Other Charges and Fees

This section lists specific charges relating to your contractual agreement.

Non Energy Charge is the total cost of your fixed Third Party Costs (TPC)s. The charge is applied to the consumption at Meter Supply Point (MSP).

Distributor Charges

The fixed and capacity charges cover the cost of installing, operating and maintaining safe and reliable electricity supplies.

The red, amber and green charges relate to different times of usage (and therefore prices) on the network. **On Flex Combi Control these charges are passed through.**



Transmission

Transmission charges recover the cost of installing and maintaining the National Grid. The cost is based on your average demand during periods of peak national demand (during November - February), multiplied by your regional tariff.

On Flex Combi Control this charge is passed through.



Taxes, Levies and Other Statutory Obligations

The CCL is a tax on energy that aims to encourage all businesses to reduce carbon emissions and become more energy efficient.

The Capacity Market (CM) aims to ensure the UK has enough capacity on the grid to cover peak demands.
