MULTI-SITE

Crossroads began in 1996, the result of 11 people wanting a place to invite their friends who had given up on "church" but not on God. Since then, we've grown, but the goal is the same: connect people seeking God with a community of growing Christfollowers.

But we're nearing capacity and need to expand. So we're opening additional locations where our friends and neighbors live. That way they can spend more time connecting with each other and God, and less time driving (or not going to church at all.)

Crossroads Mason opened in 2008, and Crossroads Florence will open in late August. Even though they are in different sites, they aren't separate churches. We operate as one church with one senior pastor, one board of directors, one bank account, one staff and the same message each weekend. And we'll continue to mobilize as one team with a unified vision, ready to bless our city in increasing ways.
