#### **Docu Shots**

Inventory Number + Photographer Initials + Date (YYMMDD) E.g. CREED31487 BG050704.tif

If no inventory number is given, please use the artist's abbreviation, e.g. *APPLE, CREED, GENZK, ORR C, RUBY*, etc.

### **Multiple Views**

- Different views of the same artwork/exhibition should be named: view01, view02, etc.
- Multiple parts of the same artwork should be named: part01, part02, etc. (alternatively: 10f3, 2of3, 3of3), e.g. *CREED31487 2of3 BG.tif*, etc.
- If you take photos of double-sided artworks please refer to the front as recto, the back as verso.
- In case of movie stills, please indicate as: still, e.g. RIST 28374 still1 BG.tif.

#### **Installation Views**

Artist Abbreviation + iv (for Installation View) + Institution + Date YYMM + Photographer Initials + viewXX

E.g. CREEDiv HWZ 0506 BU.tif or HOUSEiv New Museum 1305 TM view01.tif

HWZ = Hauser & Wirth Zurich HWL = Hauser & Wirth London HWNY/ HWNY69 / HWNY18 = Hauser & Wirth New York HWSLA = Hauser Wirth & Schimmel Los Angeles HWSO = Hauser & Wirth Somerset HWC = Hauser & Wirth Collection Henau
