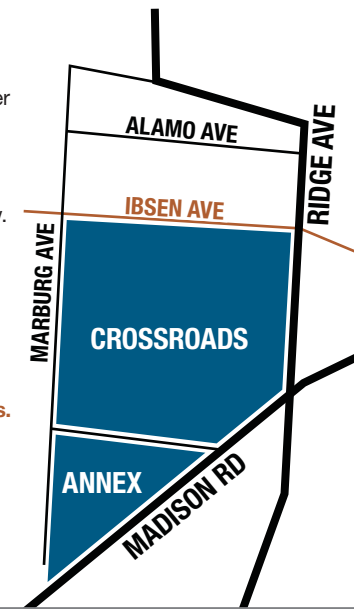
alert for Oakley
