2025 REPORTING

Maine entities are expected to receive \$228.5 million in opioid settlement funds through 2038. Under LD 110, An Act to Require Reporting on the Expenditure of Opioid Settlement Funds by Certain Municipalities and County Governments, reporting is legally required for the 39 subdivisions receiving settlement funds. The Maine Office of the Attorney General and the Maine Recovery Council voluntarily reported their expenditures to support unified statewide settlement fund reporting. To support transparency in Opioid Settlement Fund spending, a summary of 2025 mandatory and voluntary* data submitted by entities is presented below.

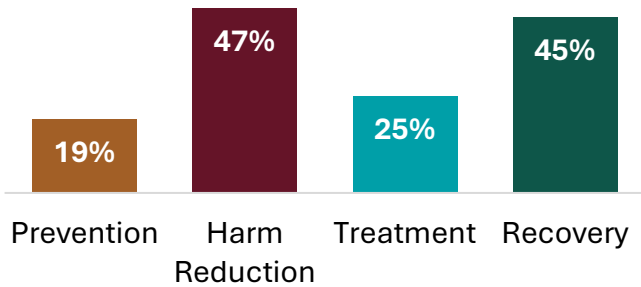

Percent of expenditures by core opioid response strategies:



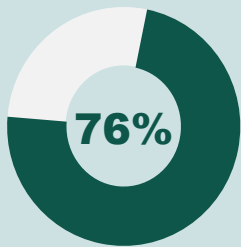

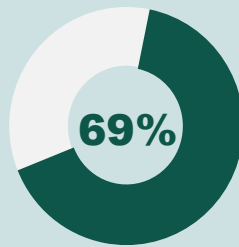
