## THE P&G GOOD EVERYDAY CANADA SWEEPSTAKES OFFICIAL RULES

## NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER THE SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. Timing: The P&G Good Everyday Canada Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes") begins 12:00:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("ET") on February 22, 2021 and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. ET on June 30, 2021 (the "Sweepstakes Period"). The Sweepstakes Period will consist of two (2) entry periods (each an "Entry Period"), as described in the chart below. Each Entry Period will begin at 12:00:00 a.m. and end at 11:59:59 p.m. on the dates listed in the chart below. Sponsor's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Sweepstakes.

- 2. Eligibility: The Sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of Canada who reached the age of majority in their province or territory of residence as of the last day of the month prior to date of entry. Employees of Procter & Gamble Inc. (the "Sponsor"), their respective parents, subsidiaries, divisions, affiliates, suppliers, distributors and advertising, promotional and judging agencies, including Don Jagoda Associates, Inc.   - b.) Enter via mail: On a plain piece of 3"x 5" paper, hand print your first and last name, street address (no P.O. Boxes), city, province, postal code, month and year of birth and e-mail address. Mail your entry in an envelope no larger than #10 (business-size envelope) with sufficient postage affixed to mail to the USA, to: The P&G Good Everyday Sweepstakes Canada Entries, P.O. This section does not limit any other consent(s) that an entrant may provide the Sponsor in relation to the collection, use and/or disclosure of their personal information.
- 5. Random Drawings: Three (3) winners (one for each prize as described below) will be selected for each Entry Period in random drawings on the drawing dates listed in Rule #1, on or about 9:00 AM ET, from among all eligible entries received/postmarked within the Entry Period for each prize. The drawings will be conducted by Don Jagoda Associates, Inc. (at their offices in Melville, NY USA), an independent judging organization whose decisions are final on all matters relating to the Sweepstakes. Odds of winning are dependent upon the total number of eligible entries received/postmarked for each Entry Period and for each prize.
- 6. Winner Notification/Prize Redemption: Potential winners will be notified by email on or about the drawing dates listed above.
