Distributor Charges

The fixed and capacity charges cover the cost of installing, operating and maintaining safe and reliable electricity supplies.

The red, amber and green charges relate to peak times of usage (and therefore prices) on the network.



Transmission

Transmission charges recover the cost of installing and maintaining the National Grid. The cost is based on your average demand during periods of peak national demand (in November and February), multiplied by your regional tariff.



Reconciliation Adjustments

These occur when we review your account to ensure we've billed you correctly. Some nonenergy charges are estimated, until the Government and various industry bodies confirm the cost. If there's a discrepancy between the estimate and actual cost, we make an adjustment.



Taxes, Levies and Other Statutory Obligations

These charges are levied on suppliers to cover the cost of subsiding renewable energy generation, and ensuring the UK has enough electricity on the grid to meet demand.
