

Understanding your Flex Combi invoice for Non-Half Hourly (NHH) meters



Energy

This section breaks down the total cost of the energy you've used throughout the billing period.

Energy is charged at Meter Supply Point (MSP), rather than the Notional Balancing Point (NBP).



Other Charges and Fees

This section lists specific charges relating to your contractual agreement.

Energy and Non Energy are charged at the Meter, rather than NBP. Non Energy Charge is the total cost of your fixed Third Party Costs (TPCs).



Taxes, Levies and Other Statutory Obligations

The CCL is a tax on energy that aims to encourage all businesses to reduce carbon emissions and become more energy efficient.

Also known as the Meter Point Administration Number, or **MPAN**
