### About 10X

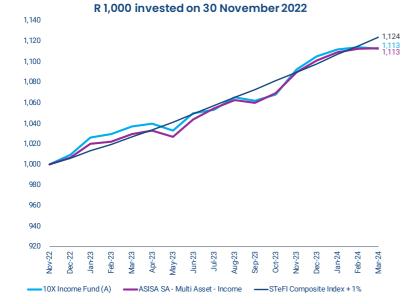
10X Investments began investing money in 2007 and currently has R48 billion under management. We manage a range of investments from pensions to discretionary investments.

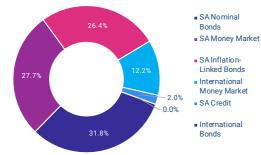
