

# Hauser & Wirth at West Bund Art & Design 2024

- Historic gems from masters Louise Bourgeois and Philip Guston
- In a first for the gallery at a fair in Asia, a wall painting by Martin Creed will be installed directly on four walls
  of the booth
- Debut of new large-scale canvases by Angel Otero and Catherine Goodman
- Contemporary highlights by Camille Henrot, whose work is also on view at Jing'an Sculpture Park in Shanghai, Rita Ackermann and Zhang Enli, among others

Hauser & Wirth's booth at West Bund Art & Design this year reveals exceptional works by historical masters Louise Bourgeois and Philip Guston, alongside leading contemporary voices, such as Rita Ackermann, Barbara Chase-Riboud, Martin Creed, Catherine Goodman, Camille Henrot, Jenny Holzer, Roni Horn, Takesada Matsutani, Angel Otero, Pipilotti Rist, Avery Singer and Zhang Enli.

## Booth highlights:

Major historic highlights include Philip Guston's 'Untitled (Red and Black Book)' (1969) from an important body of work that marked a pivotal point in the artist's extraordinary career. The cartoon-like books epitomize the distinctive visual lexicon the artist developed during the last 12 years of his life. Louise Bourgeois's 'The Pacifiers (#8)' (2007) depicts vertical lines composed of biomorphic forms. This remarkable work belongs to the group of prints Turning Inwards (2005-2010), widely acclaimed for their complexity and large scale.

In a first for the gallery at a fair in Asia, Turner Prize winning artist Martin Creed's conceptual wall paintings will be installed directly on four walls of the booth. Through minimal interventions which treat all elements equally, he allows materials to speak for themselves, making no separation between his work and everyday life, between art galleries and the outside world.

Further standout works in the presentation include the debut of Angel Otero's new large-scale painting 'Red Mangrove' (2024) and Catherine Goodman's 'Lemongrass' (2024). These are accompanied by contemporary highlights, including Camille Henrot's 'Dependent Personality Disorder' (2014) from her Desktop Series (2013-2014). Referring to the use of the computer desktop as a space of creation, the sculpture counterbalances the immateriality of digital desktops through the weightiness and tangibility of bronze. Henrot's large-scale bronze work 'Undelivered Message' (2016) is currently on view at Jing'an Sculpture Park through the end of the year.

Other showstoppers include 'A Nostalgic Person' (2023) by Zhang Enli from his abstract portraits, capturing the 'essence' of his subject rather than their physical representations.

The 8th Shanghai Jing'an International Sculpture Project (2024 JISP) 26 September – 31 December 2024

Centered around the theme 'Echoes Among Us,' 2024 JISP is an exploration of the harmonious coexistence between art, the city, and its people. Curated by UCCA Lab, part of UCCA Center for Contemporary Art, the exhibition will present sculptures by 31 artists from 10 countries, including Camille Henrot. These works create a unique artistic immersion, fusing art and urbanity to celebrate global cultural exchange.
