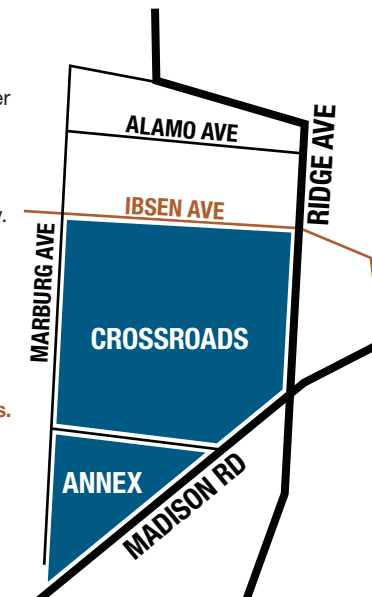
## alert for Oakley

The Kennedy Connector, which will give Ridge and Madison better access from I-71, is under way. The city is working with us to minimize our impact, and we are working hard to adapt traffic flow.
