How our South Africa partnership began?

It was the summer of 1999 and Brian Tome was at a conference in Chicago. The conference was great, but during a break between sessions Brian itched for something to do or someone to meet. He introduced himself to a pastor who walked by. He didn't know him—he just thought he might be nice to talk to. It turned out the pastor had started a church with a heart very similar to Crossroads, only his was halfway around the world. His name was Titus Sithole, and he was the pastor of Charity and Faith Mission Church in Mamelodi, South Africa. Over the next several years their conversations, meetings and e-mails developed into discussions about how both churches could work together to help reach more people, both here and in Africa, with God's love. The relationship has evolved into a strategic partnership between Crossroads and Charity and Faith Mission, including the development and construction of the Bophelong Community Hospice and AIDS care facility in Mamelodi, multiple business start-ups and hundreds of people from opposite sides of the world in intimate community with one another. Not bad for one "not-so-chance" encounter in the hallway at a conference 10 years ago.
