Safety Guidelines for **FIRE EMERGENCIES**

EMERGENCY NUMBER

If possible, dial the emergency call yourself

- Describe what happened
- Provide details of the incident and **location**
- Answer any questions asked
- Follow the instructions given to you
- End the call only when given permission

KEEP THE EMERGENCY ACCESS ROADS CLEAR

If you detect a fire...

- If possible try to extinguish the fire
 - Use a fire blanket, water or fire extinguisher
- If you can not extinguish the fire
 - Leave the apartment; close doors and windows, including the apartment door
 - Meet at designated assembly area (DO NOT use elevators)
- Call the emergency number **112**
- Warn those in danger
- Guide the emergency services to the location and follow their instructions
- If there is smoke in the stairwell, stay in your apartment and try to prevent smoke from entering
 - Do not enter to a smoke-filled stairwell
