# JEFF & AMY

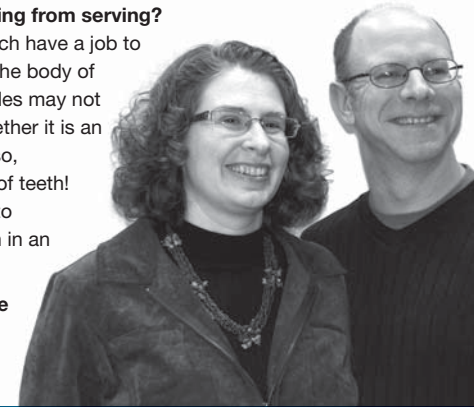
Kids' Club volunteers Jeff and Amy Hammond serve in Kindergarten at 10am. They love to hang out with kids and build connections with them.

We always get more than we give, and it's a lot of fun.

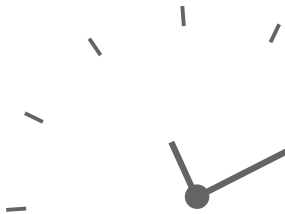
