# WHY CITYLINK +

Despite the heroic efforts of hundreds of ministries and social service agencies, one out of every four Cincinnatians still live in poverty. That's nearly twice the national average. We believe that's unacceptable.

Extensive research has shown that integrated, multi-service centers are bestin-class. Leading private charities, such as the Annie E. Casey Foundation, and cities like Miami and St. Louis are having success with this approach. So CityLink Center was founded to integrate services under one roof and to better serve the poor in Cincinnati.

We've developed a transformational program that will move people in poverty to self-sufficiency. We've identified key partners and engaged 40 local churches. Construction is underway, and the CityLink Center is expected to open this fall.

We believe God is calling us to make a real difference in the lives of those in need in our city, and we know we can't make a dent in the problem playing by the old rules of the game. So we're changing it up. The stakes are too high, and the problem too great, to do anything less.
