- > Endorsement from Internship Manager or Mentor
- > Continued active participation in Crossroads Church
- > Candidates not currently living near a Crossroads location will need to relocate to participate in the program.

WHAT ARE THE CORE COMPONENTS OF THE PROGRAM?

> Hands-on Experience

Practical ministry responsibilities at a specified site or ministry, including exposure to various ministries.

> Development

Regular intervals of equipping to prepare Fellows for perseverance in ministry and general professionalism.

> Staff Coach

We assign a 1-on-1 coach who will help with navigating staff cultural norms and provide a safe space for processing.

> Crossroads Community

For the duration of the fellowship there is an expectation of being a part of the Crossroads community, including: attending weekly services, finding a group, tithing, and regularly serving in a ministry.
