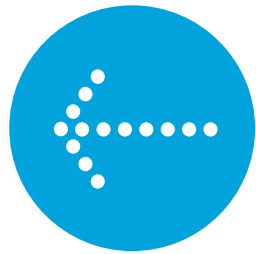
Q: Mainstream culture has adopted some gems of Bible wisdom over the years, but how about this line? Is this from the Bible?

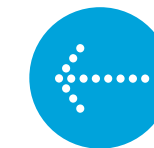
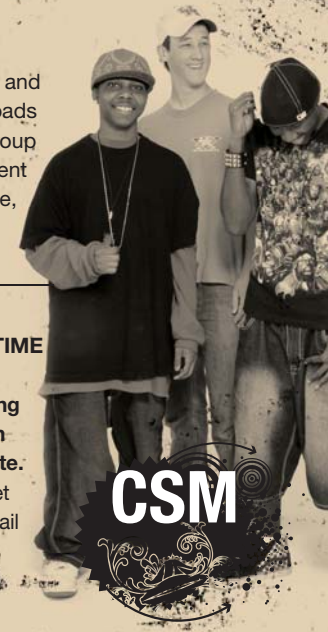


do your own THING

GET IN A SMALL GROUP
