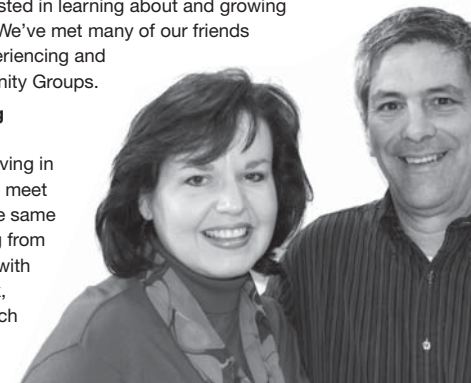
John and Camille Prado lead the Love and Respect Community Group for married couples.
