

Young Artist Concert Programme Season 2021

Through its Young Artist Concert Programme (YACP), Andermatt Music is dedicated to supporting young soloists and chamber musicians. The YACP's second year will be a programme of five monthly concerts from February to June 2021 aimed at reviving live music in the destination. Andermatt Music is working closely with The New Generation Festival, a British-founded organisation also operating in the US and Italy, that is nurturing the next generation of virtuoso performers from across the world.

THE MUSICIANS AND THE REPERTOIRE

All YACP musicians have been selected through a variety of application processes and will participate in their respective programmes for up to three years. They will also be given chances to play in other projects organised by the partners of Andermatt Music in a variety of locations, as well as career support after their participation in the YACP. The repertoire has been carefully selected to showcase this second cohort of YACP musicians in the best way possible. Andermatt Music also helps the performers with repertoire development, encouraging them to establish concert programmes of their own that feature core repertoire which can develop their artistic maturity and be repeated for other recitals in the future.

Julius Baer – our Commitment

Supporting art and music has been integral to Bank Julius Baer's philosophy for decades. An interest in the visual arts dates back to the early 1930s, when the Baer family began its private art collection. Added to this, two female members of the Baer family pursued artistic careers, one of them having studied classical music. As a result, the family maintained an intensive contact with the art scene in Zurich, Paris and New York.

In the early 1980s, the Bank founded its corporate art collection. The purpose was, and still is, to support artists who, at the time of a first purchase, are not yet firmly established, but clearly show great potential. Nearly two decades later, Julius Baer started to sponsor concert halls, festivals and museums based on its heritage.

The Bank's involvement in the Young Artist Concert Programme series reflects its commitment to cultural diversity and to fostering youth, both regionally and internationally. We are convinced that the discovery and development of new talent stimulate an enduring public interest. And we are very excited to see how this promising platform is going to develop.

TRIO CHAGALL

Trio Chagall, named after the eponymous expressionist artist, was founded in 2013 by Lorenzo Nguyen (piano), Edoardo Grieco (violin) and Francesco Massimino (cello) while they were studying together at the Giuseppe Verdi Conservatoire in Turin. The trio has won numerous awards, most recently the top prize at the 20th edition of the Premio "Trio di Trieste", where it was also given the special Dario de Rosa award, for best performance of a piece by Schumann, and the Fernanda Selvaggio award, for best trio of the competition; with each member in their early 20s, the trio is the youngest chamber group ever to win the competition. The players are currently on a specialised Master's degree programme in chamber music with Trio di Parma and Pierpaolo Maurizzi, and continue to perform live in prestigious venues, including the Vatican Museums in Rome, the Milan Theatre dal Verme and Conservatoire and the Giuseppe Verdi Theatre in Trieste.

ROBERTS BALANAS VIOLIN

Latvian violinist Roberts Balanas has amassed millions of views online with his solo violin arrangements as featured by The Strad Magazine, Classic FM, BBC Radio 3 and The Violin Channel. Sir Elton John also published his solo violin arrangement of "I'm Still Standing". In 2020, Roberts released his debut album in collaboration with Linn Records and generously supported by the Bicentenary Scholarship at the Royal Academy of Music.

MARGARITA BALANAS CELLO

Latvian cellist Margarita Balanas has performed to audiences worldwide. Margarita made her solo debut at Wigmore Hall at age 17. Since then, she has played at Royal Festival Hall, Berliner Philharmonie, Kensington Palace and at festivals, such as the Piatigorsky International Cello Festival and the Adelaide International Cello Festival. Margarita is a regular guest artist for Scala Radio, BBC Radio 3 In-Tune, Classic FM and Latvian Radio 3.

ARIEL LANYI PIANO

Israeli pianist Ariel Lanyi made his orchestral debut at the age of 7. He has appeared as a soloist with the Israel Symphony Orchestra and the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra. He has also played at festivals such as the Ausseer Festsommer, Bosa Antica Festival, Miami Piano Festival, the Ravello Festival, and the Young Prague Festival. He currently studies at the Royal Academy of Music in London.

CHARLIE LOVELL-JONES VIOLIN

Welsh violinist Charlie Lovell-Jones has been described as one of the UK's most promising young violinists.

Since his Royal Festival Hall debut at the age of 15, Charlie's solo engagements have included appearances with the BBC National Orchestra of Wales, the RTÉ Concert Orchestra in Dublin, the English Chamber Orchestra, the Westminster Philharmonic

Orchestra, the Isle of Wight Symphony Orchestra and the Havant Symphony Orchestra. He currently plays an Italian violin made by G.B. Guadagnini from the distinguished firm J & Arthur Beare, loaned to him by a generous benefactor.

JULIAN TREVELYAN PIANO

Julian Trevelyan is a British pianist and performs regularly throughout Europe and the UK. Recent solo recitals have included first performances of Beethoven's Diabelli variations at festivals in London, Munich, Paris, Vienna and Switzerland. Over the past four years, Julian has studied piano with Rena Shereshevskaya at the École Normale de Musique in Paris, now supported by a scholarship from Patrick Masure. He also composes, sings, and is renowned as a chamber musician on piano, violin and viola. Julian is studying Musicology on a scholarship at the University of Oxford where he sings with his acappella group.

Francesco Dominici Buraccini is a graduate of the Santa Cecilia Conservatoire in Rome. He is a first prize winner of many national and international competitions, including the Francesco Jalenti Guitar Competition, the Riviera Etrusca Guitar Competition, the Rossini Guitar Competition and the Prix "Campus delle Arti". He has performed at festivals, events and venues such as Lions Day in Piazza Farnese, Auditorium Seraphicum and Teatro Traiano.

LUNA VIGNI FLUTE

Luna Vigni graduated from the Rinaldo Franci Institute of Advanced Music Education in Siena before training at the National Academy of Santa Cecilia in Lugano, the Weggis Flute Academy in Milan and the Conservatoire of Italian Switzerland. Luna is a member of the Italian Youth Orchestra, the Swiss Youth Orchestra and the Mahler Jugendorchester. She recently opened a Sir James Galway concert as a soloist with the Orchestra ArteViva in Milan.
