RAMP TO 71 S REOPENED

The on-ramp from Ridge Ave to southbound 71 is open to traffic again. Some construction crews will still be there working through September to build a retaining wall, but the ramp should remain open.

CITYLINK GROUNDBREAKING

CityLink will break ground at 800 Bank Street some time later this month. The facility will include an 80,000 square-foot building on a five acre campus. The building will be re-purposed from the existing structure, an idle food processing plant, to include classrooms, offices, meeting spaces and computer labs.
