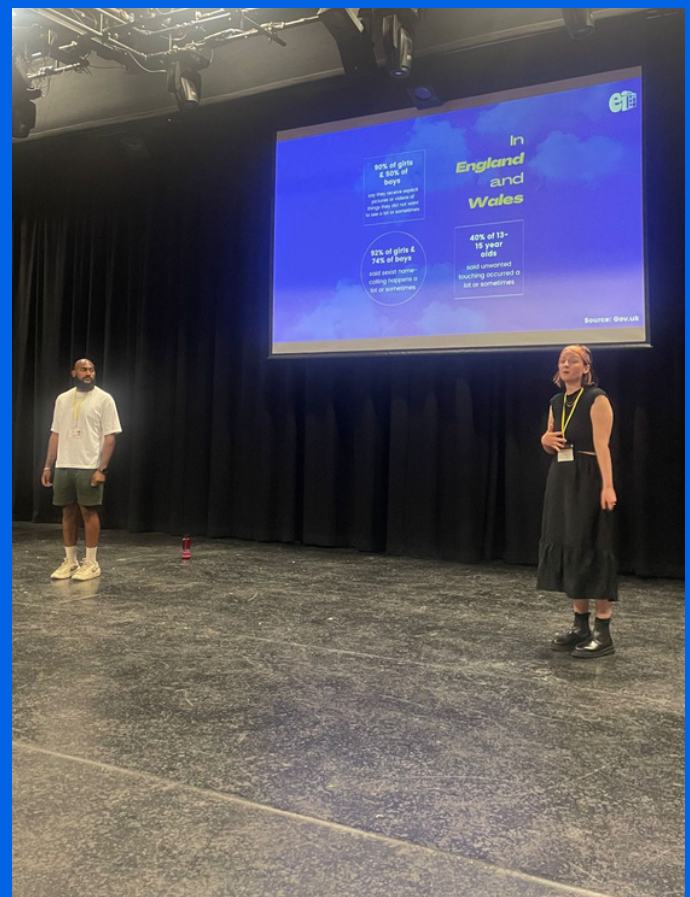

It made me feel grateful that people could listen to and learn about this topic. Also, to normalise the conversations in the talk and help people who may not have been in a relationship before understand what it should be like, as I think there is a preconception about teenage relationships.
