- 6 Arrange storage or shipment.** You can safely store your vials at our state-of-the-art facility. And when you're ready, schedule your shipment to arrive at least two days in advance of your procedure.

While all our donors have been rigorously screened to help ensure they're qualified, we offer different types of donors:

- ID disclosure donors have agreed to release certain identifying information to donor-conceived individuals if requested at 18 years of age.
- Open donors have agreed to a minimum of one communication with a donor-conceived person if requested at 18 years of age.**
- Anonymous donors have not agreed to any contact with a donor-conceived person.**

We want to make sure that purchasing, storing and accessing the vials you need, when you need them, is as convenient, affordable, and flexible as possible.



More vials mean more savings

Save more when you buy more. With the Family Today & Family Tomorrow® program, you'll receive one free year of storage with the purchase of four or more vials and three years of storage with the purchase of eight or more vials.†

† Only single purchases of 4 or more vials qualify for free storage. This offer will not apply to combined purchases made at separate times.

†† Purchases made through Progyny and other fertility benefits partners are not eligible for the vial buyback program.

Multiple vials

Before you choose your donor, it's important to consider your plans for your family, today and in the future. So be sure to talk to your doctor about the number of vials you may need for an immediate procedure. But also (because donors' vials sell out quickly), if you plan to use the same donor for every child you hope to have in the future, the only way to make sure that donor's vials will be available, is to purchase additional vials today.

Vial buyback option

If your plans change, or you end up needing fewer vials than you anticipated to build your family, you can rest easy knowing any unused and unshipped vials can be sold back for 50% of their original price within 3 years of your original purchase.††

Vial exchange program

Thanks to the vial exchange program, you can exchange unshipped vials you've purchased for other vials from another donor within 3 years of your original purchase. It's a great opportunity if a preferable donor (or one with the number or type of vials you need) becomes available.

Please note: California Cryobank acquired USC/PTI (Procreative Technologies) in 1997. While we did not continue to sell their donors, we did retain some patient and donor files. If you have any questions about the USC/PTI donors, please contact our family building consultants at 866-927-9622.

1. California Cryobank is proud to offer ID disclosure donors in addition to our open and anonymous donors. ID disclosure donors have agreed to allow California Cryobank to release their identifying information should a donor-conceived child request it once they turn 18. This information may include: the donor's full name, date of birth, and last-known address.
2. California Cryobank cannot guarantee that a donor has not or will not give through another sperm bank. California Cryobank only makes representations with regard to vials obtained by California Cryobank.
3. After the first year, families are responsible for storage. Patients can choose to renew storage each year, or they can save on 18-year or lifetime options. The current annual storage fee is subject to change. The use of cord blood is determined by the treating physician and is influenced by many factors, including the patient's medical condition, the characteristics of the sample, and whether the cord blood should come from the patient or an appropriately matched donor. Cord blood has established uses in transplant medicine, however, its use in regenerative medicine is still being researched. There is no guarantee that potential medical applications being studied in the laboratory or clinical trials will become available. Cord tissue use is still in early research stages, and there is no guarantee that treatments using cord tissue will be available in the future. Cord tissue is stored whole. Additional processing prior to use will be required to extract and prepare any of the multiple cell types from cryopreserved cord tissue. Cbr Systems, Inc.'s activities for New York State residents are limited to collection of umbilical cord tissue and long-term storage of umbilical cord-derived stem cells. Cbr Systems, Inc.'s possession of a New York State license for such collection and long-term storage does not indicate approval or endorsement of possible future uses or future suitability of these cells.
4. It is not possible to test for or to identify every genetic condition or mutation. Genetic testing can reduce, but cannot eliminate, the risk for the genetic diseases included in that particular test. Interpretation of genetic data can also change over time as genetic technology and knowledge is improved.
