Most welcome to the fifth edition of Better Bodies Challenge The competition is open to Swedish, Nordic and Baltic countries including Russia that are members in a National Federation affiliated to the IFBB.

Date:

Saturday 21 March starting 09.00 with running order in blocks.

The venue is Folkets Hus Stockholm City Conference Center and is located at Barnhusgatan 12-14 in Stockholm. Only 5-10 minutes walk from Stockholm Central Station.

Registration:

Will be Friday 20nd March, Time 18.00 at the competition venue Folkets hus Stockholm City Conference Center. To enter this event all Swedish athletes must be a licensed athletes of Swedish Bodybuiding & Fitness Federation (SBBF). Foreign athletes must be licensed athletes of their national federation affiliated to the IFBB.

Entry fee:

Entry fee: 1000 SEK up to 28th of February via below instructions. Athletes who compete in more than one category pay an entry fee of 1000 SEK for the first category and 500 SEK for every additional category that the athlete compete in.

After this date, 28th February, the entry fee is 1200 SEK in cash or swish at the registration. For additional categories extra 600SEK per class.

You must do the weigh in with your posing suit on.

Competitors may show their attire at the registration but are still responsible for showing up for competition in suits and attire according to the IFBB rules.

At the registration you will receive badges for competitors and coaches (one coach for each competitor).

Rules:

Better Bodies Challenge is arranged according to the rules set by the IFBB, EBFF and SBFF.



Last day of entry is 8th March.

All foreign competitors must sign up through their national federation.

National Federation of the athlete and directly to IFBB Head office in Madrid and IFBB Technical commission.

The final decision to allow an athlete to compete in this event rests with the IFBB.
